Bernard,

Thanks for the telephone advice. As you know we have been slowly advancing our political effort for the implementation of our Rapid Organ Recovery Ambulance (RORA) from Year 1 to Year 2. As we prepare our renewal submission it is clear that we must ask permission to roll over the personnel costs for those who would staff the RORA in Year 1. I hope that we can begin RORA function sometime in the last quarter of 2008 [September-December] [First quarter of Year 2 of the grant]

Therefore the *Family Service Counselor* (FSE on budget) = Salary & fringe (\$23,040 x 2) and the *Emergency Medical Technicians* (EMTs) = Salary & Fringe (\$9,521 x 4) and Other expenses + \$5,854 would be moved to Year 3 when we are only staffed for 9 months (not to Year 2 when we are fully staffed for the entire year) . With this change in staff allocation we would be fully staffed to operate the RORA for both Years 2 and 3. This total transmission from Year 1 to Year 3 is \$46,080 + \$9,521 x 4 + \$5,854 = TOTAL \$90,018.

I will know by the time of submission whether we have spent the entire \$100,000 for the development of our PR campaign. If this is not completed in Year 1, I would ask that the remaining dollars be rolled over to Year 2. I will have more detail shortly.

Thanks for your advice and support on this project.

Dear Dr Goldfrank:

I spent a good bit of time with Brad Barney our grants management specialist, regarding your request for carryover of funds. Regulations allow a justified carryover of unobligated funds from year one to year two or year two to year three but not directly from year one to year three.

There is, although, a delayed approach which may lead to the approval of the carryover you are requesting. Continue your second year budget as originally written. At the end of the budget year two (or within 90 days thereof) when you file your Financial Status Report you may submit a request for unobligated funds available from the first two years to be carried over to the third year. At that point, based on the number of individuals and offices that have to sign off on the request, the process may take 2 weeks to 2 months before a decision is made. Given progress through budget year two, justification for the carryover similar to the present request and programmatic support for the carryover there is a good likelihood, but no guarantee that the carryover request would be approved by the Division of Grants Management. The fund carryover, if approved, would then be available for salary use through the completion of year three.

Based on the regulations I can not be more definitive than the above.
