As the CGI coincides with the UN meeting and also the G20, we should explore the idea of whether we could bring together and participation of both the British and Irish Prime Ministers under the auspices of the CGI. The theme could be 'Implementing Peace'. The session would explore the steps for the

peace and political process in NI and obviously a session could have wider application into say the Middle East peace and political process.

To take this forward it would be helpful to explore this with President Clinton and State, and following their expression of interest/approval, I would take this forward with the British and Irish Prime Ministers.

Preaching reform, Clinton wins African hearts

JOHANNESBURG — In Liberia, Hillary Clinton brought out the crowds despite torrential rain. In Congo, she came away deeply shaken from a meeting with rape victims. Kenya's prime minister said Africa didn't need lectures from the West about democracy, but Africa got one anyway.

At home, the U.S. secretary of state's visit may have been overshadowed by the aftermath of her husband's mission to North Korea to bring home two imprisoned U.S. journalists. But on her seven-nation Africa tour, ending Friday with a stopover in the West African island republic of Cape Verde, she made one splash after another.

Coupled with Barack Obama's visit last month, the two trips to Africa were the earliest into an administration by any secretary of state or president, underlining Washington's pledges to pay more attention to the continent.

In the U.S., the headline-making moment of the trip was her testy response to a question about Bill Clinton. But in Africa, it quickly became a footnote. What people wanted to hear was support for democracy, clean government and ending its many civil wars.

Clinton's ambitious itinerary resembled those of China's foreign minister, who makes extensive annual tours of his country's allies on the continent. But where China tends to sidestep the issues of corruption democracy, Clinton

confronted them head-on.

Kenyan Prime Minister Raila Odinga, speaking hours before Clinton arrived, said Africa did not need to be lectured about democracy. After they met, she did just that. "The absence of strong and effective democratic institutions has permitted ongoing corruption, impunity, politically motivated violence and a lack of respect for a rule of law," Clinton said. "These conditions ... are continuing to hold Kenya back."

Odinga switched to a more conciliatory tone, saying African countries could learn from Clinton's example when she conceded defeat to Obama during the U.S. presidential primaries.

"That is a lesson Africa needs to learn seriously," he said. "In Africa, in many countries, elections are never won, they are only rigged. The losers never accept that they lost. If we do this, we will be able to develop democracy truly in the African continent."

In Angola, she told Foreign Minister Assuncao Afonso dos Anjos that his country needed to write a new constitution, prosecute human rights crimes and hold a proper presidential election.

"So, Mr. Minister, we have our work cut out for us," she said.

And in Nigeria, Africa's biggest oil producer, she said "the disconnect between Nigeria's wealth and its poverty is a failure of governance at the federal, state and local level."

To Africa's reformers, often an embattled minority, these were heartening words.

Emma Ezeazu, who campaigns for free and fair elections in his native Nigeria, said Clinton's visit showed that U.S. officials "are becoming more pro-active in their relationship with Nigeria, in particular on the subject of governance and democracy. They are paying more attention."

Tiseke Kasambala, a Johannesburg-based researcher for Human Rights Watch, commended her grasp of human rights abuses in Africa — not just the headline-makers, like Zimbabwe and Congo, but the lesser publicized offenders such as Angola.

In Goma, a Congo town in a region ravaged by gang rapes amid continuing fighting between army and rebels, Clinton announced \$17 million in American aid to help the victims.

She toured a squalid camp of 18,000 refugees and heard one of them tell her, "We really want to return home, that's why we are asking America to help stop the fighting."

"That's why I'm here," Clinton replied. "I want you to be able to go home."

In Cape Town, South Africa, big, joyous crowds turned out for her at a housing project. In Liberia, founded in 1847 by freed American slaves, rain-drenched crowds waved U.S. and Liberian flags at Clinton's motorcade.

The crowds in Nigeria and Angola were fewer, but community and religious leaders seemed excited just to be with Clinton and be heard by her.

Nancy Kachingwe, a Malawian with the development group ActionAid, applauded Clinton's "very strong emphasis around women's rights."

Some of former President George W. Bush's Africa initiatives, particularly on AIDS, have been widely praised in Africa. But there were also sharp differences over world trade, global warming, and over the Bush administration's anti-terrorism strategy.

