Dear Ms. Millspaw:

I am writing in response to your Freedom of Information Law request for:

- “1) All records of communication between the Office of the mayor and Imam Feisal Abdul Rauf concerning the Cordoba Initiative’s proposed Cordoba House Project.
- 2) All records of communication between the Office of Mayor Bloomberg and any of the following entities:
- a) Council of American-Islamic Relations (CAIR);
 - b) Islamic Society of North America (ISNA);
 - c) International Institute of Islamic Thought (IIIT);
 - d) American Society for Muslim Advancement (ASMA);
 - e) American Arab Anti-Discrimination Committee (ADC); and/or
 - f) Muslim Public Affairs Council (MPAC).

The time frame...from January 1, 2009 to [August 13, 2010].”

We have conducted a thorough search to identify all responsive records. Accordingly, enclosed are records that are responsive to your request and subject to disclosure. Please note that certain information responsive to your request has been withheld pursuant to Public Officers Law Section 87(2)(b), which allows agencies to withhold information that “if disclosed would constitute an unwarranted invasion of personal privacy.”

You may appeal this determination within 30 days to Deputy Mayor Carol Robles-Román, Records Access Appeals Officer, at City Hall, New York, NY 10007. Thank you.
