That said, the incomplete traces could conceivably include a purchase made by one of our targets that we did not know about (some other FFL, earlier date, etc.) If I have learned anything, until we have all the traces done, I can't state with certainty that another recovered gun will not come back to FF. Today, it is just the two.

Sorry this took so long. The two guns out of the sixteen recovered that trace back to Fast and Furious are as follows:

GP WASR-10 Rifle 7.62 S/N: 1965BA903 purchased by ATF (indicted) on Monday 12/14/09. We did not have eyes on and were notified after the purchase. This was one of 43 firearms he purchased on a single transaction at ATF that day. See ROI 48 attached for details of the purchase and notification to us.

GP WASR-10 Rifle 7.62 S/N: AH 6830-1989 purchased by ATF (indicted) on Saturday 1/30/10 after he was a suspect in the case. We did not have eyes on and were notified after the purchase. This was one of 16 firearms he purchased on a single transaction at ATF that day. See ROI 82 attached for details of the purchase and notification to us.

The remainder of the traces on the other 14 guns are still in progress.
