Wanted to speak for a moment about Israel's announcement of changes to its Gaza policy.

As you know, Israel will be spelling out a new policy in the next few hours.

They have come a long way, and gone well beyond where we expected them to go. Clearly, they can go further. For example, there is no direct reference to increasing commerce between Gaza and the West Bank - something that the PA would like to see. We should keep pressing the Israelis to take additional steps such as this.

I know that our Quartet envoys are discussing a statement in response. I believe a statement is important, because this is such a central issue and exactly the sort of moment where the Quartet's voice should be heard. It can also add momentum to the process of reform of this policy.

I believe the statement should **acknowledge and encourage** the progress the Israelis have made through this announcement. They have announced some important steps and those should be welcomed.

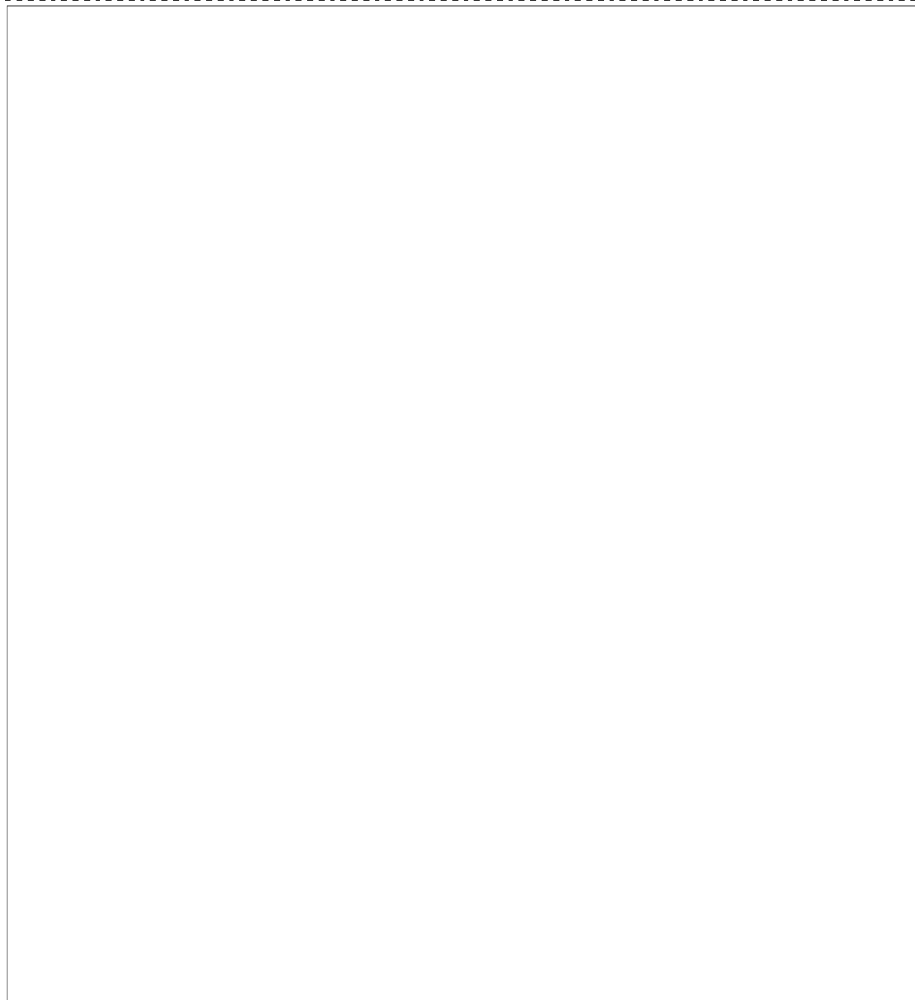
The statement should also *challenge* them to (1) implement these steps swiftly and comprehensively, and (2) pursue additional steps.

Through a properly balanced statement that responds positively to the specific steps Israel has announced and challenges them to implement swiftly and to go further, the Quartet will be doing its job, and can serve as an oversight mechanism to make sure there is follow-through.

We should be acting together to promote progress - and we should be asking Israel to have a continuing conversation with the Quartet as representatives of the international community on how to keep improving the situation in Gaza.

I hope you will instruct your Quartet envoy to work with our team on text, and perhaps we can follow up with a principals call tomorrow.

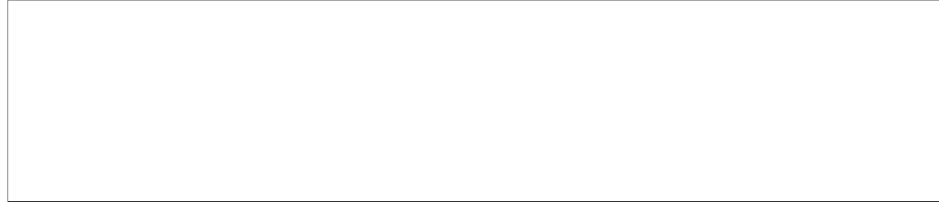

There weren't a huge number of updates over the evening, though the phones are getting more active again now. Late this morning we learned that SYG Ban Ki Moon was in touch with AMB Rice, and told her that there were approximately 100 UN staff still buried under the rubble at MINUSTAH, [redacted]. SYG Ban formally requested helicopter search and rescue teams. AMB Rice underscored that we need to make getting those SARs a priority.

