His staff also told me that the CODEL would be open to a C-9, if it could make Cairo in one day. I don't know how they'll take a "may" make it type answer.

Taking the C-9 also complicates planning already arranged with CENTCOM for the Dubai-Kabul/return portion on April 12, in theater MILAIR support; C-9 can't go to Kabul, the C-40 can.

I'd rather be able to tell the McConnell office yes or no on the C-40, along with the C-9 timeline you sent earlier. I doubt they will answer the question, "Will the principal accept travel via the C-9 and keep the travel period 4-14 April or not?" without the C-40 piece, but I will inform them of the current status.

We are hard pressed to resolve the C-40 question but continue to be advised by OSD that the bottom line take way from the discussion between SECDEF and the member was that "a Codel shift "to" travel dates 3-13 April, would make the C-40 assignment possible".

During our discussion yesterday afternoon you indicated to me that the principal did not have that understanding and was confident that SECDEF had confirmed milair support via a C-40 for travel period 4-14th. However, were the "C-9" capable of travel from Conus to Cairo in a crew day then perhaps it could answer the mail in terms of air support.

I had CVAM run the C-9 times early this morning as a result of our phoncon yesterday afternoon. As indicated below, it appears that the C-9 may be able to reach Cairo in the timeframe that you indicated was essential to the delegation as of yesterday.

-- The group is also the only group with a large aircraft who only has four members (McConnell, Chambliss, Barasso, Risch + spouses) all others have 5,6,7, or 10 members.
