Dear Mr. Marshall:

I refer to our letter dated December 27, 2016, regarding the release of certain Department of State material under the Freedom of Information Act (the "FOIA"), 5 U.S.C. § 552. The processing of records responsive to your request is ongoing and has yielded an additional 506 documents. After reviewing these documents, we have determined that 198 may be released in full, 299 may be released with excisions, and 9 must be withheld in full. All released material is enclosed.

An enclosure explains the FOIA exemptions and other grounds for withholding material. Where we have made excisions, the applicable exemptions are marked on each document. All non-exempt material that is reasonably segregable from the exempt material has been released. For the documents withheld in full, we have cited FOIA Exemptions 5 and 6, 5 U.S.C. §§552 (b)(5) and (b)(6).

We will keep you informed as your case progresses. 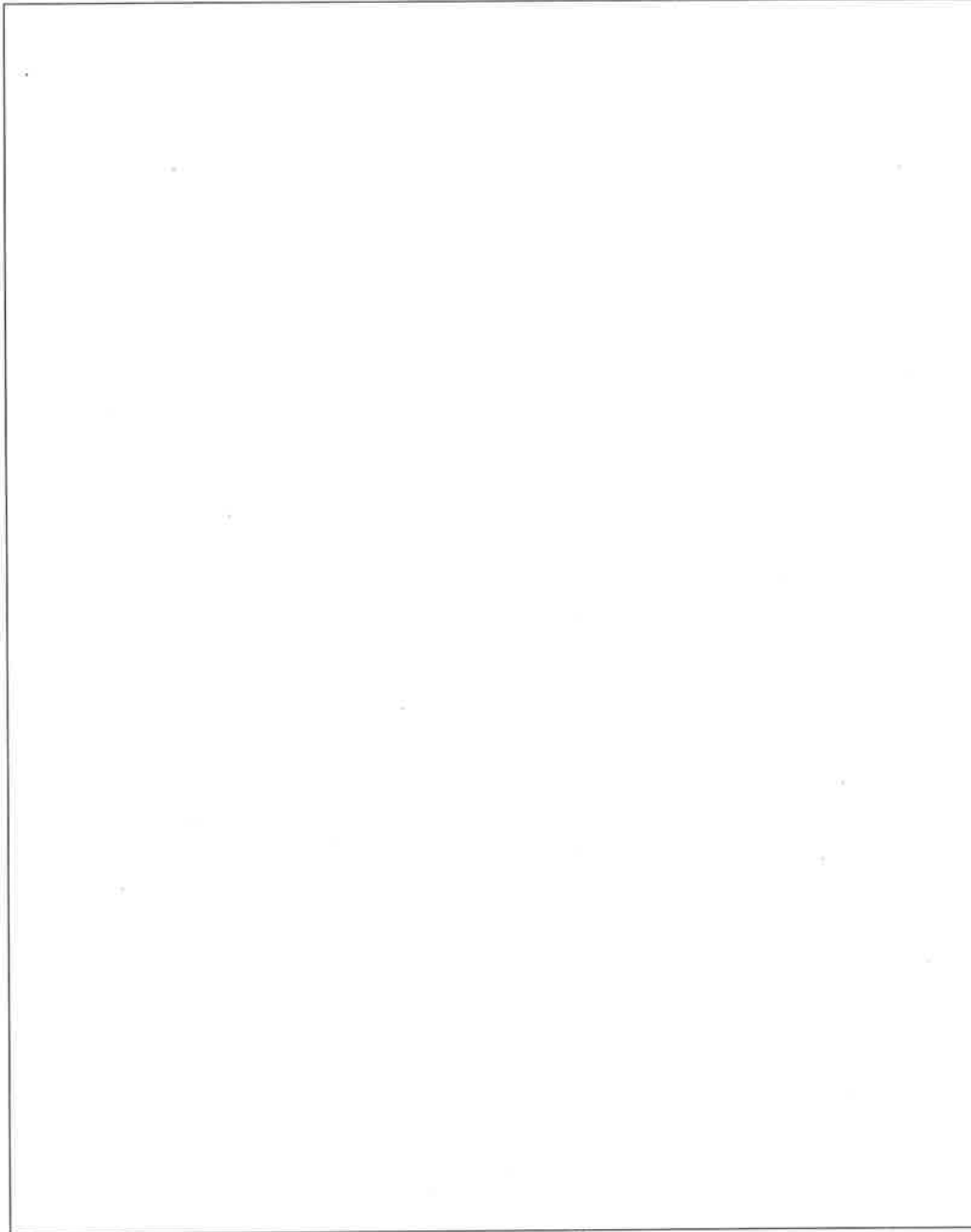

