
. THE FOLLOWING FEI/DHS BULLETIN IS BEING RETRANSMITTED TO :SOS TO ADVISE RECIPIENTS OF THE POSSIBLE IMPACTS OF THE EPTEMBER 1, 2004 CHECKEN AFFILIATED TERRORIST ATTACK ON THE CHOOL IN BESLAN, NORTH OSSETIA, RUSSIA, AND TO PROVIDE ROTECTIVE MEASURE GUIDANCE.

THERE IS NO IMMINENT THREAT TO U.S. SCHOOLS AND THE GROUP HAT CONDUCTED THE OPERATION HAS NEVER ATTACKED OR THREATENED O ATTACK US INTERESTS. HOWEVER, THE EXTENSIVE MEDIA OVERAGE AND THE HIGH CASUALTY RATE GENERATED BY THE INCIDENT

IN BESLAN WARRANT A SUMMARY OF LESSONS LEARNED FROM THAT INCIDENT AND PROTECTIVE MEASURE GUIDANCE FOR NELFING TO PREVENT AND RESPOND TO A SIMILAR TERRORIST ATTACK WERE IT TO OCCUT IN THE UNITED STATES.



- 4. RECIPIENTS ARE REMINDED THAT THE INTELLIGENCE BULLETIN IS DESIGNATED "SENSITIVE BUT UNCLASSIFIED AND FOR OFFICIAL USE ONLY" AND SHOULD NOT BE DISSEMINATED BEYOND LAW ENFORCEMENT CIRCLES.
- 5. PRELIMINARY ANALYSIS OF THE PLANNING AND TACTICS REPORTEDLY USED BY THE TERRORIST ASSAULT TEAM AGAINST THE BESLAN SCHOOL AND THE RUSSIAN AUTHORITIES' RESPONSE TO THE CRISIS HAS IDENTIFIED SEVERAL ITEMS THAT LAW ENFORCEMENT AND SCHOOL ADMINISTRATION AND SECURITY PERSONNEL MAY CONSIDER WHEN DEVELOPING SCHOOL SECURITY AND EMERGENCY RESPONSE PLANS.
- 6. REPORTING INDICATES THAT APPROXIMATELY THIRTY TERRORISTS USED A STOLEN POLICE OR MILITARY TRUCK FOR TRANSPORTATION TO THE SCHOOL GROUNDS. UPON ARRIVING AT THE SCHOOL, THE TERRORISTS REPORTEDLY WERE STOPPED AT A GATE BY A FOUR-PERSON SUARD FORCE THAT HAD BEEN STATIONED AT THE SCHOOL TO INCREASE THE PROTECTION AT SENSITIVE ESTABLISHMENTS, WHICH INCLUDED SCHOOLS IN THE CAUCASUS REGION. AS THE SECURITY GUARDS—CONDUCTED AN IDENTIFICATION CHECK, THE TERRORISTS REPORTEDLY DPENED FIRE, KILLING TWO AND INJURING TWO. THEY ALSO KILLED SIX PARENTS WHO RUSHED TO THE ASSISTANCE OF THE SECURITY SUARDS.
- 7. THERE ARE STRONG INDICATIONS THAT THE TERRORISTS HAD PRE-POSITIONED A LARGE CACHE OF WEAPONS, INCLUDING EXPLOSIVES AND AMMUNITION, WITHIN THE SCHOOL BUILDING PRIOR TO THE ATTACK. THEY MAY HAVE EITHER UTILIZED A GROUP OF ETHNIC PRECHEMS INVOLVED IN RENOVATION WORK AT SCHOOLS IN THE REGION OVER THE SUMMER TO HIDE THE WEAPONS UNDER THE FLOOR OF THE ICHOOL, OR POSED AS CONSTRUCTION WORKERS TO SMUGGLE THE VEAPONS INSIDE. REPORTING SUGGESTS THAT THE WEAPONS MAY HAVE BEEN DISGUISED AS CONSTRUCTION EQUIPMENT EMPLACED AT THE


SCHOOL. IN ADDITION TO STORING WEAPONS, A SCHOOL WORKER REPORTED THAT HE OBSERVED FALSE-FRONTED WALLS, WHICH PRIOR TO THE ATTACK WERE COVERED IN TEMPORARY STUCCO, THAT WERE GOUGED OUT GURING THE STAND-OFF TO SERVE AS SHELTERED FIRING POSITIONS. IF TIESE ACCOUNTS ARE TRUE, "HIS WOULD INDICATE THAT THE ATTACKELS AND BEEN PLINNING THE ATTACK FOR MONTHS, WOULD HAVE HAD DETAILED KNOWLENGE OF THE FACILITY GROUNDS AND BUILDING INTERIORS, AND YOULD HAVE LIKELY BEEN CONFUCTIONS OF PRE-OPERATIONAL SURVEILLANCE OF BUILDING OFFERATIONS AND STAFF.

