Backgrounder

The “9/11 Khalid Shaikh Mohammad et al.” military commission is a joint trial of five defendants charged with conspiracy, attacking civilians, intentionally causing serious bodily injury, murder in violation of the law of war, hijacking or hazarding a vessel or aircraft, and terrorism. The U.S. government asserts that together the defendants planned, supplied, enabled

and worked to carry out the hijacking of the four airplanes used in the asymmetrical attacks of 11 September 2001. This military commission remains in the pre-trial phase.

ISN 10024 Khalid Sheikh Muhammed is a Kuwaiti or Pakistani citizen, approximately aged 54.

ISN 10013 Ramzi Bin Al Shibh is a Yemeni citizen, approximately aged 47.

ISN 10014 Walid Mohammed Bin Attash is a Yemeni citizen, approximately aged 41.

ISN 10018 Ali Abd Al Aziz Ali, known as Ammar Al Baluchi, is a Pakistani citizen, approximately aged 42.

ISN 10011 Mustafa Ahmed Al Hawsawi is a Saudi Arabian citizen, approximately aged 51.