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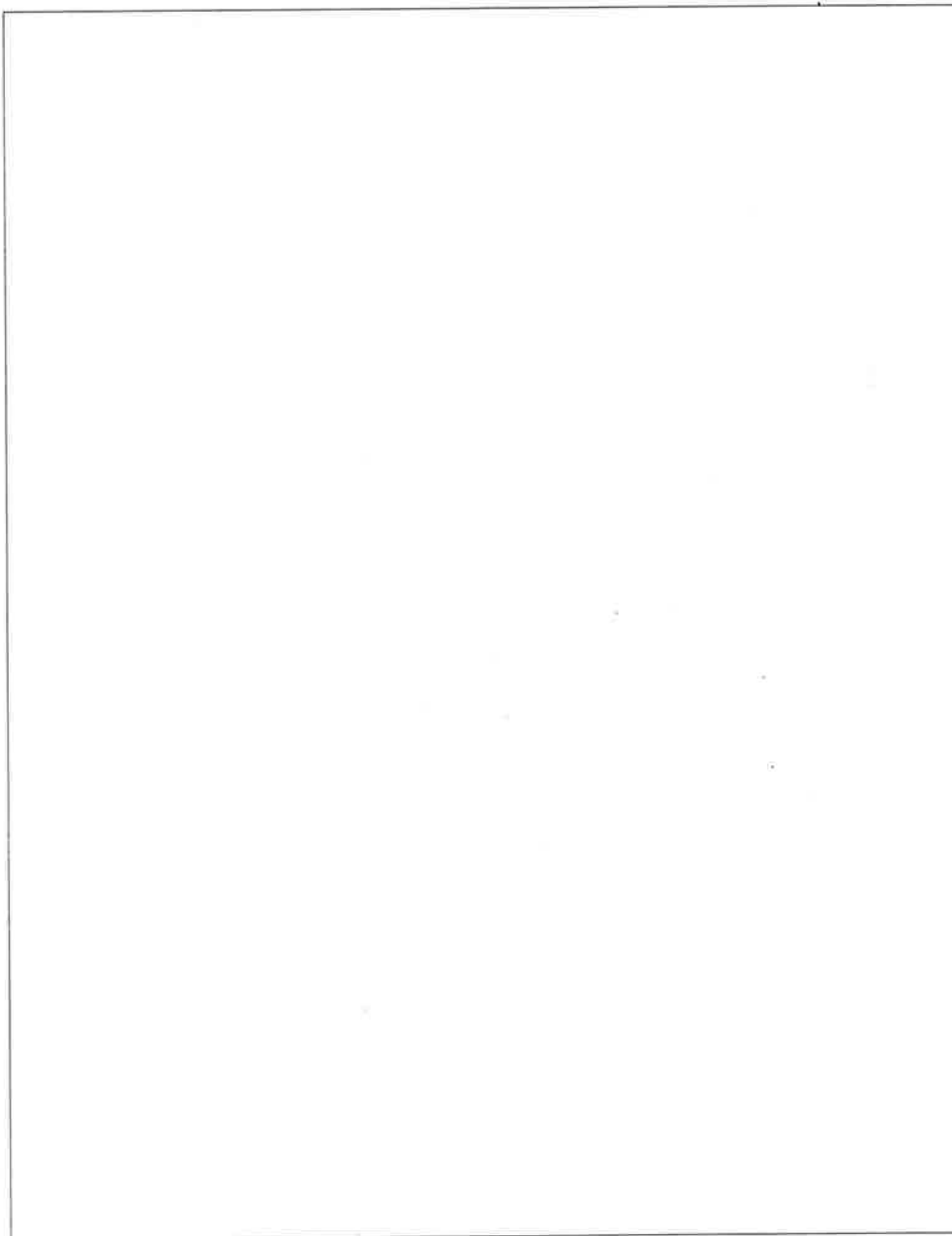

Thoughts and Ideas for the Week from AMS  
 Feb 1-5 2010

**For the QDDR:** As I noted earlier, I had a great meeting with Andrew Steer and Nick Dyer, director general and head of policy planning at DFID. They recounted how originally it had been necessary to declare DFID's complete independence and separation from FCO, moving DFID offices out of British embassies around the world. Today, however, Andrew said that DFID and FCO were once again co-locating, due to **the cost-savings and efficiency of combining the back-office functions and the complementary skills that development experts and diplomats bring to common tasks**, especially in areas like developing governance strategies. As Andrew put it, development in the 21<sup>st</sup> century is not only about "immunizing children," but rather about convincing presidents and prime ministers *themselves* to see childhood epidemics and maternal mortality as national crises that must be addressed. **Development issues must be worked "at both ends," operationally and politically.** Diplomats must convince national governments of the priority and inter-connectedness of development issues **for all ministers**; development experts must ensure the availability and effectiveness of actual delivery systems.

Equally interesting, individual DFID officers gain power **"from being plugged into a global knowledge and access network."** (I promise that I did not prompt them on this.) They argued that their field offices are "engine rooms for international dialogue," providing on the ground expertise and credibility in larger national, regional and international discussions. But the key to people listening to DFID is knowing that a DFID official has control over his or her own budget, diplomatic access back to the FCO and hence to the UN and regional organizations, access to the rest of the British government through an independent voice in Cabinet, financial international access to British representatives in the IFIs and MDBs, and access to the expertise and leverage of a global network of NGOs, foundations, corporations, international alliances such as GAVI, and other actors in the global development space. DFID's aim, in Steer's words, is to be **"a networked, global organization,"** part of a larger global development system.

