



Subject: Question about the Black Panther Voter Intimidation case

I have called the Justice Department and talked to them, but there was one question that they were not able to answer. One of the New Black Panther Party members who had charges voluntarily dismissed was Jerry Jackson, an elected member of the Philadelphia Democratic Committee. He was also a credentialed poll watcher for the Democrats when the violations occurred. This is the first time that I can find that the Justice Department has refused to take a default judgment. The explanation for asking for voluntary dismissal of the counts is also something that I have never seen. "These same Defendants have made no appearance and have filed no pleadings with the Court. Nor have they otherwise raised any other defenses to this action. Therefore, the United States has the right under to dismiss voluntarily this action against the Defendants." In other words, since the defendants haven't tried to defend themselves, even though the Justice Department had won the case so DOJ is now going to be dropping it.

#### **Voting**

• Department to File Motion for Default Judgment in U.S. v. New Black Panther Party
On May 15, 2009, pursuant to court order, the Department will file a motion for a default
judgment against at least some of the defendants in United States v. New Black Panther
Party for Self-Defense, et al., (E.D. Pa.). The complaint in this action, filed January 7,
2009, alleged that, on election day in November 2008, members of the New Black Panther
Party for Self-Defense (NBPP) stood in formation, in military-style uniforms, a few feet
from the entrance to a polling location in Philadelphia, Pennsylvania, brandishing a billyclub, and yelling racial taunts and slurs at voters and poll-workers. The complaint alleged
various violations of Section 11(b) of the Voting Rights Act. The NBPP has been
identified as a racist hate group by the Southern Poverty Law Center, the Anti-Defamation
League, and the founders and members of the original Black Panther Party. The United
States will seek an injunction in this matter; the precise terms of the proposed injunction is
yet to be determined.





#### **Voting**

On May 15, 2009, the Department voluntarily dismissed its claims that the New Black Panther Party for Self-Defense (NBPP), Malik Zula Shabazz and Jerry Jackson violated Section 11(b) of the Voting Rights Act, and moved for a default judgment against the remaining defendant, Minister King Samir Shabazz. The complaint in this action, filed January 7, 2009, alleged that, on election day in November 2008, members of the NBPP stood in formation, in military-style uniforms, a few feet from the entrance to a polling location in Philadelphia, Pennsylvania, brandishing a billy-club, and yelling racial taunts and slurs at voters and poll-workers. The complaint alleged various violations of Section 11(b) of the Voting Rights Act.


