Of the 4 empty FN gun boxes 3 were purchased by 2 different straw purchasers from Fast and Furious, both who have been indicted and arrested. (The plastic gun box has a serial number sticker on the outside of the box.)

At 2 other locations (which to the best of my knowledge SA **DEA** was not called on?) the DEA also recovered firearms from Fast and Furious:





In summary 47 of the 60 firearms appear to be purchased by suspects associated with Fast & Furious, and 3 of the 4 empty gun boxes appear to be purchased by suspects associated with Fast & Furious.