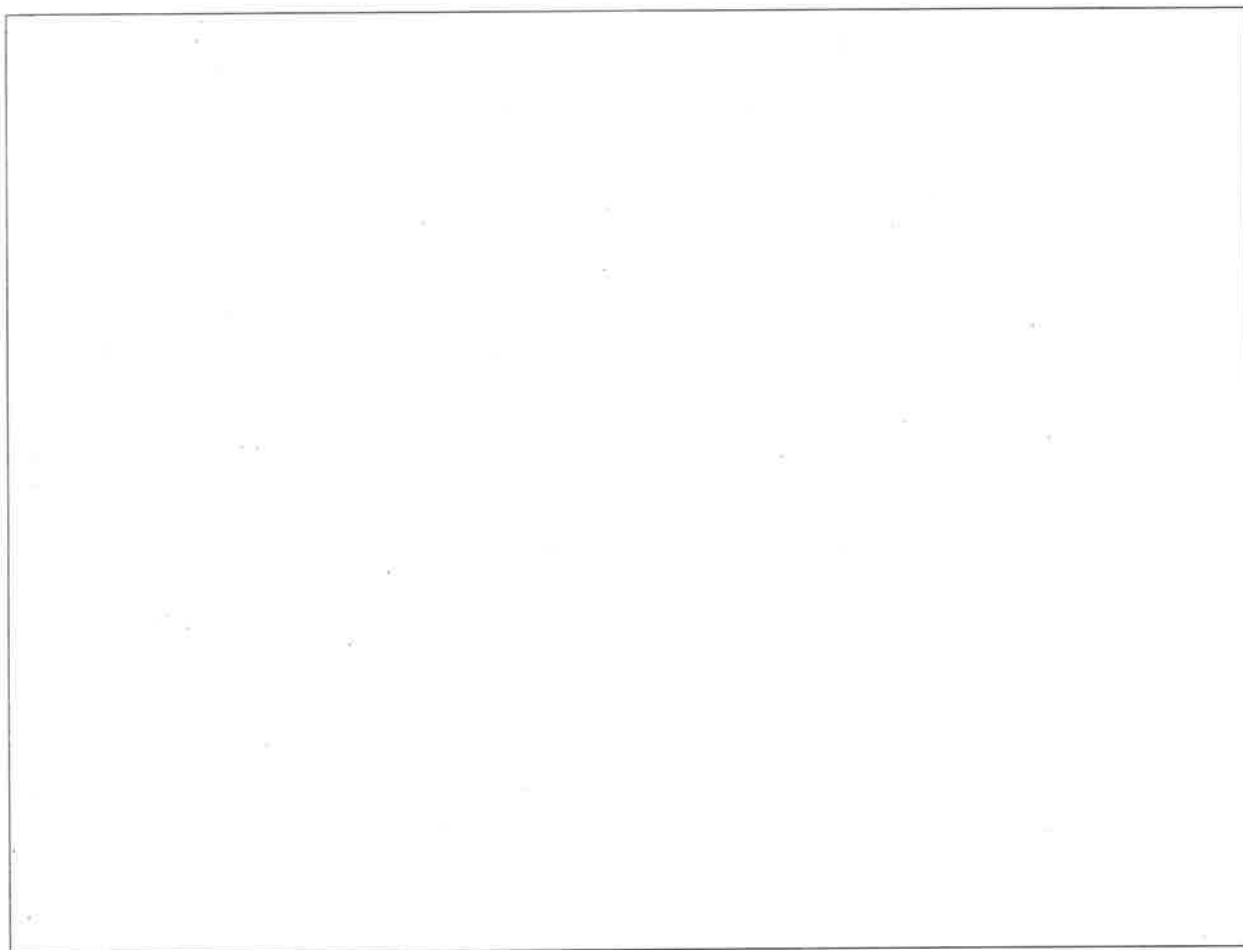
To achieve these goals, DFID and apparently the British government generally have made major changes in both management and institutional culture. Each higher official is evaluated on a points system in which **points are awarded partly for how well s/he has managed his own staff, partly for how well s/he has worked across the ministry, and partly for how well s/he has worked across government.** Further, if you are in-country, your evaluation depends in part on **how good a report you get from the chief of mission.** The point is to create a team-focused, problem-solving culture that emphasizes the value of cultivating and using connections for a common purpose.

