Attached is the listing of CODELs for Jun and Jul with a particular focus on the 4th of July recess. Aircraft confirmed are shown with an "x" in the column next to the "aircraft granted" column. Also, for those not confirmed, you can see the requests we've made to the Army, Navy, Guard and Reserve.

There is a G-5 available to us this recess -- assigned to CODEL McCain. The other three are assigned to White House and Cabinet missions. Notably, there are two C-9s available. However, there are no trips requested/planned with pax or destinations suitable for their capability.

Janice, our DoD Directive for Congressional travel (DoD Directive 4515.12) prohibits travel of dependents of members and employees of Congress on military air. Exceptions may be made by the Secretary of Defense to permit dependents -- with or without reimbursement -- when:

- 1) Essential to the proper accomplishment of the mission;
- 2) Desirable because of diplomatic or public relations; or
- 3) Necessary for the health of the principal (e.g., Member of Congress).

The directive grants OSD the discretion to determine when reimbursement is appropriate. Exception #2 is the basis upon which we authorize travel of spouses to accompany Members for protocol purposes.

There is no authority in our Directive to fly Members' spouses without the Member.

I hope this is responsive to your concerns. Let us know if you need anything further.

Kay, I wanted you to know that we have successfully sourced aircraft and crews for all of the currently planned trips during the July recess. This is the second month running we've flown four C-40Cs simultaneously in support of large CODELs (and the first time ever as these are new assets at Scott AFB). This is great work on the part of the National Guard, particularly since they are only resourced to fly two of their three big jets as primary mission aircraft.

You'll note that CODEL Boyd is not listed. We have made multiple offers to them (Robert Wilkie and I personally spoke with David Morrison). We have tentatively blocked dates in Iraq for them for 14-15 Jul and have even blocked an aircraft. But we do not have confirmation from them. Just wanted you to know that we've leaned as far forward as we can to support them without them given us their final decision.

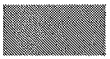

There are four G-5s in use from the 89th Airlift Wing until the end of May. Starting on June 1st, only three will be available for tasking. As of now, there are multiple users consuming the available planes during these two time periods -- White House military office taskings, the VP, Cabinet Officers and multiple other executive users.

We also had a G-5 available to us in EUCOM, but due to the delay in getting the priority list, that aircraft was tasked to a Senate CODEL travelling to the same region.

As of now, we plan to support the House CODELs in the following manner:

Kay, the issue is no crew. We cannot swap crews among different platforms due to crew certification/qualification issues. For example, the "small planes" are typically G-3s and G-5s. Even those crews must be certified to fly each aircraft and cannot swap without the required training and certs. Using a small airplane crew to fly a 737 would violate several flight safety regulations.

The Speaker Pelosi C-40 will be reset for use on another mission. I don't have visibility into their other missions, but I can tell you it will not be used for another CODEL during recess.

Kay, the Speaker Pelosi crew will not be able to support this mission as there are crew rest requirements post- and pre-mission that would prevent them from supporting CODEL Engel. The post-mission requirement is one day for every three days gone, and at least one-day crew rest prior to the mission for an overnight trip. The earliest they could notionally support another mission would be the 4th (and that would be assuming that all of the crew were available and did not have to return to their civilian jobs.)

The National Guard -- with augmentation from the Active and reserves -- has generated three crews and aircraft to support CODELs during the recess period, and will not be able to support further missions during this time (until after minimum acceptable levels of crew rest).

We've tried to find a way to support this mission. At one point, we had a small aircraft available, but they outgrew the plane. As of now -- with 12 Members plus spouses -- we do not have an aircraft.

Janice, our DoD Directive for Congressional travel (DoD Directive 4515.12) prohibits travel of dependents of members and employees of Congress on military air. Exceptions may be made by the Secretary of Defense to permit dependents -- with or without reimbursement -- when:

- 1) Essential to the proper accomplishment of the mission;
- 2) Desirable because of diplomatic or public relations; or
- 3) Necessary for the health of the principal (e.g., Member of Congress).

The directive grants OSD the discretion to determine when reimbursement is appropriate. Exception #2 is the basis upon which we authorize travel of spouses to accompany Members for protocol purposes.

There is no authority in our Directive to fly Members' spouses without the Member.

I hope this is responsive to your concerns. Let us know if you need anything further.

Kay, I wanted you to know that we have successfully sourced aircraft and crews for all of the currently planned trips during the July recess. This is the second month running we've flown four C-40Cs simultaneously in support of large CODELs (and the first time ever as these are new assets at Scott AFB). This is great work on the part of the National Guard, particularly since they are only resourced to fly two of their three big jets as primary mission aircraft.

You'll note that CODEL Boyd is not listed. We have made multiple offers to them (Robert Wilkie and I personally spoke with [REDACTED]). We have tentatively blocked dates in Iraq for them for 14-15 Jul and have even blocked an aircraft. But we do not have confirmation from them. Just wanted you to know that we've leaned as far forward as we can to support them without them given us their final decision.
