Project Gunrunner

ATF has established four main objectives for Project Gunrunner:

1. Investigate individuals responsible for illicit firearms trafficking along the Southwest border.
2. Coordinate with U.S. and Mexican law enforcement along the border in firearms cases and violent crime.
3. Train U.S. and Mexican law enforcement officials to identify firearms traffickers and provide outreach education to gun dealers.
4. Trace all firearms to identify firearms traffickers, trends, patterns, and networks.

Background

ATF's Project Gunrunner – was launched in April, 2005 due to ATF forecasting, based on our unique historical experience and expertise combating firearms trafficking along the Southwest Border (SWB), that because of President Calderon's tough rhetoric against the Mexican drug trafficking organizations (DTOs) during his presidential campaign violence was going to drastically increase and along with it the trafficking of firearms to Mexico. This was in fact realized and the ongoing drug war in Mexico between the DTOs themselves, and the Government of Mexico against the DTOs, has created a lucrative firearms trafficking market.

Firearms are the DTOs "tools of the trade", as they are with violent criminals all over the world. A large percentage of the firearms being seized from Mexican DTOs and traced through ATF's National Tracing Center are of U.S.-source, that is either U.S. manufactured or imported into the U.S. legally.

The DTOs are interested in specific types of firearms or "weapons of choice" based on a specific need due to the ballistic characteristics and capabilities of certain types of firearms. The classification "weapons of choice" is based on the analysis by ATF of firearms traces out of Mexico and along the SWB. Current "weapons of Choice" trends include an increased interest over the past two years in .50 caliber rifles (penetrate armored vehicles) and 5.7x28mm caliber firearms (ability to penetrate certain levels of ballistic vests) as well as the traditional .223 and 7.62 caliber "assault-type" firearms.

Not just firearms but ammunition – ammo for weapons of choice is in very large demand in Mexico and short supply here in the U.S. 75-100 round drum magazines are in very high demand as well and have been seized in increasing numbers in Mexico over the past year.

Grenade issue – Hand and Rifle grenades are quickly becoming a new “weapon of choice”. Central American black market is a factor and concern as is those individuals in the U.S. who see an opportunity to make a profit by illegally manufacturing “homemade” grenades.

Signs of Success:

1. ATF and Mexican intelligence that the DTOs are becoming increasingly frustrated with our combined efforts to address the illegal trafficking of firearms from the U.S. to Mexico
2. Increase in price of trafficked firearms in Mexico
3. Smaller purchases by straws – no longer do we see the 15-20 purchased during a single transaction
4. The use of other firearms trafficking routes, e.g. Guatemala
5. Serial Number obliteration increasing

Main Focus – Work closely with our U.S. and Mexican law enforcement counterparts to focus ATF efforts on those criminal organizations that are illegally trafficking in firearms to violent drug trafficking organizations operating on both sides of the U.S./Mexico border. Main point is that we are focused on eliminating the **Illegal Sources** of firearms to these violent criminals as well as working with the industry to educate and alert them to the illegal schemes being used by the DTOs to acquire firearms in the United States. Finally, through joint efforts with the industry like the National Shooting Sports Foundation’s “Don’t Lie for the Other Guy” campaign, we strive to educate the public to the illegality of “straw purchasing” firearms, especially for those intent on trafficking them to Mexico and into the hands of violent DTO members.

- ii. Joint Investigations & Intelligence
 1. With U.S. LE – OCDETF Strike Force, etc
 2. With Mexican LE – PGR GC-Armas, CENAPI, SSP, etc.
 3. Use of ATF Intel, eTrace and NTC resources like Violent Crime Analysis Branch; use of EPIC, HIDTA, etc
- b. Industry Compliance/Cooperation**
 - i. FFL and Public Outreach
 1. Compliance Inspections at FFLs
 2. Partnership with Industry – Education and Exchange of Information
 3. “Don’t Lie for the Other Guy” with NSSF
- c. Training of Mexican and U.S. LE**
 - i. Firearms Id and Tracing
 - ii. Serial Number restoration
 - iii. Explosives Id and Safe-Handling

Phoenix Field Division growth as a result of Project Gunrunner funding:

- New Groups in Phoenix and Tucson, which are based out of the OCDETF Strike Forces due to the role ATF can play in dismantling the firearms trafficking activities of identified CPOTs and RPOTs.
- New Field Office in Las Cruces with a Satellite Office in Roswell.
- Additional Special Agents, Industry Operations Investigators, Intelligence Research Specialists and Investigative Analysts

Lastly:

- ATF’s unique statutory authority and investigative purview in identifying and disrupting not only the illicit **sources** of firearms bound for Mexico, but also in identifying and dismantling the criminal infrastructures that the DTO's exploit to acquire US sourced firearms, is key in addressing the firearms related violence on both sides of the SWB.

- Interdiction alone is not the answer, but instead is one tool in any successful strategy to stop guns from going to Mexico. ATF is the only agency having the expertise and authority to address the problem at the "source". Our strategy should be and is proactive, not solely reactive.
- The violence is not limited to the Mexican side of the border but affects the U.S. Border States too. In Phoenix, Arizona the nearly 400 kidnappings and home invasions - most by rival criminal groups - mimic closely the 500 or so kidnappings in Mexico City. ATF's primary focus on violent crime puts it in a unique position to proactively and positively affect the violence currently being experienced along the SWB due to the ongoing drug war in Mexico.