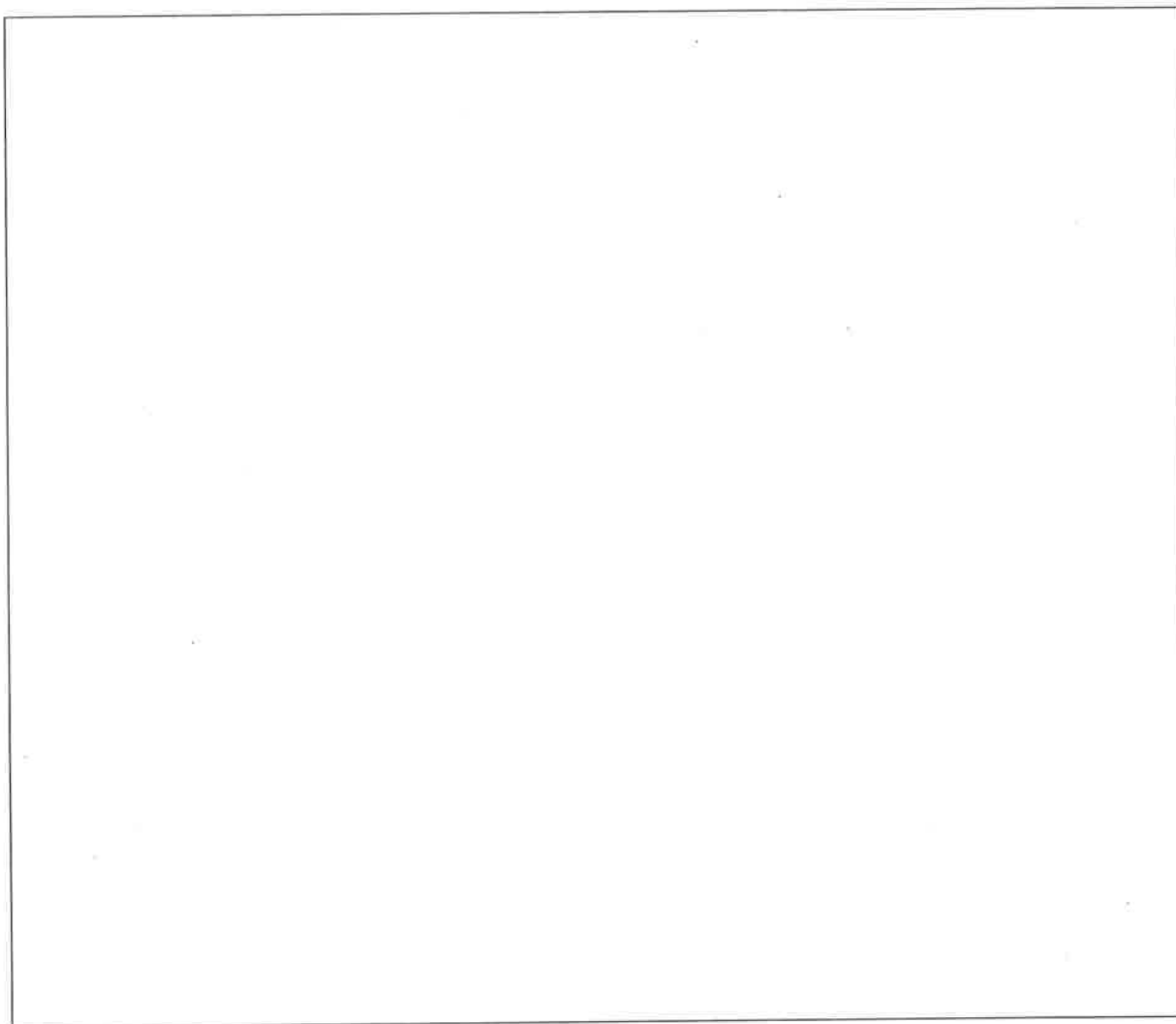
For the QDDR: As I noted earlier, I had a great meeting with Andrew Steer and Nick Dyer, director general and head of policy planning at DFID. They recounted how originally it had been necessary to declare DFID's complete independence and separation from FCO, moving DFID offices out of British embassies around the world. Today, however, Andrew said that DFID and FCO were once again co-locating, due to the cost-savings and efficiency of combining the back-office functions and the complementary skills that development experts and diplomats bring to common tasks, especially in areas like developing governance strategies. As Andrew put it, development in the 21st century is not only about "immunizing children," but rather about convincing presidents and prime ministers themselves to see childhood epidemics and maternal mortality as national crises that must be addressed. Development issues must be worked "at both ends," operationally and politically. Diplomats must convince national governments of the priority and inter-connectedness of development issues for all ministers; development experts must ensure the availability and effectiveness of actual delivery systems.

Equally interesting, individual DFID officers gain power "from being plugged into a global knowledge and access network." (I promise that I did not prompt them on this.) They argued that their field offices are "engine rooms for international dialogue," providing on the ground expertise and credibility in larger national, regional and international discussions. But the key to people listening to DFID is knowing that a DFID official has control over his or her own budget, diplomatic access back to the FCO and hence to the UN and regional organizations, access to the rest of the British government through an independent voice in Cabinet, financial international access to British representatives in the IFIs and MDBs, and access to the expertise and leverage of a global network of NGOs, foundations, corporations, international alliances such as GAVI, and other actors in the global development space. DFID's aim, in Steer's words, is to be "a networked, global organization," part of a larger global development system.

To achieve these goals, DFID and apparently the British government generally have made major changes in both management and institutional culture. Each higher official is evaluated on a points system in which points are awarded partly for how well s/he has managed his own staff, partly for how well s/he has worked across the ministry, and partly for how well s/he has worked across government. Further, if you are in-country, your evaluation depends in part on how good a report you get from the chief of mission. The point is to create a team-focused, problem-solving culture that emphasizes

FYI that Miliband has called to speak with you. The subject is a UK Court of Appeal decision that will be handed down tomorrow morning London time relating to former GTMO detainee Binyam Mohamed. The decision is embargoed, but the Court has allowed four people in the USG to review it, and now has consented to have Miliband discuss it with you.

