PLAINTIFF JUDICIAL WATCH'S NOTICE OF ADDITIONAL RELEVANT EVIDENCE

- 1. Along with its January 22, 2016 reply brief, Plaintiff submitted additional evidence that demonstrates that the knowledge of the "clintonemail.com" record system was widespread throughout the State Department.
- 2. Specifically, Plaintiff submitted an August 20, 2011 email that showed that senior management at the State Department was well aware that Mrs. Clinton was using a "non-state.gov" record system to conduct official government business. In addition, the email suggested that senior management was concerned that records on the "clintonemail.com" system were not being managed in a way that would allow for the State Department to search those records in response to FOIA requests.
- 3. Plaintiff just recently received additional evidence that demonstrates that senior management at the State Department was well aware that Mrs. Clinton was using a "non-state.gov" system to conduct official government business. This evidence also shows that the senior management at the State Department knowingly aided Mrs. Clinton in establishing and using a "non-state.gov" system.

- 4. On January 23, 2009, just two days after Mrs. Clinton was sworn in as Secretary of State on January 21, 2009, Ms. Mills emailed Lewis Lukens, then-Executive Director of the State Department's Executive Secretariat, and asked:
 - 1. [C]an our email be accessed remotely through the web using a non-DOC computer like my laptop?
 - 2. I am travelling to the M-E tonight will my DOS bb work there and is there a cell phone attached?
 - 3. [I] spoke to Dan re: bb for HRC (and reports that POTUS is able to use a super encrypted one[])
 - 4. [I] spoke to Dan re: setting up Counselor office for HRC so she can go across hall regularly and check her email.¹

In response to question four, Mr. Lukens responded, "Will set up the office across the hall as requested. Also think we should go ahead (but will await your green light) and set up a stand alone PC in the Secretary's office, connect to the Internet (but not through our system) to enable her to check her emails from her desk." Mr. Lukens sent this email to Ms. Mills' non-state.gov email address and also carbon copied Ms. Abedin on her non-state.gov email address, Mr. Kennedy, and Daniel Smith, then-Executive Secretary of the State Department. In response, Mr. Kennedy stated, "The stand-alone separate network PC is [a] great idea."

5. Like the August 20, 2011 email, this newly discovered email demonstrates that there is at least a "reasonable suspicion" that the State Department and Mrs. Clinton deliberately thwarted FOIA by creating, using, and concealing the "clintonemail.com" record system for six years.

Plaintiff received this record in response to another FOIA request to the State Department. The entire email chain as received by Plaintiff is attached as Exhibit A.
