
This is a supplemental response to this office's June 26, 2014 letter to you regarding your Freedom of Information Act request seeking access to:

“All Justice Department records from the Interactive Case Management System detailing the number of hours DOJ Attorney Barbara Bosserman expended on the investigation of the Internal Revenue Service Targeting Conservative organizations seeking tax-exempt status in the 2010 and 2012 elections cycles.”

In accordance with the Stipulation for Compromise Settlement and Release of Claims entered by the Department of Justice and Judicial Watch in *Judicial Watch, Inc. v. U. S. Department of Justice*, No. 15-5271 (copy of Stipulation attached), the Civil Rights Division is releasing the total number of hours Barbara Bosserman expended on the aforementioned investigation of the Internal Revenue Service.

As compiled from the Interactive Case Management System, Ms. Bosserman's investigative efforts totaled 1,529.25 hours.
