Dear Mr. Bekesha:

I refer to our letter dated August 5, 2016 regarding the release of certain Department of State records under the Freedom of Information Act (the "FOIA"), 5 U.S.C. § 552.

The search of the materials provided to the Department by the FBI resulted in the retrieval of six documents responsive to your request. After reviewing these documents, we have determined that all six may be released in part. All released material is enclosed.

An enclosure explains the FOIA exemptions and other grounds for withholding material. Where we have made excisions, the applicable FOIA exemptions are marked on each document. All non-exempt information that is reasonably segregable from the exempt material has been released.

We will keep you informed as your case progresses. I refer to our letter dated October 12, 2016 regarding the release of certain Department of State records under the Freedom of Information Act (the "FOIA"), 5 U.S.C. § 552.

As counsel for State communicated to you on October 12, 2016, the Department's production of responsive, non-exempt documents to you on that date omitted a page of one document because it was discovered that additional redaction was necessary. A complete copy of that document, withheld in part, is now enclosed.

An enclosure explains the FOIA exemptions and other grounds for withholding material. Where we have made excisions, the applicable FOIA exemptions are marked on each document. All non-exempt information that is reasonably segregable from the exempt material has been released.

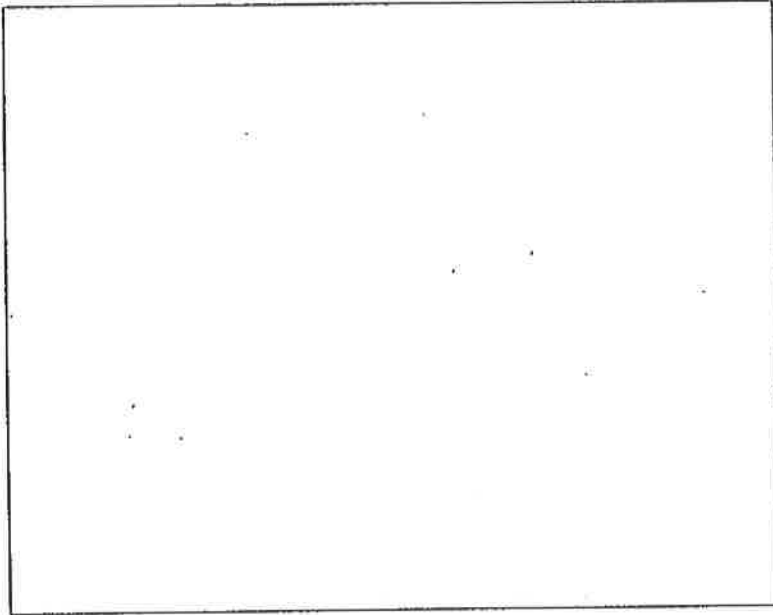

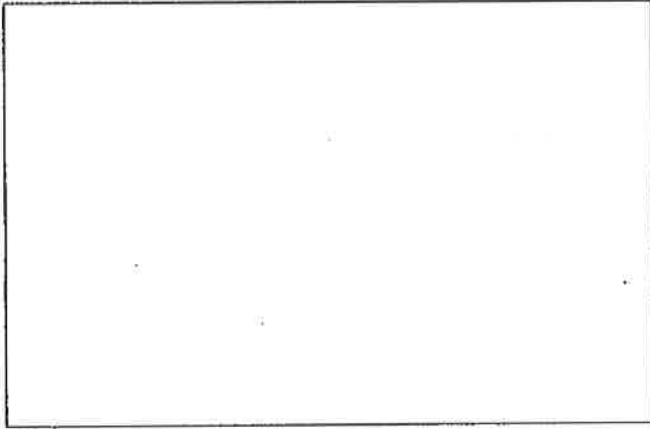