Washington wants to buy Africa's oil and gain access to its markets, and fears instability in places like Somalia could fuel anti-U.S. terrorism. Clinton won points by stressing that as the U.S. pursues its interests, it sees the virtue of "working with and listening to our friends and allies, and creating not a multipolar world, but a multi-partner world."

Kachingwe said what matters now is the follow-up.

"There will be a positive impact" from Clinton's trip, she said. "But somewhere along the way, we do need to see ... what's going to come to keep the momentum going."

To the Secretary's Staff:

I applaud the Quadrennial Diplomacy and Development Review (QDDR) as a vital tool to integrate development as a core element of our renewed diplomatic leadership. I urge that this blueprint be clear and lean, so that any Chief of Mission can contribute at the country level. No nation is too small or remote for our attention.

In the Federated States of Micronesia, where I serve as Ambassador, the U. S. Department of the Interior (DOI) runs a sizeable, top heavy assistance program under a Compact of Free Association. This program, which is a vestige of a post-World War Two Strategic Trusteeship relationship, remains almost entirely outside the authority of the COM. The deliberately uncoordinated implementation of over \$90 million of annual grant assistance by a U.S. domestic agency has wasted resources, generated resentment toward the United States, and exacerbated internal political tensions. Micronesia became a sovereign nation 30 years ago.

In 2003, the Bush Administration situated the DOI Compact assistance office thousands of miles away in a deluxe office suite in Honolulu. Administration of the Compact grants is thus performed by four DOI civil servants who take occasional flights to Micronesia. Under this long distance arrangement, we have failed to coordinate and build partnership. No USAID or any other U.S. development specialists are attached to the Embassy, including for the purpose of coordinating an additional \$50 million worth of other federal programs. In a dissent cable that I submitted to Policy Planning last May (Kolonia 82), I attempted to convey the larger context of such an inadequate aid vehicle. In effect, an intrinsically friendly Pacific island nation now chafes and resents a U.S. aid program that is perceived as mismanaged and neocolonialist. We have failed to significantly improve the lives of the Micronesians, 29.9% of whom now live below the Basic Needs Poverty Line. The Chief of Mission has been unacceptably excluded.

While I have thus opted to depart post in September, the QDDR has given me hope for the future. The Secretary's opening remarks to the House Foreign Affairs Committee of April 22 resonated like music in my ears, particularly her statement, "We're turning our ambassadors into in-country chief executives with authority and responsibility for the

programs on the ground."

Thank you for shining a spotlight on a core systemic problem. I do hope my successor will become the beneficiary of such empowerment. Otherwise, we are not One U.S. Government here, as a recent OIG report of our post emphasized. Please do consider Micronesia in the QDDR, perhaps as a small prototype that could serve as a catalyst to better harness development to diplomacy in small island developing nations. As a Foreign Service Officer, I remain at your service and eager to contribute to reform.

Biehl called a little after 1:30 pm to say the meeting with the de facto envoys had been abruptly cancelled -- but for perhaps a positive reason.

Micheletti has asked about half the team to return to Tegucigalpa (Corrales stayed, as "he seeks to confirm that he will not lose his visa"). In the phone call he got from the de facto envoys as they headed for the airport, Biehl said he detected a positive attitude. The envoys seemed confident they would get M to sign the SJ Accord. The envoys promised to call Biehl late this afternoon with the news from Honduras. If, if, if, if, the news is positive, Biehl and OAS Political Director Victor Rico will leave for Tegucigalpa tomorrow morning to meet Micheletti, make sure this is not another time-wasting tactic, and get something in writing from him that he agrees to the Accord and will sign it.

Just before speaking to me, Biehl had spoken with Arias who expressed cautious optimism that we might have a break-

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through. Arias told Biehl to tell us, that if that happens the United States gets the credit.

Arias said the US has played the game exactly right, with the appropriate mix of carrots, sticks, toughness, unified message, even-handedness and, above all, good timing. Arias said the Europeans have been calling him over the past two days, and have fallen into line with the US; the Swedes, as head of the EU, and have told him that they will take their cue from the US and will support US actions. Arias, Biehl said, was extremely complimentary of the "great political instincts shown by Secretary Clinton."

