Synopsis: (cont.):

At approximately 5:55 a.m., Mexican LEAs were performing a warrant service at the Represito Ranch in Mexico. The ranch is located approximately a half mile south of the International Border, south of Horse Peak in the 3 Points Station AOR.

Agents from the Tucson Sector Foreign Operations Branch were parked Approximately 100 yards north of the Border on the U.S. Side when they observed a Mexican LEA helicopter cross north into the U.S. for approximately 100 yards. The agents then heard and observed two rounds being shot from the helicopter which landed approximately 15 yards to the side of one of the unmarked Border Patrol Vehicles (FOB) they were driving. Also, there were two marked units at the scene next to the unmarked as well. So one unmarked and two marked.

The agents immediately turned on their emergency equipment at which time the helicopter returned south into Mexico. No agents were hurt and there was no damage to GOV property.

The FOB Agents were not involved in the operation and had set up north in the U.S. in order to observe (b) (7)(E)

Agents ultimately observed (from a high point in the U.S.) approximately 45 individuals being taken into custody by Mexican LEA.

CIT notified but declined to respond.
