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#### STATEMENT OF WORK

#### 1.0 BACKGROUND, SCOPE, SERVICES AND GOALS

#### 1.1 Background.

The Inner Range of the Atlantic Fleet Weapons Training Facility at Vieques is critically important for the combat training and readiness of Atlantic-based naval forces. Its value lies in the unique opportunity it affords sailors and marines to conduct multi-dimensional, integrated live-fire combat training under realistic conditions prior to deployment overseas. The Vieques Inner Range provides an environment for the training and evaluation of major Fleet units in which a full range of warfare missions – land, sea, and air – can be joined. It is the only East Coast training site that offers a challenging live-fire target complex with immediately adjacent, large areas of low traffic density airspace and deep-water seaspace. It permits the measurement and evaluation of the capabilities and performance of equipment, weapons, and personnel, at the unit and individual level, and more importantly as an integrated combat team. It is the sole site available for Atlantic Fleet ships to conduct Naval Surface Fire Support training before deploying, and offers naval aviators the most realistic air-to-ground raining range, without restrictions on airspeed, altitude, or number of planes on target.

On January 31, 2000, the United States concluded an agreement with the Governor of Puerto Rico concerning the future use of Navy facilities on the island of Vieques. One of the provisions of the agreement provides for a referendum among the residents of Vieques as to whether the Navy may continue to use the facilities. Title XV of the 2001 National Defense Authorization Act mandates that "[t]he President shall provide for a referendum to be conducted on the island of Vieques, Puerto Rico, to determine by a majority of the votes cast in the referendum by the Vieques electorate whether the people of Vieques approve or disapprove if the continuation of the conduct of live-fire training, and any other types of training, by the Armed Forces at the Navy's training sites on the island..." This referendum is scheduled for November 6, 2001.

On January 2, 2001, a new Governor was elected to Puerto Rico who opposes Navy training at Vieques. Under the Governor, the Commonwealth of Puerto Rico has engaged in a well coordinated national and international communications campaign in an attempt to prevent the Navy from training at Vieques. The campaign includes the dissemination of inaccurate information and intensive lobbying.

The Navy wishes to facilitate the dissemination of accurate information to: (1) the residents of Vieques to ensure they are fully informed about the facts and issues relevant to the decision, and (2) national and international audiences, to counter the inaccurate information that has been issued by those who oppose Navy training at Vieques. Navy also desires expert counsel and advice on how to prepare for the 6 November 2001 referendum, and arrive at a long-term solution to the issue of maintaining a training range at Vieques beyond May 2003. Due to the proximity of the referendum, the Navy requires immediate advice and assistance concerning the most effective means of accomplishing these goals.

- 1.2 **Scope**. This statement of work (SOW) covers strategic counsel and implementation regarding the resumption and continuation of regularly scheduled realistic training at the US Naval Facility on Vieques, Puerto Rico.
- 1.3 Services. The Contractor shall provide strategic counsel related to communications and policy to the United States Navy (USN) with respect to the issue of Vieques. In particular, the Contractor will provide support to the design of communications initiatives associated with four (4) separate but related arenas: Local-Vieques, Commonwealth, Federal and International. The area of work will be associated with the design and delivery of accurate and timely information associated with this issue. These Services shall include, but not be limited to, the design and conveyance of information to senior government officials, opinion leaders at the local, state, and federal levels of government.

1.4 **Goals**. The Goal of this project is to provide accurate and timely information to appropriate audiences regarding the issue of regularly scheduled realistic training with respect to Vieques, Puerto Rico.

#### 2.0 TIMELINE AND REQUIREMENTS

2.1 **Timeline**. The timeline for this project is twenty-seven (27) weeks.

Stage 1: Conduct preliminary research, assemble project team; Provide counsel to Local arena

Stage 2: Conduct Strategic Planning Session; Commence contact with Federal and Commonwealth arenas Continue Research Review International arena Provide counsel to Local arena

Stage 3: Continue contact with Federal and Commonwealth arenas Continue Research Continue review International arena Continue counsel to Local arena

Stage 4: Evaluate findings and draft report and briefing. Produce final report and briefing.

#### 2.2 Specific Tasks:

Task 1 - Identify Information Needs.

The contractor shall assess the extent to which each arena is presently aware or unaware of the facts and issues relevant to the January 31 Agreement concerning the Navy's future use of facilities on Vieques. Based on this assessment, the contractor shall identify those facts and issues for which the dissemination of accurate information is needed to facilitate an informed decision with respect to the upcoming referendum.

Task 2 - Develop a Communications Plan.

Based on the results of Task 1, the contractor shall develop a strategic communications plan that could be implemented prior to the Vieques referendum. The strategic communications plan shall consist, at a minimum, of the following:

a. recommended strategies and methods to assist the Navy to ensure that accurate and comprehensive information is prepared and disseminated;

b. a process to provide Navy leadership advice and assistance concerning the dissemination of information for the duration of the strategic communications plan;

- c. a process to assess the efficacy of the dissemination of information pursuant to the communications plan and to modify the strategic communications plan on the basis of such assessments, if necessary; and
- d. a process to report regularly to Navy leadership concerning the contractor's progress and efforts during the implementation of the strategic communications plan.

Task 3 - Provide a Plan of Action and Milestones and Implement Plan.

The contractor shall provide a plan of action and milestones for implementation of the strategic communications plan developed under Task 2, and implement same.

- 2.3 **Resources**. The Contractor will make available senior communications strategists on a regular basis to review the situation and to engage as appropriate. In addition, the Contractor has or will acquire the appropriate resources to provide the services and products as required in the conduct of this contract.
- 2.4 **Reports**. The Contractor shall provide regular status reports and recommendations as required by the U. S. Navy.
- 2.5 **Travel**. The Contractor is authorized to travel to Puerto Rico and other destinations subject to approval by The US Navy.
- 2.6 **Status and Cost Reports.** The Contractor will submit a monthly status report detailing management, financial, costs, schedules, and technical progress and project issues. The report shall document highlights of the current reporting period and the previous reporting period, the plans for the upcoming period(s), the critical issues, and the status of general tasks. Data in the reports shall include identification of the amount of funds received, percentage of received funds spent, percentage of work completed (both actual and "earned value"), and an estimate of future monthly spending until contract completion or termination.
