Attached is the white paper I received this morning [Redacted] and the email strings between [Redacted] and others in NSA regarding this subject. [Redacted] advised in a telecon I had with him that another paper is forthcoming that will cover what he's provided and maybe a little more. I asked if cost is going to be addressed. He doesn't know. I responded to [Redacted] email that the Secretary returns Sunday from her trip, that Pat Donovan tasked us with a memo that he wanted by today and that we finished last night and that it outlines the vulnerabilities and risks of BB use inside and outside a SCIF (because they're essentially the same) and concludes with our collaboration with NSA to seek an acceptable solution for their desired BB use. I also asked if the forthcoming paper is going to include an estimated timeline and cost for modification of devices. So I'll let you know what I get back. I don't think there's anything here that needs to be included in our current draft memo, but please review and see what you think. Thanks. [Redacted]
