1. Recently, Chairman Issa sent a letter to **State** in which he cited to a Fox News report stating that two Fast and Furious guns were used in the kidnapping and murder of the brother of the former Attorney General of Chihuahua.

2. We've been told by ATF that when Mexican law enforcement raided the kidnappers' compound, they seized a number of firearms, two of which tie back to Fast and Furious.

3. While it may be an overstatement to say that the guns were "used" in the murder, the core allegation appears to be true - namely, that the kidnappers/murderers were in possession of two guns that tie back to Fast and Furious.