I haven't read it, and don't know what it will say, but below is the background on the case (which as you know has come up between you and Miliband a few times before). The UK is also reaching out to Jones and Pannetta.

Mohamed, a one-time UK resident, is a former Guantanamo detainee who has claimed publicly that, before arriving at Guantanamo, he was detained at secret locations in Pakistan, Morocco, and Afghanistan and subjected to two years of torture. At one point, the United States contemplated prosecuting BM in a military commission, but ultimately declined to do so. The United States transferred BM from Guantanamo to the UK on February 23, 2009.

Before the USG transferred him, BM sued Her Majesty's Government (HMG) in the UK, seeking to obtain various classified intelligence documents in HMG's possession that contained U.S. intelligence information. Those documents related to his detention and treatment before the USG brought him to Guantanamo. In the course of the UK litigation, HMG was forced to provide the documents to the UK courts. In 2008, during the course of this litigation, a UK lower court issued a classified opinion that addressed, among other things, BM's allegations of abuse. The opinion contained seven paragraphs that summarized certain sensitive aspects of the classified intelligence information. In February 2009, the UK court rejected BM's request to disclose the seven paragraphs. In October 2009, however, after the Obama Administration released memoranda from the Department of Justice's Office of Legal Counsel that detailed the CIA's use of waterboarding and other interrogation techniques, the UK court reversed itself, concluding that disclosure was appropriate. (The court suggested that the contents of the seven paragraphs went no further than the descriptions in the OLC memos.)

HMG appealed that conclusion to the UK Court of Appeal, asserting that disclosure of the seven paragraphs would have a serious adverse effect on UK national security because it would chill the willingness of the United States and other countries to share intelligence with HMG. Before the Court of Appeal reached a decision, U.S. District Judge Kessler

issued an opinion in a habeas case brought by Guantanamo detainee Farhi Saeed Bin Mohamed. In that opinion, she rejected the USG's use of BM's statements about Farhi's activities because she concluded that those statements were tainted by BM's torture. She also noted that the USG did not challenge or deny the accuracy of BM's story of "brutal treatment." BM's counsel brought this decision to the attention of the Court of Appeal.

The UK Court of Appeals will release its judgment tomorrow, February 10, at 9:30 am UK time. We have asked the UK for its press lines and will circulate them as soon as the judgment becomes public.

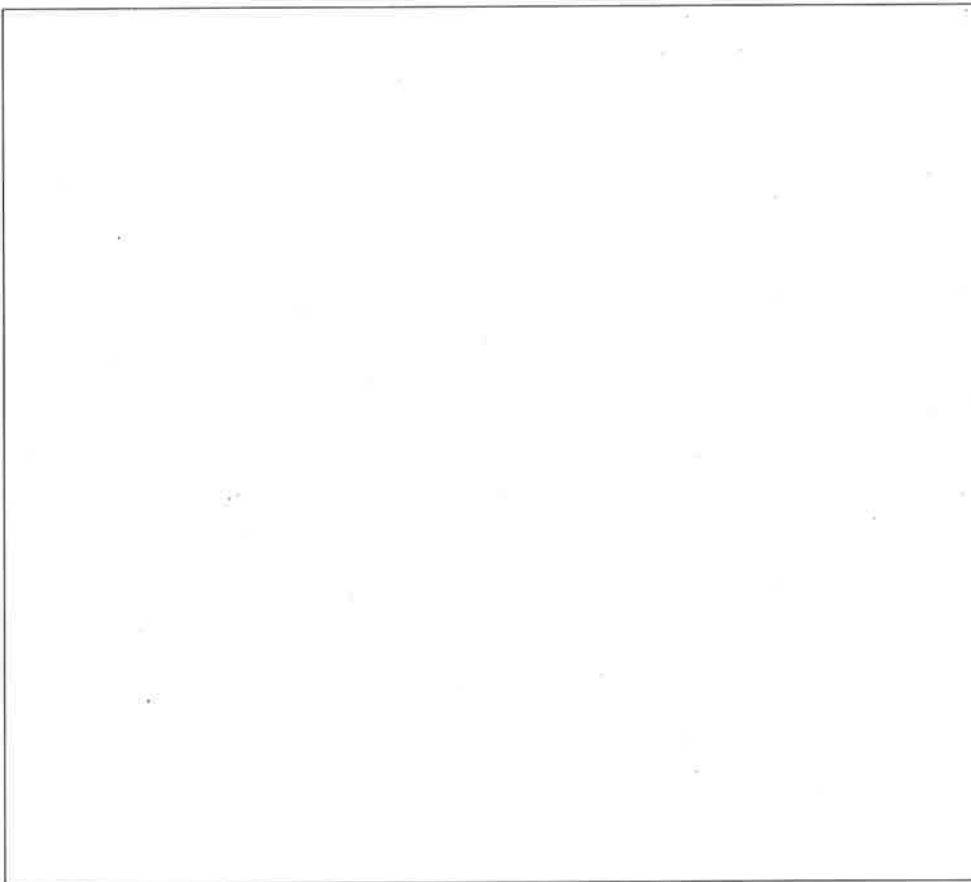

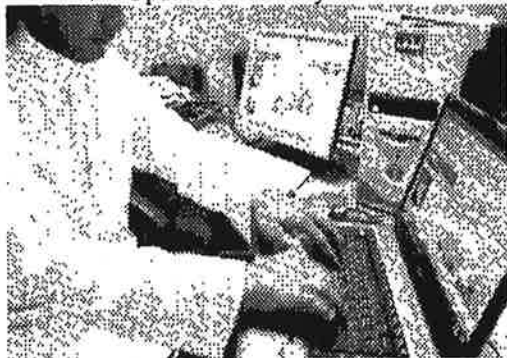

RIYADH // Saudi Arabia is planning to introduce regulations, including a licensing requirement, for its indigenous internet news sites, which have become a key fixture in the kingdom's active online community.

