The shotgun was manufactured in Japan and, according to Mr. Roy, it had an original retail value of approximately \$600.00. The shotgun is used and is approximately 10 years old. I do not know the current value. Note 3: Reference Part V, line 3 -Mr. Donaldson is a friend. We vacationed together for several days in the Bahama Islands. I, along with others, traveled from Orlando, Florida to Marsh Harbour, Bahama Islands in Mr.

Donaldson's airplane. We also made the return trip in the airplane. I believe that commercial transportation would have cost approximately \$360.00. Note 4: Reference Part Y, line 4-Gregory A. Presnell is a U.S. District Judge in the Middle District of Florida. I, along with others, stayed several days at a residence he rented in the Bahama Islands.
