Judicial Watch – Zogby Poll on Clinton and Government Corruption

Highlights

- More than one in five Democrats (22.1%) believes Hillary Clinton is either "very corrupt" or "somewhat corrupt."
- 39.3% of self-described political independents believe Hillary Clinton is "very corrupt" or "somewhat corrupt."
- 55.6% of respondents who attend church at least once per week are either "very concerned" or "somewhat concerned" there will be high levels of corruption in the White House if Hillary Clinton is elected President.
- One in five union households are "very concerned" there will be high levels of corruption in the White House if Hillary Clinton is elected President.
- 50% of self-identified born again Christians believe Bill Clinton cannot be trusted to behave honestly in the White House if Hillary Clinton is elected President.
- 79.3% of African Americans trust Bill Clinton to behave honestly in the White House if Hillary Clinton is elected President, whereas 6% do not trust him to behave honestly. For White Americans, those figures are 45.5% and 40.2% respectively.
- 30.3% of union households do not trust Bill Clinton to behave honestly in the White House if Hillary is elected President.
- The majority of every single demographic group believes corruption is a "significant problem in Washington."
- 46.4% of self-described political liberals strongly agree that bigger government leads to more corruption.
