MINUTE ORDER. In light of [21] the parties' joint status report, it is ORDERED that 1) by November 2, 2015, defendant shall produce to plaintiff the responsive records it has already identified; 2) by November 30, 2015, defendant shall produce to plaintiff the non-exempt portions of those records not yet reviewed that do not have to be referred to one or more agencies, and refer all other responsive records to the appropriate agency or agencies; 3) within two weeks of the completion of all inter-agency consultations for a given record, defendant shall produce any non-exempt portion of that record to plaintiff; and 4) by December 7, 2015, the parties shall file another joint report on the status of the production of the remaining documents.
