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
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

Trying to look good for IOC makes sense

City crews are repaving roads in Washington Park, and that has offended plenty of people. The critics grouse that City Hall is fixing up those streets -- when other streets are in worse shape -- just to make the park look better before an inspection visit in two weeks by a team from the International Olympic Committee, which will decide if Chicago is awarded the 2016 Summer Games. We say the critics are right. City Hall is, in fact, putting a priority on spiffing up the park to make a good impression on the Olympic Committee. And that's fine by us. Because we want Chicago to win.

As we've written before, we think the Olympics, if done right, could be a boon to Chicago's economy and international image and leave behind a lasting legacy of civic improvements -- better housing, transportation and the like -- especially on the South Side.

The key phrase here, of course, is "if done right." We know the Olympics have left other towns high and dry and burdened with debt, and Chicago can't afford that kind of empty two-week party. So we're glad to see all the local Olympic critics and watchdog groups sprouting up; we count ourselves among them. We'll be monitoring the city's Olympic efforts -- most especially following the money -- and doing our best to make sure the Games serve our city well.

But promoters of a Chicago Olympics need credible and constructive criticism, not contrived controversies that undermine public support for the Games but amount to nothing.

Along those lines, we weren't sure what to make of scolding news reports around town Thursday about the road repairs in Washington Park.

If Chicago is serious about bringing the Games to Chicago, of course we should spiff up Washington Park -- the proposed main Olympic site -- in advance of a make-or-break IOC inspection. It would be beyond pathetic to lose the Games because of a bunch of potholes.

Critics of a Chicago Olympics present what we see as a false choice -- the city can either spend money on fun and games or on housing and schools. We think a successful Olympics would lead to an economically stronger Chicago better able to invest in those schools and that housing.

The IOC inspection team is due in town April 2. Between now and then (and long afterward), you'll be hearing plenty of reservations about Chicago's Olympic bid, many of which we share.

Critics are troubled that Chicago has created a \$500 million guarantee against operating losses for the Olympics and that Gov. Quinn has pledged the state will guarantee an additional \$250 million. Our concern is that if the city fails to run a good Olympics, the taxpayers will actually have to come up with that money.

Many critics also complain that the city's Olympic bid fails to guarantee direct benefits to minorities and the poor, especially in the awarding of contracts. Community activists, with particular support from Aldermen Toni Preckwinkle and Pat Dowell, are demanding that the city award half of all contract money to minorities and women and to make at least 30 percent of housing to be built for the Olympic Village affordable.

These are the kind of deeply serious issues that must be resolved if Chicago is to make a success of its Summer Olympics in 2016.

But when the local detractors get in a huff over something so obviously sensible as repaving a couple of roads before a big inspection, they diminish their own credibility.

As every landlord knows, it helps to paint the walls before showing an apartment.

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