The draft regulations, still under study, would require internet-based news sites to request a government licence and to respond to complaints about their content that are received by the ministry of culture and information. "We want them to feel that they are under our umbrella," Abdul Rahman al Hazza, spokesman for the ministry, said in a phone interview yesterday.

Mr al Hazza referred to the new rules as "guidelines for the e-press", and said the idea is to help the electronic media with staffing and financing and give them "somebody to talk to" if they have problems. "It's going to be simple and easy."

Asked if the new rules would involve censorship, Mr al Hazza replied: "Not that much." Mainly, he added, if there are complaints about something written at an online news site, "we just look at it".

A report last year in the Saudi Gazette said the draft regulations also cover "appointment conditions for editors-in-chief, granting permits to journalists, and invitations to cover news events".

A 2007 law already subjects online writers to criminal penalties for such things as defamation.

The planned regulations, which Mr al Hazza said are still two to three months away from being finalised by the ministry, are an effort to bring online news sites such as Sabq, Alweeam and A'ajel under government control in much the same way that the country's traditional daily newspapers are regulated.

It is not clear if news sites like Elaph.com, which is London-based but has a Riyadh office, would also have to get a licence.

Saudi newspapers are licensed by the government and can be temporarily stopped from publishing if they print something upsetting to a government official. But this has been rare in recent years, during which the Saudi print media has been encouraged to report more critically on social and economic problems. There is considerable self-censorship, however, as the media stay away from sensitive issues.

Although the draft regulations under consideration do not apply to bloggers, there are concerns that the government eventually will try to regulate them as well.

"They are not talking about blogs" right now, observed one veteran Saudi blogger, Ahmed Ba-Aboud. "But eventually they will get to us. It is a concern."

Mr Ba-Aboud, 38, a management consultant in the kingdom's Eastern Province city of Dhahran, said the government does not understand that online media are attracting readers because they are not controlled like traditional newspapers. "There's no way I'd send anything I write to the government to censor it," he said. "That's not how the internet works."

Ahmed al Omran, who blogs at [www.saudijews.org](http://www.saudijews.org), was caustic about what he called the ministry's "dumb idea to regulate so-called electronic media".

"Ironically, some owners of news websites are actually pushing for this law," Mr Omran lamented in a posting last month.

"They argue that it would make it easier for them to get funding and make money from advertising. What about their independence and freedom that could be threatened by the new law? Well, apparently these things are not high on their agenda."

Saudi Arabia's sprightly blogging community includes both Saudis and foreigners writing in both Arabic and English. It also boasts one of the region's highest proportion of female bloggers – about 46 per cent, according to a 2009 study by Harvard University's Berkman Center for Internet and Society. About one-third of the kingdom's population regularly goes online.

The community's latest arrival showed up February 2, when Mr Ba-Aboud launched a new English-language

blog so that outsiders can learn more about "regular people like myself".

Most foreigners know certain kinds of Saudis, Mr Ba-Aboud said in an interview, including "extremists like Osama bin Laden", "rich people" and "people related to the government".

But the voice of ordinary Saudis "does not reach around the globe in a similar magnitude", he wrote at the new site, <http://alternativesaudivoices.wordpress.com>.

It will be a sort of communal blog in that Mr Ba-Aboud has invited anyone to contribute a posting, and as co-ordinator, he will post them on the site. Only those that "call for hate or violence" will be rejected, he added. In an interview last November, Mr al Hazza, the ministry spokesman, said the new regulations arose partly because ordinary citizens "don't know where to go" to complain about something written at an online news site.

"The problem we have is that there is no government department to refer to ... Nobody to evaluate their job to see if they are doing wrong or right."

Censorship "is not the idea" behind the new rules, he said. "The idea is to regulate."

Mr al Hazza said a decision will probably be made in the next couple of weeks about whether the new regulations shall be issued by the minister of culture and information, Abdel Aziz al Khoja, or be sent to the Shoura Council for action.

