Janice, our DoD Directive for Congressional travel (DoD Directive 4515.12) prohibits travel of dependents of members and employees of Congress on military air. Exceptions may be made by the Secretary of Defense to permit dependents -- with or without reimbursement -- when:

1) Essential to the proper accomplishment of the mission;

2) Desirable because of diplomatic or public relations; or

3) Necessary for the health of the principal (e.g., Member of Congress).

The directive grants OSD the discretion to determine when reimbursement is appropriate. Exception #2 is the basis upon which we authorize travel of spouses to accompany Members for protocol purposes.

There is no authority in our Directive to fly Members' spouses without the Member.

I hope this is responsive to your concerns. Let us know if you need anything further.

Kay, I wanted you to know that we have successfully sourced aircraft and crews for all of the currently planned trips during the July recess. This is the second month running we've flown four C-40Cs simultaneously in support of large CODELs (and the first time ever as these are new assets at Scott AFB). This is great work on the part of the National Guard, particularly since they are only resourced to fly two of their three big jets as primary mission aircraft.

You'll note that CODEL Boyd is not listed. We have made multiple offers to them (Robert Wilkie and I personally spoke with David Morrison). We have tentatively blocked dates in Iraq for them for 14-15 Jul and have even blocked an aircraft. But we do not have confirmation from them. Just wanted you to know that we've leaned as far forward as we can to support them without them given us their final decision.

Kay, the Speaker Pelosi crew will not be able to support this mission as there are crew rest requirements post- and pre-mission that would prevent them from supporting CODEL Engel. The post-mission requirement is one day for every three days gone, and at least one-day crew rest prior to the mission for an overnight trip. Janice, our DoD Directive for Congressional travel (DoD Directive 4515.12) prohibits travel of dependents of members and employees of Congress on military air. Exceptions may be made by the Secretary of Defense to permit dependents -- with or without reimbursement -- when:

1) Essential to the proper accomplishment of the mission;

2) Desirable because of diplomatic or public relations; or

3) Necessary for the health of the principal (e.g., Member of Congress).

The directive grants OSD the discretion to determine when reimbursement is appropriate. Exception #2 is the basis upon which we authorize travel of spouses to accompany Members for protocol purposes.

There is no authority in our Directive to fly Members' spouses without the Member.

I hope this is responsive to your concerns. Let us know if you need anything further.
