EXPLANATION OF EXEMPTIONS

SUBSECTIONS OF TITLE 5, UNITED STATES CODE, SECTION 552

- (b)(1) (A) specifically authorized under criteria established by an Executive order to be kept secret in the interest of national defense or foreign policy and (B) are in fact properly classified to such Executive order;
- (b)(2) related solely to the internal personnel rules and practices of an agency;
- (b)(3) specifically exempted from disclosure by statute (other than section 552b of this title), provided that such statute (A) requires that the matters be withheld from the public in such a manner as to leave no discretion on issue, or (B) establishes particular criteria for withholding or refers to particular types of matters to be withheld;
- (b)(4) trade secrets and commercial or financial information obtained from a person and privileged or confidential;
- (b)(5) inter-agency or intra-agency memorandums or letters which would not be available by law to a party other than an agency in litigation with the agency;



Sorry to bother you with this, but given my old CD DAD job is posted, I need guidance on what my new position is and what legal authorities attach to it.	
Broadly, I need to be able to act at least in the capacity of my old CD DAD job – approve NSLs, conduct	
declassify information, agent travel, requisitions,	b3 -1
etc. Of those, the most problematic and one of the most essential is declassification authority. As I	b7E -4
understand it, declassification authorities are billet-limited by Division and position, and they are	
provided by DOJ, not by the FBI. CD has three. I understand the need to fill my position within CD, but	
I'd respectfully request based on mission need that I keep the authorities from my old job.	
If I "remain" in CD for billeting purposes (I don't know what would be entailed in creating a fourth paper DAD position), that would mean one of the DADs in CD would not have declass authority. Bill, I defer to you as to who would not have it. My initial thought is that Intel Branch doesn't declass nearly what Ops Branch I and II do, but I defer to you.	
There are certainly other solutions, but I don't want to be left without authorities if/when a new DAD is selected.	
Please let me know what I can do to help. Thanks for your consideration,
