He told me that they CODEL wanted to learn more about the issue including, how firearms are traced, how the US works with Mexico, how we exchange information, and did the GOM feel they were informed about the operation which let arms flow into Mexico. They would also like to gain a better understanding of the magnitude of the violence at the border.