I'm attaching our draft talking points from about an hour and a half ago; the background sections in particular have some useful information. Currently, Southcom is conducting aerial reconnaissance of the airport to determine in what sort of repair it is. The talking points note that several countries and organizations (Dominican Republic, Chile, UK, the Netherlands, IADB) have offered assistance to Haiti (and info'd us). In addition to those on the list, the Israelis are trying to send several urban search and rescue teams (some of the team members need help getting visas to transit Miami en route to Port-au-Prince).

The UN Situation Center is in contact with MINUSTAH's Deputy Force Commander. They have been working to clear a couple of major streets in Port-au-Prince, as noted in the talking points. They have also reviewed the airport, and their Deputy Force Commander told the UN Situation Center several hours ago that the airport was functional (in the sense that the tarmac was intact and planes could physically land).

Oren Anolik, political counselor at the Israeli Embassy, called around 2 a.m. to ask if there were any updates. We had few updates at that time, other than to let him know that we had learned the damage to southern Haiti was much more extensive than that in the north.

Purpose of Call: To inform Prince Saud of expected Wikileaks leaks.

- 1. Wishing King Abdullah Well: First let me convey my best wishes for a rapid and full recovery for His Majesty King Abdullah. Bill and I hope to see him sometime in future (we offered but they declines for Sat). Our thoughts are with him as he r
- 1. Wikileaks: I deeply regret the likely upcoming Wikileaks disclosure (which could come as early as November 26).
- 1. This appears to be the result of an illegal act in which a fully cleared intelligence officer stole information and gave it to a website. The person responsible will be prosecuted to the full extent of the law. We have taken aggressive measures
- 1. The U.S. will maintain its longstanding practice of not commenting publicly on classified material alleged to have been leaked. If asked publicly about how the leak of material affects our bilateral relationship, we will reiterate our strong com
- 1. This is the kind of sensitive information we fear may be released: details of private conversations with your government on Iraq, Iran, and Afghanistan.
- 1. I seek your help in preventing Wikileaks from undermining our mutual national interests. The President and I are committed to deepening our bilateral relationship.
- 1. (If raised) If Saudi Arabia Requests the Relevant Cables: I will have our ambassador come in to brief you on specifics.

Background: King Abdullah arrived in New York November 22 for treatment of what the Saudi government has described as a slipped disk and adjacent blood clot.

