The precise number of guns tied to F and F has been verified by our trial team and case agents Friday. By "tied to" we mean a charged F and F defendant bought the guns, or a purchaser bought the guns who is a suspect and who is

likely to be charged in the second round of F and F indictments.

The numbers are these: 44 of the 46 guns recovered from a BMW car stop were from Fast and Furious as defined above, 4 of 7 guns recovered from Hazelwood House search warrant were from Fast and Furious, and 3 of the 7 guns recovered from the San Miguel Search warrant were from F and F as defined above, **for a total of 51 out of 60 guns** recovered in the Phoenix Metropolitan area the week of April 11, 2011 in the DEA Cruz case were from Fast and Furious purchasers. These weapons were purchased mostly in Nov and Dec of 2009, and consist of 50 assault type weapons and one pistol from our review of the ATF spreadsheets.
