Dear Ms. Garcia:

This is in response to your Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) request dated November 9, 2011. You requested, for the time frame of August 1, 2011 to the present:

1. all communications to, from, or about Mark Mallory;
2. all communications referring or relating to Cincinnati;
3. all communications to, from, or about Congressman Blumenauer; and
4. all communications referring or relating to the American Jobs Act.

In accordance with the FOIA, 5 U.S.C. § 552, enclosed are responsive records we found, with the exception of the home address and phone number of an individual which is protected by exemption 6. Exemption 6 protects against a clearly unwarranted invasion of personal privacy. 5 U.S.C. § 552(b)(6) and 49 CFR 7.13(c)(6).

I am the person responsible for this determination. If you are dissatisfied with this response, you may appeal to Rosalind A. Knapp, Deputy General Counsel, U.S. Department of Transportation, 1200 New Jersey Avenue, SE, Washington, DC 20590. An appeal must be made in writing and be submitted within 30 days after you receive this determination. It should contain any information and arguments you wish to rely on, and the envelope in which the appeal is sent should be prominently marked "FOIA Appeal." The Deputy General Counsel's determination will be administratively final.