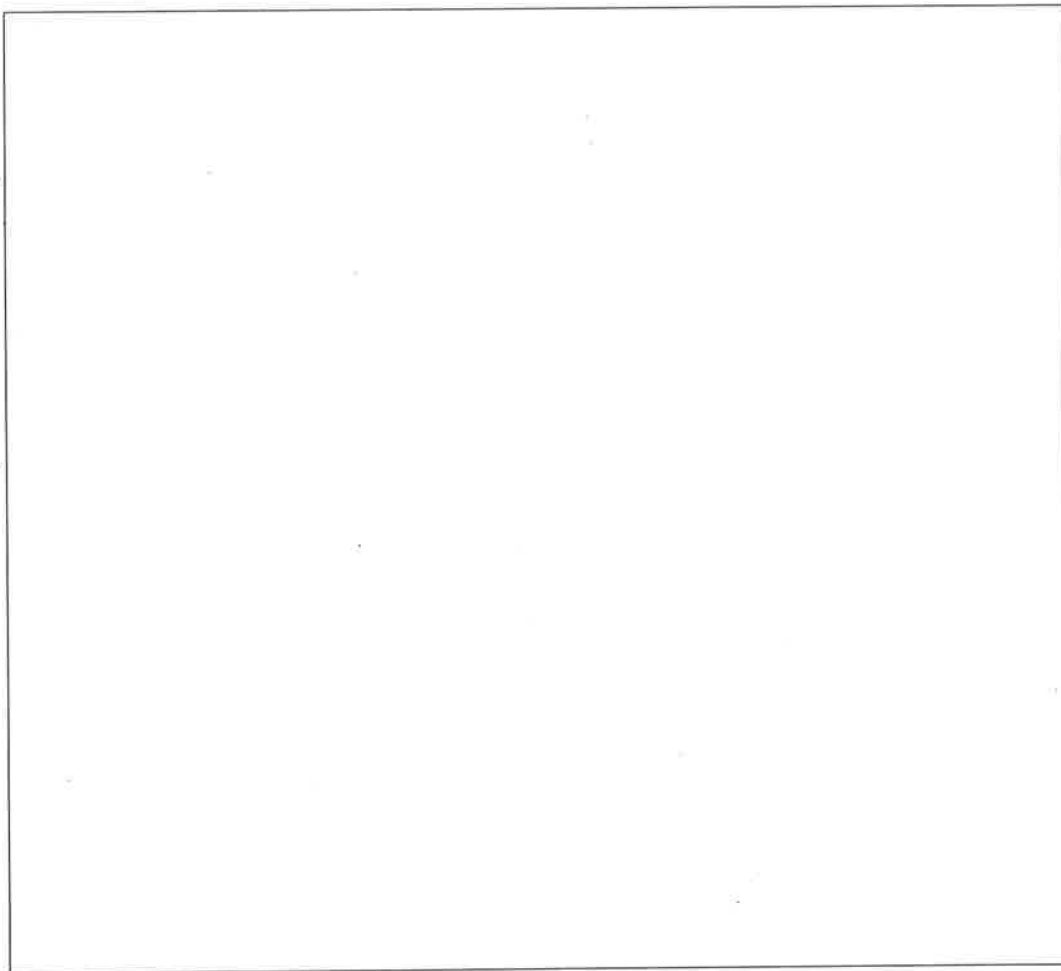

**ADOPTION |** Hillary Clinton continues to hail an adoption home she helped open with Mother Teresa that has since closed its doors  
 By Emily Belz

**WASHINGTON—**An adoption ministry Secretary of State Hillary Clinton hailed as a home she helped open with Mother Teresa no longer handles adoptions and its phone line has been disconnected, though at last week's National Prayer Breakfast Clinton spent five minutes of her 30-minute speech relating the story of its opening. Last Thursday Clinton described Mother Teresa "beaming about what this meant for children and their futures," seemingly oblivious that the Mother Teresa Home for Infant Children in northwest Washington, D.C., is now defunct. She said she worked tirelessly to "cut through all the red tape," although it appears that red tape prevented the work from continuing. According to a pastor

at the church next door to the home's former location, the adoption ministry failed to take off because the Roman Catholic nuns who ran it weren't allowed to care for babies without medical personnel on site. "I'm not sure the legal thing that came down upon them, but they realized they needed to expend their energies in another way," said Maureen Freshour, who along with her husband, David, pastors Chevy Chase Baptist Church and lives nearby. Freshour has stayed in touch with the nuns from the Missionaries of Charity order who ran the home and said that the remaining three or four sisters have moved to another house in Washington, where they are ministering to the homeless. "This has been a core issue—adoption—whether the home [Clinton] talked about survived or not," said Chuck Johnson, chief operating officer of the National Council for Adoption. "It's an issue she's been consistent on." During her speech on Thursday, Clinton reminisced about the 1994 National Prayer Breakfast when she attended as first lady and Mother Teresa was the speaker. The Roman Catholic nun delivered a blistering speech about abortion, saying, "Any country that accepts abortion is not teaching its people to love, but to use any violence to get what they want." Mother Teresa then called on attendees to fight abortion through adoption: "Please don't kill the child. I want the child. Please give me the child." The audience that day gave her a standing ovation—but President and Mrs. Clinton, both pro-abortion, did not stand. Afterward, Mother Teresa asked to meet with Hillary Clinton and they went to talk behind a curtain on the stage, sitting on folding chairs, Mother Teresa in sandals even though it was winter. "She told me that she knew that we had a shared conviction about adoption being vastly better as a choice for unplanned or unwanted babies," Clinton related last Thursday. "And she asked me—or more properly, she directed me—to work with her to create a home for such babies here in Washington." Clinton followed through and set up a home for unwanted babies in Washington in just over a year, no small feat in a city that was known then for its inefficient and corrupt bureaucracy. The Mother Teresa Home for Infant Children opened in June 1995 in the district's affluent Chevy Chase neighborhood to house eight pregnant mothers and their babies—but it remains unclear whether it facilitated any adoptions. I called the Missionaries of Charity in Washington, a worldwide Roman Catholic order established by Mother Teresa. The nun who answered the phone said she couldn't give her name because they aren't allowed to talk to the press. She did say, however, that the sisters who are in the order now were not in the order when the adoption home opened, so she wasn't sure why it closed. She added that the order sold the Chevy Chase house in 2002. "We work with the poor and we didn't have any work there because it's a rich neighborhood," she said. The sisters, she added, are now working with the homeless and those with AIDS in a more transitional neighborhood in the northeast section of town on Otis Street.

