Dear Mr. Marshall:

This is in reference to your September 16, 2014, Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) request to the Federal Bureau of Investigation (FBI) for information regarding James Edward Bowman. The FBI forwarded documents that originated with the Civil Service Commission for our review and release to you. We received your request in our office on May 27, 2015.

The enclosed documents have been reviewed pursuant to the provisions of the FOIA. We have deleted information that is exempt from disclosure pursuant to title 5, United States Code, sections 552(b)(6), (b)(7)(C) and (b)(7)(D). Sections (b)(6) and (b)(7)(C) exempt information that could reasonably be expected to constitute an unwarranted invasion of personal privacy. Exemption (b)(7)(D) applies to records or information compiled for law enforcement purposes the release of which could reasonably be expected to disclose the identity of a confidential source.

If you wish to appeal these deletions, you may do so by submitting a request to the Office of the General Counsel, Office of Personnel Management, 1900 E Street, NW, Washington, DC 20415-0001. An appeal should include a copy of your request, a copy of this letter, and a statement explaining why you believe the decision is in error. The appeal should also include "FREEDOM OF INFORMATION ACT APPEAL" in capital letters on the envelope and at the top of the letter of appeal.

SYNOPSIS OF FACTS

This report covers employment with the 9937 TU Medical Nutritional Laboratory at the Fitzsimons Army Hospital, Denver, Colorado from July 15, 1953 to present date of January 10, 1955 and neighborhood investigation at Fitzsimons Army Hospital and Hoffman Heights at Aurora, Colorado from July, 1953 to present. No derogatory information was developed at place of employment or residences. Local police files show no criminal record. Credit bureau records at Denver, Colorado

show no credit record established. Date and place of birth corroborated by personnel records on file at Fitzsimons Army Hospital.

DENVER, COLORADO.

Employment

9937 TU MEDICAL NUTRITIONAL LABORATORY, Fitzsimons Army Hospital. Record information furnished by (b)(7)(D) and First Sergeant of the Detachment.

Our records indicate that James Edward Bowman was called to active duty in Chicago and immediately transferred with this Detachment to Fitzsimons, July 15, 1953 and is still on duty with the Detachment here as of this date. Bowman is a Captain in the Medical Corps and is on duty here as a Pathologist. Captain Bowman is one of the few people in the Army who is rated as a Pathologist and is apparently of high standing in that capacity. We have his birth date listed as February 5, 1923, Washington, D. C. At one time, Captain Bowman lived in the Bachelor Officers Quarters here on the Post. At the present time, and since about March of 1954, Captain Bowman and his wife have lived at 941 Turson Street, Hoffman Heights, Aurora, Colorado. Captain Bowman's immediate supervisor is (b)(6)(b)(7)(C) Psychologist, with the 9937 TU Medical Nutritional Laboratory, Fitzsimons Army Hospital. However, (b)(6)(b)(7)(C) at Fort Carson, Colorado. There is nothing in our records reflecting unfavorably upon Bowman's character, associations and loyalty. This Unit operates out of the Surgeon General's Office in Washington, D. C. Therefore, Captain Bowman's 201 file would be in Washington, D. C.

(b)(7)(D) 9937 TU Medical Nutritional Laboratory.

As (b)(7)(D) of the Unit, I have known Captain Bowman since July, 1953 when he joined the Unit. We have had fairly close contact here during that period and I would say that he is a very outstanding man. He is one of the nicest persons I have had occasion to meet and, although he is of a different nationality, I have found both he and his wife get along exceptionally well. He is very pleasant and agreeable to work with and generally speaking, is very highly regarded by all who know him. He is a man who has lots of ability and conducts himself well at all times. I have never seen him drunk or drinking and believe that he is a man of excellent morals and character. I have no reason whatever to question his honesty and feel that he is financially responsible. As

for his associates for the most part, they are officers here with the Unit at the present time. I am sure there would be no reason to feel that he would be involved with any questionable organizations and certainly no reason at all to question his loyalty to the United States. Captain Bowman is the Pathologist for the Laboratory here in this Unit and is very much interested in his work. I might add, that he is one of the very few Pathologists in the United States Army at the present time. His immediate supervisor is (b) (6) (b) (7) (C)

(b) (6) (b) (7) (C) From my knowledge of Captain Bowman and close contact with him here, I would recommend him highly for a responsible position which might involve national security.

(b) (7) (D)

9937 TU Medical

Nutritional Laboratory, Fitzsimons Army Hospital.

I have known Captain Bowman, who has been with our Unit here since, I believe, September, 1953. That is when I joined the Unit. I have had quite close contact with him here in our assignments, since he is the Pathologist for the Unit. He is a very conscientious individual, very thorough in his work and very much interested in all the phases of his work. He is very pleasant and agreeable fellow and I might add, a very quiet individual. He does not get around much socially, but then most of our officers in this Unit do not. The reason being that they are highly scientific personnel and of course keep more to themselves. He is a man of good morals and character and I certainly have never seen him drunk or drinking. I would feel, from my experience with him, that he is a very temperate man if he drinks at all. He takes care of his financial obligations and certainly lives within his means, or appears to, from what I know of him here. Captain Bowman came here from Chicago with the Unit, and from my general knowledge of him, I would say that he is very highly regarded by all who know him. I am not too familiar with his associates, but I believe they are other officers within the Unit here and I have no knowledge of his being affiliated with any questionable organizations. I have no reason whatever to question his loyalty to the United States, and I would certainly recommend him highly for a responsible position that is within his field, which might involve national security. I was out with him, or in his company rather, at one of our Command functions in the way of social activities, and found him to be always very quiet and reserved in his statements and behavior. I have never heard of anything whatever against Captain Bowman.

(b) (7) (D)

Assigned 9937 TU Medical

Nutritional Laboratory, Fitzsimons Army Hospital.

I have known Captain Bowman since July, 1953 and have gotten to know him fairly well during that period since my office is just across the hall from his in the same Unit. He is very prompt for work, very steady on the job and certainly deeply interested in his work. He is very pleasant

and agreeable at all times, and I often see him socially here at the Fitzsimons Army Hospital. I think that he is thoroughly honest, trustworthy and completely dependable. He is a man of very high morals and character and conducts himself well at all times. Although he is of a different nationality than mine and most of us here, I consider him a man of very high type. I have never seen him using liquor to excess nor have I seen any indication that he might do so. I have never seen him under the influence of liquor and have never heard of him being in that condition. I would say that his associates are mostly officers within the Unit here and I have no reason to feel that he would be involved with any questionable organizations. I know of no reason whatever to question his loyalty to the United States and would recommend him without hesitation for a highly responsible position which might involve national security.

Neighborhood

I know of no associates he may have other than possibly some of the military personnel from Fitzsimons. I do not think there would be any reason to feel that he would be involved with any questionable organizations and certainly know of no reason at all to question his loyalty to the United States. From my knowledge and experience with him as a neighbor during the past few months, I would recommend him highly for a responsible position with the government which might involve national security.

INVESTIGATOR'S NOTE: The above witness was contacted by phone due to the fact that he (b)(7)(D) and the Investigator was unable to catch him at home.

I have known the Bowmans for several months as neighbors across the street, but I have never had any particular contact with them. Since they are of a different nationality than any one in this section of
