The licensee contacted Springfield Armory who verified that they did not ship the firearm to the licensee (Exhibit 6 and Worksheet 1). IOI ATF ontacted Springfield Armory via email to confirm that the firearm was never shipped to the licensee. Springfield Armory replied that the firearm was defective and remained at their facility (Exhibit 6). IOI ATF asked the licensee why an entry was made into the A/D record for a firearm that was never received. ATF stated that they frequently receive firearms from manufactures that do not match the serial numbers on the invoice or case. The serial number was mistakenly taken from the case or invoice and not the firearm. The licensee was not cited for this entry.