- 8. REPORTS CONCERNING THE TERRORISTS' ACTIONS ONCE INSIDE THE SCHOOL BUILDING PROVIDE SOME INDICATION THAT CHECKEN AFFILIATED TERRORISTS ARE APPLYING LESSONS LEARNED FROM PREVIOUS OPERATIONS WITHIN RUSSIA.
- -- USING THE EXPERIENCE GAINED FROM THE OCTOBER 2002 MOSCOW THEATER HOSTAGE CRISIS WHERE RUSSIAN AUTHORITIES UTILIZED AN INCAPACITATING AGENT AGAINST THE TERRORISTS AND HOSTAGES, THE TERRORISTS REPORTEDLY KNOCKED OUT ALL THE WINDOWS IN THE GYMASIUM WHERE THE HOSTAGES WERE BEING HELD TO IMPROVE VENTILATION WITH THE HOSE OF REGATING ANY USE OF INCAPACITATING GASES. SOME REPORTING ALSO SUGGESTS THAT THE BESLAN ATTACKERS HAD GAS MASKS AND BROUGHT DOGS TO ALERT THEM TO THE USE OF GAS.
- -- TERRORISTS REPORTEDLY SEPARATED THE CHILDREN FROM THE PARENTS AND TEACHERS AND PLACED SOME OF THE CHILDREN NEAR THE WINDOWS TO DISCOURAGE ATTEMPTS BY SECURITY FORCES TO RAID THE BUILDING.
- -- THE TERRORISTS WIRED THE SCHOOL BUILDING GYMNASIUM AND SURROUNDING AREA WITH AT LEAST FIFTEEN IMPROVISED EXPLOSIVE DEVICES (IEDS) AND/OR MINES. IN ADDITION, REPORTING INDICATES THAT SEVERAL ASSAULT LEADERS MAY HAVE HAD THE CAPABILITY TO DETONATE ALL OF THE EXPLOSIVES, AS WELL AS THE SUICIDE BELTS WORN BY THE TWO FEMALE TERRORISTS. THIS DIFFERS FROM THE 2002 MOSCOW THEATER ATTACK IN WHICH, APPARENTLY, NO ONE TERRORIST HAD THE CAPABILITY TO DETONATE ALL OF THE EXPLOSIVES. ACCORDING TO A VARIETY OF REPORTING, NO SINGLE RUSSIAN GOVERNMENT AGENCY HAD CLEAR ON-SCENE COMMAND AND CONTROL OF THE NUMEROUS FEDERAL AND REGIONAL CIVILIAN AND MILITARY AUTHORITIES. THE OUTCOME OF THE ATTACK UPON THE SCHOOL IN BESLAN AFFIRMS THE IMPORTANCE OF ESTABLISHING A THOROUGH RESPONSE PLAN THAT OUTLINES CLEAR COMMAND AND CONTROL RESPONSIBILITIES IN THE EVENT OF A POTENTIAL TERRORIST OR HOSTAGE SITUATION. IN ADDITION, THE DIFFICULTY EXPERIENCED BY RUSSIAN AUTHORITIES IN MAINTAINING AN EFFECTIVE CORDON DURING THE BESLAN INCIDENT HIGHLIGHTS THE IMPORTANCE OF ESTABLISHING AND MAINTAINING A SECURE PERIMETER.








10. THE FOLLOWING ACTIVITIES MAY SUGGEST TERRORIST SURVEILLANCE OF EDUCATIONAL FACILITIES. 11. LAW ENFORCEMENT AGENCIES, SECURITY PERSONNEL, AND EDUCATIONAL ADMINISTRATORS SHOULD BE AWARE AND REMAIN ALERT TO INDICATORS OF SURVEILLANCE ACTIVITIES. LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICERS ARE ENCOURAGED TO MAINTAIN LIAISON WITH LOCAL SCHOOL ADMINISTRATORS IN THEIR RESPECTIVE JURISDICTIONS AND ASK PERSONNEL TO REPORT SUSPICIOUS ACTIVITIES. SCHOOL OFFICIALS ARE ENCOURAGED TO REVIEW AND UPDATE THEIR EVACUATION PLANS AS WELL AS SECURITY AND EMERGENCY POLICIES. IN ADDITION TO PLANNING AND THE NEED FOR FREQUENT EXERCISES INVOLVING BOTH THE SCHOOLS AND THE PIRST RESPONDER COMMUNITY (LAW ENFORCEMENT AND FIRE/EMS), PLANNING AND EXERCISES SHOULD INVOLVE THE LOCAL MEDICAL COMMUNITY TO ENSURE THAT MASS CASUALTY CONTINGENCIES ARE FULLY COVERED. EMERGENCY MEDICAL TREATMENT FOR CHILDREN IS SIGNIFICANTLY DIFFERENT FROM ADULTS AND SHOULD BE FACTORED INTO ANY PLAN OR EXERCISE. IN CONJUNCTION WITH THIS JOINT INTELLIGENCE BULLETIN, THE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION WILL DISSEMINATE THIS INFORMATION IN 1TS OWN FORMAT TO ITS CONSTITUENTS USING DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION CHANNELS.