I just received a call from Arias. He expressed his appreciation for everything the US had done in support of democracy in Honduras. He said the recent tough messages by Insulza, OAS Ambassadors and USG officials strengthened by US sanctions, was having an impact on the M regime. He praised our decision to close the consulate and urged that we also move to take away tourist and business visas from key regime members and supporters. I told him we were working on implementing the visa and other measures which I expected could be announced soon.

Arias was critical of Z saying his recent public statements continued to be unhelpful. He described Z's statement advocating the death penalty (presumably to apply to his political enemies) and asking for the extension of his term in office as "disastrous". He said that Insulza had made the right call by not allowing Z to address the OASGA. We agreed the influence of FM Rodas over Z was highly negative.

I told Arias I would be back in Honduras tomorrow and planned in the coming days to press influential political, business and civil society and urge support for the immediate signing of the SJ Accord. Arias and I agreed to stay in close touch in the coming days.

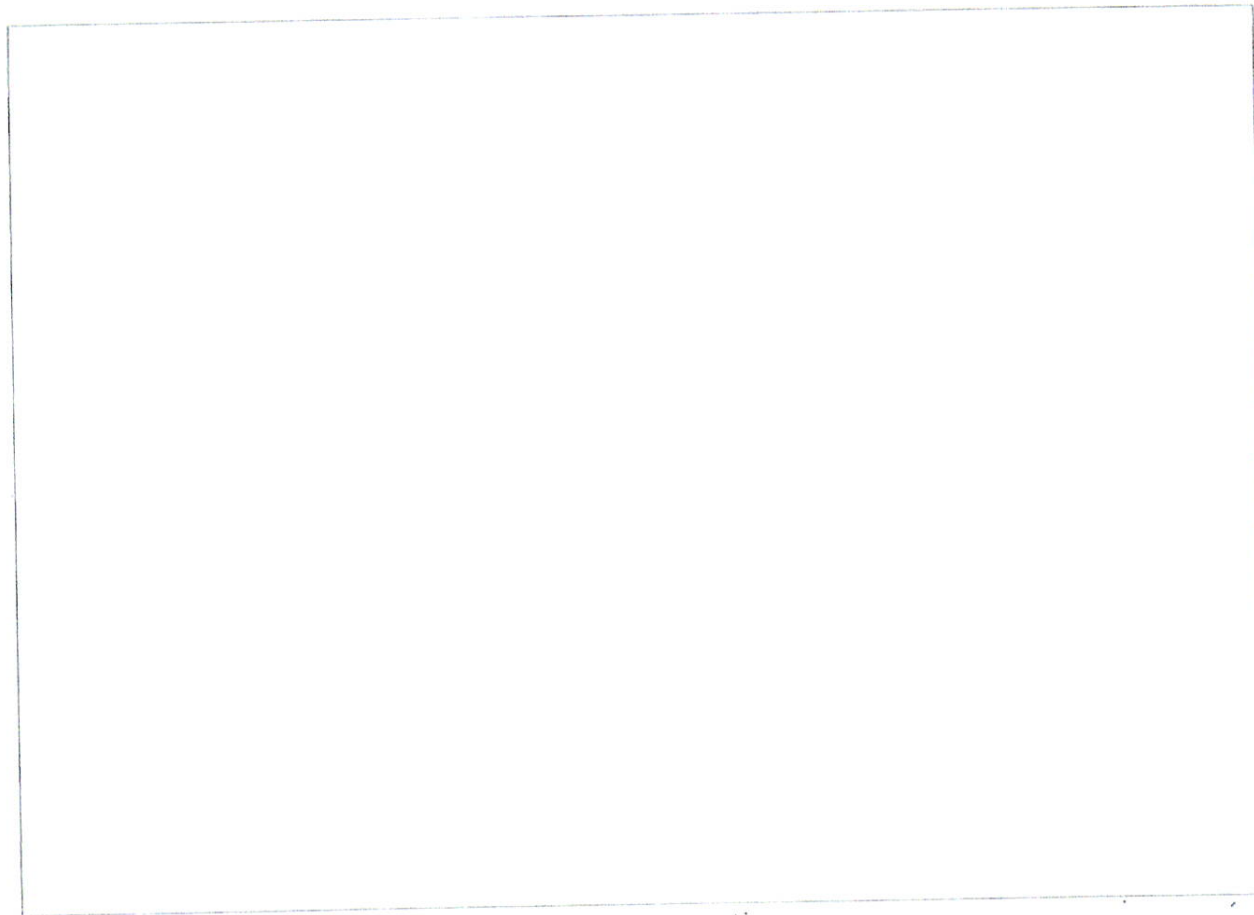

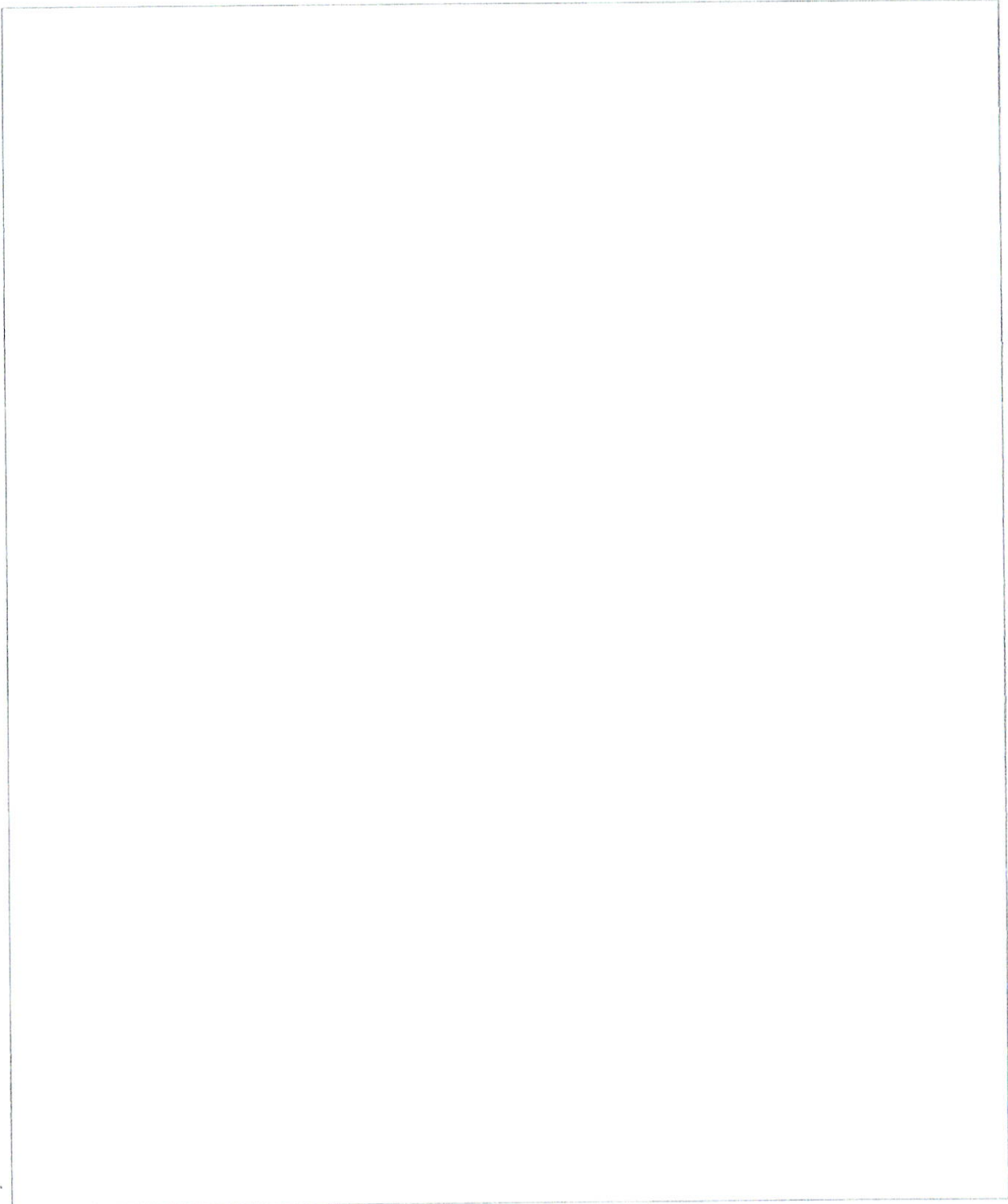