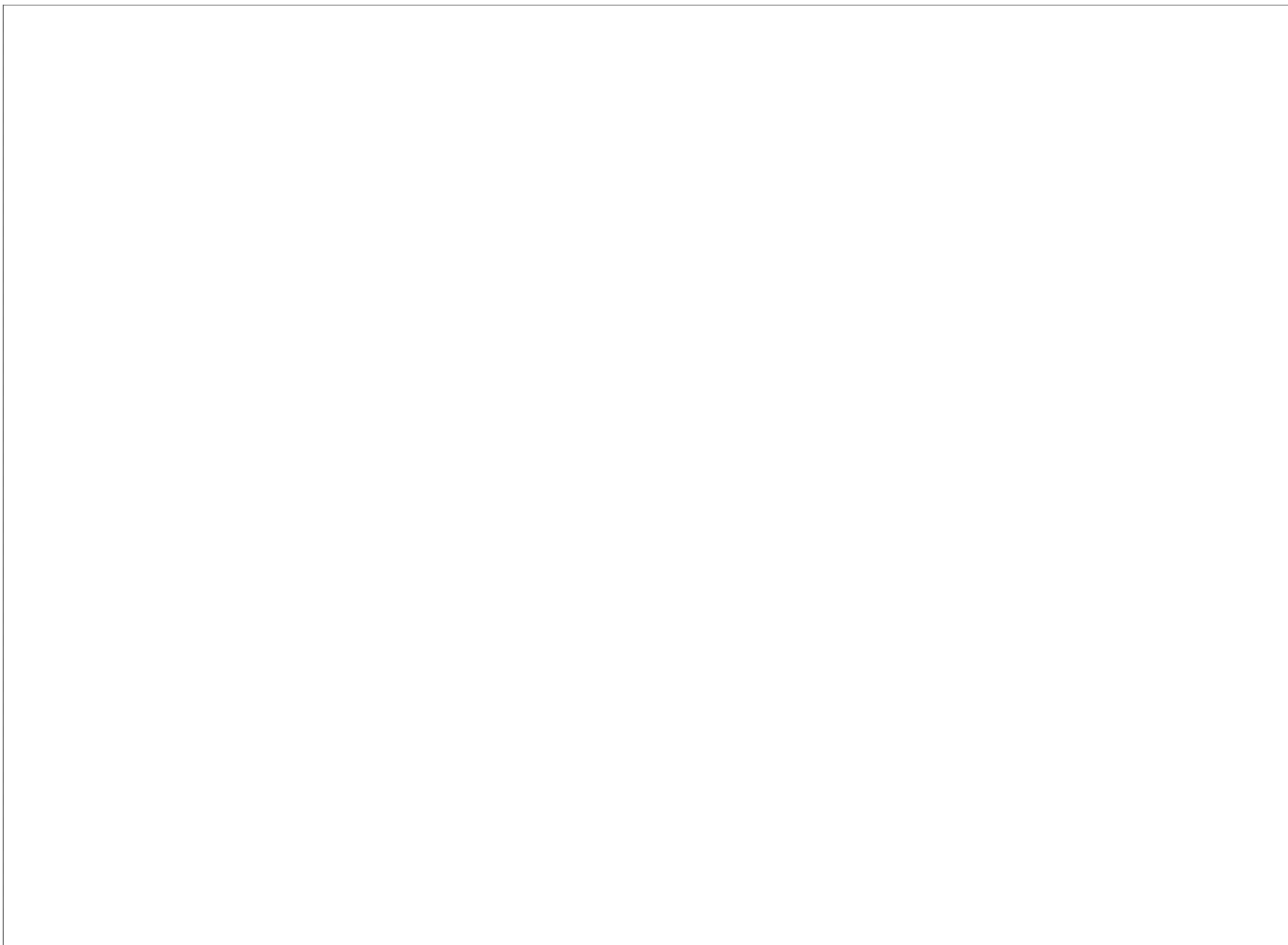

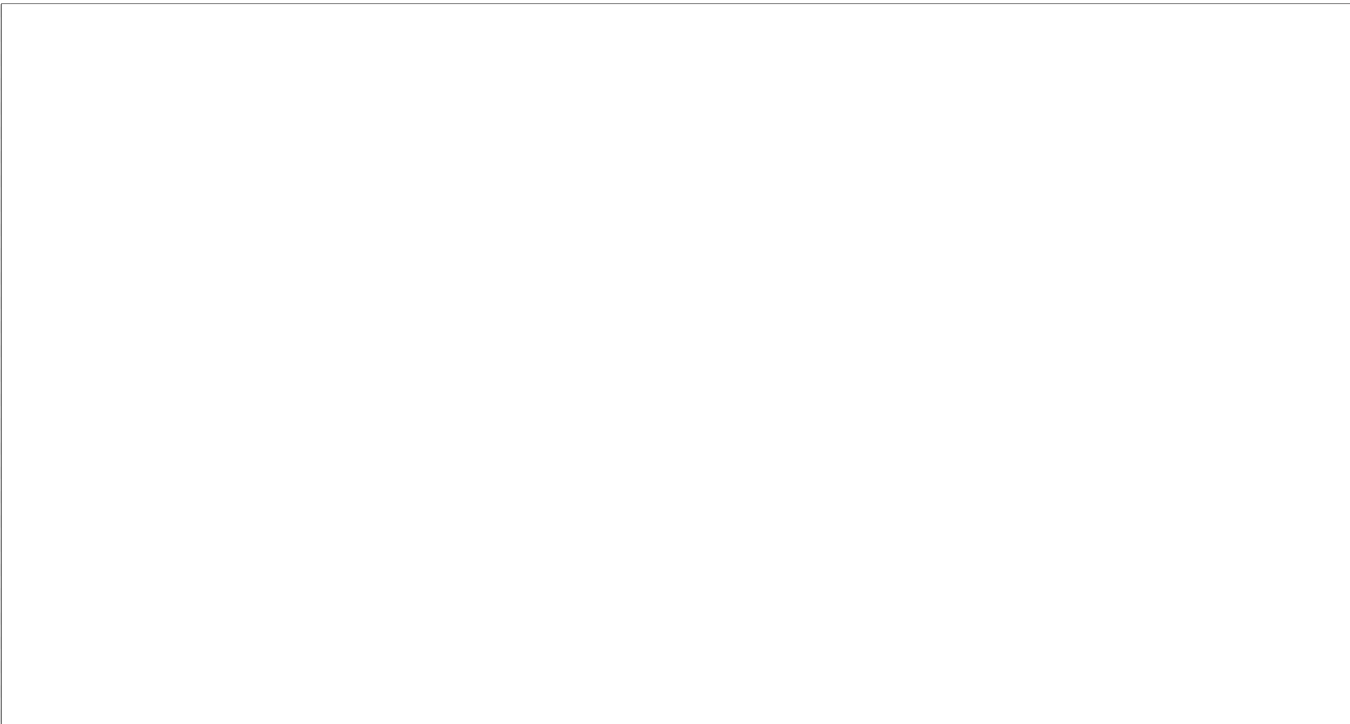
