Complaint for Injunctive Relief. This Court therefore issues a Permanent Injunction ordering, restraining and enjoining Defendants and their agents, servants and employees and representatives from enforcing Special Order No. 7.

- 3. Pursuant to the Court's order granting Plaintiff Harold P. Sturgeon's Motion for Summary Judgment, Plaintiff Harold P. Sturgeon is entitled to judgment on the First Cause of Action in Plaintiff Sturgeon's Complaint for Declaratory and Injunctive Relief. Specifically, the Court hereby judicially determines and declares that Special Order No. 7 conflicts with the provisions of the California Vehicle Code, including California Vehicle Code Sections 14602.6 and 14607.6, governing the impounding of vehicles driven by unlicensed drivers and therefore is *ultra vires* under Vehicle Code Section 21, is preempted by the Vehicle Code, and is unlawful and void.
- 4. Pursuant to the Court's order granting Plaintiff Harold P. Sturgeon's Motion for Summary Judgment, Plaintiff Harold P. Sturgeon is entitled to judgment on the Second Cause of Action in Plaintiff's Complaint for Injunctive Relief. This Court therefore issues a Permanent Injunction ordering, restraining and enjoining Defendants and their agents, servants and employees and representatives from expending taxpayer funds or taxpayer-financed resources, including their own time or the time of other LAPD officers, employees, or officials, to enforce, maintain, or otherwise carry out Special Order No. 7.
- 5. Plaintiffs Los Angeles Police Protective League and Harold P. Sturgeon may file Motions for Attorney's Fees against Defendants City of Los Angeles and Charlie Beck, Chief of Police pursuant to a duly noticed Motion.
- 6. As the prevailing parties, Plaintiffs Los Angeles Police Protective League and Harold P. Sturgeon are entitled to costs incurred in prosecuting this action pursuant to a memorandum of costs.
