**Description and Objectives**

The three hour training session will be designed as in-depth diversity awareness sessions aimed at establishing common ground knowledge and understanding about the issues and challenges impacting the USDA/APHIS, their mission and their goals. The format will consist of interactive facilitation and experiential learning along with small group exercises. Each session will establish familiarity of the basic concepts regarding diversity and how inclusive, diverse teams can improve the bottom-line and increase productivity and mission effectiveness.

The training sessions will be tailored and customized to the specific desires and challenges of the USDA/APHIS. The participants will learn:

- How identifying biases and respecting differences can benefit the workplace
- Practical skills for increasing sensitivity, including racial sensitivity
- Skills to successfully build relationships with people of diverse backgrounds
- Methods of conflict management

When Participants have completed this training they will have a greater understanding of diversity and racial cultural differences. Participants will have obtained and increased the skills necessary to perform their jobs in a more emotionally intelligent and sensitive way including the ability to manage conflict.
