STATUS REPORT

Defendant United States Department of State (“State”) submits this status report, pursuant to the Court’s minute order of October 20, 2015, which adopted State’s proposed schedule and ordered State to file a status report disclosing the number of additional emails to or from former Secretary of State Hillary Clinton responsive to the FOIA request,¹ including those documents recently provided by Huma Abedin, Cheryl Mills, and Jacob Sullivan that contain emails to or from former Secretary Clinton. State has completed the search and found 23 additional responsive emails to or from former Secretary Clinton.²

¹ The FOIA request seeks “records concerning, regarding, or related to notes, updates, or reports created in response to the September 11, 2012 attack on the U.S. Consulate in Benghazi, Libya,” and is limited to the time frame “September 11-15, 2012.”

² State has conducted a review to identify any such documents that are duplicates of documents that have already been produced to Plaintiff, but it is possible that additional duplicate documents may be identified during the process of reviewing the responsive documents for exempt information that must be redacted. If this occurs, those documents will not be produced a second time.