Shaun requests that he bring to the State Department to meet you on March 17 and to the White House St. Patrick's Day event a woman named Kate Carroll, the widow of a policeman murdered last year by the Continuity IRA, who has been a key figure in the campaign for the peace process.

I have included Shaun's email to me below and a BBC story on Kate Carroll:

1. Shaun's email on Kate Carroll

We discussed the possibility of arranging for HRC to meet Kate Carroll next week during the St Patrick's Day celebrations.

Next week Kate is coming to the United States on March 16th. Kate is an extraordinary woman whose voice on Tuesday ( the first anniversary of her husband Constable Stephen Carroll's murder ) was critical in persuading all the DUP to make their vount count and ensure that the cross community vote succeeded.

Kate would herself admit that before her husband's brutal murder, she was a quiet and timid person who would never have been found to speak up. Stephen's death led her to find her voice and make it vital.

Her courage in the days after Stephen's murder inspired all the politicians to come out and call for unity and peace. Martin M and Peter R both visited her at home.

Since then Kate has tried to piece together her life. But this week she decided to speak out about the senseless of life without Stephen and to use it as an appeal to everyone still engaged in violence in NI to stop.



On Tuesday she gave television and radio interviews, press and media coverage to her "terrible" anniversary. But she wanted it to be used for peace. She appealed to the politicians to put aside their differences and vote for devolution.

Kate is a vital voice.

Kate now wants to set up a charity to encourage young people to reject the NI of the past and ensure that no young person wastes their life in violence. In doing this she is a source of inspiration and leadership against conflict and those who would be drawn in.

For HRC, I can only imagine that Kate is the model of 'vital voices.' It would be wonderful to ask Kate to come to Washington - probably on the morning of the 17th March - and bring her to State to meet the Secretary of State. Perhaps also at HRC's invitation I could also bring her to the reception in the evening at The White House.

## 2. BBC story

Murdered policeman's widow appeals to politicians

For Kate Carroll, every Monday is a rerun of the day her husband was shot dead.

She counts down the events of 9 March 2009 on the clock.

"Monday, 10 O'clock was when Steve would have rung me," she said.

"Half past ten - Steve died. At 20 past 11, Graham came to the door to tell me that Steve had been killed.

"I relive that all the time. That is just my Mondays."

Exactly a year ago, Constable Stephen Carroll, 48, was responding to a call for help in Craigavon. It was a trap.

The Continuity IRA was lying in wait. They shot him dead. He was the first PSNI officer to be murdered in Northern Ireland.

Speaking shortly afterwards, Kate said his killers were "sick".

"They have robbed my son of his father, my grandkids of their grandfather, my mum of her son. And me of my life," she said.

"Part of my life has gone. I feel now that I'm dead inside."

A year on, Kate Carroll said her pain was "as raw as ever".

"I don't think I have quite accepted that Steve has gone, although there is a grave to prove he is not there any more," she said.

"To me, Steve is still in my heart. I think about him every day I write to him every night. I can't move on from him but I'm trying my best."

But with family and friends' support, she has worked to keep her husband's memory alive.

In her garden, there is a tree planted in his memory.

"It is my Steve's tree. It is called the ghost tree. It has a special meaning... I go out and look at it and I just love it," she said.

A year ago, Steve Carroll was counting down time in his job, looking forward to a new kind of future with his family.

Before he left for work that Monday, he had talked about the increasing level of violence, after the murder of two soldiers the previous Saturday.

"He said to me just as he was going out: 'Wouldn't it be ironic, just with my last year-and-a-half, that something would happen?'

"He said: 'Love you, see you tonight'. We kissed each other at the door. He smiled and away he went. That was the last I saw of him."

For Kate Carroll, the anniversary is one of the worst days she can think about.

As politicians in the Northern Ireland assembly prepare to vote on the transfer of policing and justice powers, she will be remembering exactly one year ago, when her husband's regular phone call wasn't made, when the knock came to the door that changed her world.

"I hope and pray that this will be the last policeman's wife who has to sit here and explain how she feels because her husband has been taken away by a bullet."

But, she points out: "This is a very big day for Northern Ireland."

"Hopefully something good will come out of this. That's my role to make sure Steve hasn't died in vain. Nobody wants this

so-called war to be carried on."
