In both requests, Mexico requests information about the investigation, and in at least the second request, asks to interview **ATF** ATF's responses do not apparently provide factual information, but instead indicate that this is an ongoing investigation and any such requests should be made to DC (it is possible that the documents say more than that though as Chris was giving me a quick and rough translation).

Our OIA team apparently did not learn about this until after ATF received and responded to the Mexico requests – as you can imagine, they were not very pleased.
