Background on labor leaders

Anna Burger, Chair, Change to Win

Anna Burger is the Secretary-Treasurer of SEIU and Chair of the Change to Win Federation. Prior to that, Burger served as SEIU Local 668's first female President and as SEIU's National Field Director. She and her husband, Earl Gohl, have one daughter, Erin. Richard Trumka, President, AFL-CIO
