Mike, the typical flight time to San Francisco is 5+45 this time of year. Given the varying aircraft capabilities and conditions, the following refueling guidelines would come into play:

- The C-32 (Boeing 757) has a max itinerary time of 8+00 and can make it non-stop both ways.
- The C-40B (Boeing 737) has a max itinerary time of 10+30 and can make it non-stop both ways.
- The C-37 (Gulfstream V) has a max itinerary time of 11+30 and can make it non-stop both ways.
- The C-20 (Gulfstream III) has a max itinerary time of 5+30 (so this would need to stop for fuel heading west -- depending on the winds). Travelling east, it should be able to make it back without fuel.
- The Guard C-38 (Westwind Astra) has a max itinerary time of 4+30 (so this would have to stop for fuel).

For this weekend, the forecast is that winds heading to the west coast are very strong, thus likely forcing the C20B to stop for fuel tomorrow (generally, in the winter, the winds may prevent the C20B from making it nonstop to the west).

Thank you for your courtesy Mike.

If you don't mind, I'd like to offer some additional background. As we discussed in our recent meeting, the CODEL limits for Iraq and Afghanistan have been set for sometime due to the security and logistics demands associated with supporting Member of Congress movements in Iraq. These limits enable the Command and the Embassy to provide for the protection and movement of DVs without unduly exposing them to increased risk, and provide a methodology/CONOPs that allow State and DoD to resource this mission appropriately. Also, you should know that CENTCOM and State have held these standards consistent for all trips going into the AOR.

Mr. Wilkie asked me to pass on that the CODEL needs to conform to these standards, suggesting that staff might be reduced. If you travel with 6 Members, and 1 Escort (which must stay with the CODEL), you'll have room for five additional staff.

We look forward to discussing this further. We would respectfully ask that you comply with this protocol due the security and safety imperatives associated with travel in a combat zone.

In an effort to ensure that the legislative and executive branches of the U.S. Government deliver the same message that Syria must change its behavior on a broad range of issues of concern, the Department continues to advise against Congressional travel to Damascus. High-level U.S. visitors to Damascus complicate our efforts to dissuade regional partners and others from visiting Syria and send the Syrians and the world the wrong message. The Syrians are always looking for a way out of their isolation and tend to misinterpret and misrepresent messages delivered by high-level visitors, regardless of how strong a message is delivered privately. High-level visits to Syria, such as those by Senators Nelson, Dodd, Specter and Kerry last Christmas, were exploited by the regime to demonstrate a degree of legitimacy and international acceptance that the regime has done nothing to merit. Although each delegation met with Syrian officials in order to deliver a tough message to the regime, in each case, the visit itself become the message delivered by the Syrian Government and the Syrian press.

Syrian activities continue to undermine the prospects for peace and stability throughout the region. Issues of U.S. concern include the Syrian Government's:

- (1) failure to prevent Syria from being a transit point for foreign fighters entering Iraq who attack Americans and Iraqis,
- (2) refusal to deport from Syria former Saddam regime elements who actively support the insurgency in Iraq,
- (3) ongoing interference in internal Lebanese affairs and active support for the terrorist organization Hizballah,
- (4) the safe haven it provides to Palestinian terrorist groups which have been operationally active from Syrian soil, and
- (5) its deplorable human rights record.

In May 2004, the Bush Administration, pursuant to the provisions of the Syrian Accountability and Lebanese Sovereignty Restoration Act, imposed sanctions on Syria which banned nearly all exports to Syria except food and medicine. Subsequent to the Hariri assassination, the U.S. recalled its ambassador to Syria in February 2005. Recent attacks in Lebanon are particularly unsettling, as are Syrian efforts to block the establishment of a Tribunal of international character to try those implicated in the assassination of Lebanese Prime Minister Rafik Hariri and others.

On numerous occasions U.S. officials have spoken candidly and firmly with the Syrian Government about U.S. concerns. A summary of the visits follows:

May 2003	Secretary of State Colin Powell met with Syrian President Bashar al-Asad in Damascus
August 2003	Department of State Assistant Secretary for Near Eastern Affairs Bill Burns met with Syrian President Bashar al-Asad in Damascus, along with CIA and NSC reps

September 2004	Department of State Assistant Secretary for Near Eastern Affairs Bill Burns and Department of Defense Assistant Secretary Peter Rodman met with Syrian President Bashar al-Asad in Damascus
September 2004	Secretary of State Colin Powell met with then Syrian Foreign Minister Farouk al-Shara'a in New York
November 2004	Secretary of State Colin Powell met with then Syrian Foreign Minister Farouk al-Shara'a in Sharm el-Sheikh
January 2005	Deputy Secretary of State Richard Armitage met with Syrian President Bashar al-Asad in Damascus

In each of these efforts, the U.S. told the Syrians that we would judge their intentions based on deeds, not words. In each case, the Syrian Government promised to take action against the flow of foreign fighters into Iraq, to end their interference in Lebanon, to expel Palestinian terrorist leaders from Damascus, and to end Syrian state sponsorship of terrorism. For a year and a half the U.S. engaged with the Syrian Government on these important issues. Three and a half years later, there has been no demonstrable action on the part of the SARG to live up to its commitments or provide gestures of goodwill.

The USG, together with the international community, is focused on protecting the future of the democratically elected Lebanese Government, which is currently at risk of collapse due to ongoing interference by the Syrian regime and its allies in Lebanon. The murder of Lebanese Minister of Industry Pierre Gemayel is particularly shocking, in light of reports of ongoing Syrian interference to derail the Hariri tribunal. High-level engagement with the SARG will undermine the Lebanese Government and reinforce Lebanese fears that the U.S. is willing to sell out Lebanon to Syria.

Our policy of isolating the Syrian regime has borne fruit in the past by deterring the travel of regional leaders and helping form a consensus in the Security Council on the need for Syria to cooperate fully with the UNIIIC investigation. The Syrian Government has been put on notice that the international community will take steps to ensure that those responsible for this and related assassinations, assassination attempts, and other terrorist attacks will be brought to justice. We ask that you support our efforts by not further rewarding the Syrian Government.
