Dear Ms. Garcia:

This letter is in final response to your Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) request dated January 7, 2013. Your request sought all records concerning, referring, or relating to Carter Dougherty, Maura Reynolds, or any other individual currently affiliated with Bloomberg from 12/1/2012 to the present.

A search of Offices of External Affairs and Chief Administrative Officer (Records and FOIA) for documents responsive to your request produced a total of 269 pages that are released in part pursuant to Title 5 U.S.C. § 552 (b)(6).

FOIA Exemption 6 exempts from disclosure personnel or medical files and similar files the release of which would cause a clearly unwarranted invasion of personal privacy. This requires a balancing of the public's right to disclosure against the individual's right to privacy. The types of documents and/or information that we have withheld may consist of mobile phone numbers or information belonging to a third party that are considered personal. The privacy interests of individuals in their records you have requested outweigh any minimal public interest in disclosure of the information. Any privacy interest you may have in that information does not factor into the aforementioned balancing test.


You may appeal any of the responses or decisions set forth above. If you choose to file an appeal, you must do so within 45 calendar days from the date of this letter. Your appeal must be in writing, signed by you or your representative and should contain the rationale for the appeal.
