The United States Immigration and Naturalization Service (INS), advised he sought entry under sponsorship by the Soviet and Eastern European Exchange Staff of the USDS to accept a position as research associate at City University of New York.

In addition, (b)(6)(b)(7)(C)-1 per ICE visited the INS Office in New York and was granted authority for an indefinite stay in the United States.

He was subsequently visited again by (b)(6) (b)(7)(C)-2 per ICE who reiterated the offer of a passport extension. It was refused and (b)(6)(b)(7)(C)-1 per ICE is reputed to have chided about the failure (b)(6)& of the Romanian Government to release his daughter to him and (b)(7)(C) said he would report on the matter.

Our source advised that Senator Edward M. Kennedy of Massachusetts has been contacted and requested to assist in getting the (b)(6). (b)(7)(C)-1 per FBI child out of Romania.

In addition, it was stated by our source that the Romanian Orthodox priest in New York was preparing a memorandum to be submitted to President Richard M. Nixon suggesting that current flood relief being sent by the United States to Romania should be used as a lever to secure the release of relatives of Romanian refugees.



Kennedy indicated he would accept a fee of \$1 and wave the remainder of his \$5,000 salary.

In July, 1961, Edward Kennedy made a familiarization and orientation tour of Central and South American countries. During this tour, the Mexico City Legal Attache reported that Kennedy had expressed an interest in meeting with "Leftists" to talk with them and determine why they think as they do. Kennedy met with a number of individuals known to have communist sympathies. While in Mexico City, Kennedy asked the Ambassator to invite left-wingers to the Embassy where he could interview them; however, the Ambassador refused to do so and stated that if any such interviews were to be conducted, all arrangements would have to be made by Kennedy himself. Subsequently, a State Department official in Lima, Peru, confidentially advised that Kennedy had made a similar request in Peru, and this official described Kennedy as "pompous and a spoiled brat."

In August, 1961, a confidential source advised that Edward Kennedy had recently dined with Dr. Lauchlin Bernard Currie, former White House Aide to President Roosevelt. Currie's name had been mentioned in Washington investigations of Soviet spy rings. It was also noted that Dr. Currie had recently been invited to the U. S. Embassy at Bogata, Columbia, where Currie presently resides.

In October, 1961, a confidential source on Portuguese matters advised that Edward Kennedy was planning to enter politics and had retained one (b)(6), (b)(7)(C)-1 per FBI an attorney in Boston, to be his advisor on how to obtain Portuguese votes in Massachusetts. This source described (b)(6), (b)(7)(C)-1 per FBI as being a rightest and an extremist on behalf of the Portuguese Government. Inasmuch as there was a question as to whether (b)(6), (b)(7)(C)-1 per FBI should be registered as a foreign agent with the Department of Justice, Attorney General Kennedy was advised, and he spoke to "Teddy" about this. (b)(6), (b)(7)(C)-1 per FBI subsequently registered as a foreign agent on 12-29-61.

In July, 1961, Edward Kennedy made a tour of Central and South American countries. During this visit, he expressed an interest in meeting with "Leftists" to talk with them and to determine why they think as they do. He met with a number of individuals known to have communist sympathies. The Ambassador to Mexico refused his request to invite left-wingers to the American Embassy.
