ATF we just got back from viewing some guns that were taken last night from a group of gunmen tied to the "el teo" organization. Supposedly they were on their way to kill the Public Safety Secretary Lt Col. ATF when they were intercepted by the State Police (PEP). They were armed with five long guns and five handguns, vests etc .

From examination of the guns these look like the same type of weapons that are coming from Phoenix and that we have been seen in other cases tied to El Teo.

Below are the guns.

Four of the guns are Romania, Romarm GP WASR 10/63 UP AK-47 type rifles, 7.62X39mm, all had been converted to fire full auto and were in good condition. The Importer, as in the others, is CAI, Georgia, VT. With the following serial numbers: ATF

One is an Alexander Arms LLC, US Army Radford Arsenal, BEOWULF .50 caliber rifle, made on a Rock River Arms LAR-15 receiver, Cleveland, Ill, serial number obliterated

Two are FN HERSTAL 5 7 semi-auto pistols, caliber 5.7mmX28mm, imported by FNH USA, Fredricksburg, VA one obliterated serial number the other ATF

One Ruger P94, 9mm pistol, serial ATF made in Southport, Conn, USA by Ruger

One EAA Witness, caliber .38 super, semi-auto pistol, serial number ATF made in Italy imported by EAA Cocoa, Fla

One Smith and Wesson, Model 39-2, 9mm semi-auto pistol, serial number
