Subject: Texas Public Information Act Request

On February 2, 2017, the *Austin American-Statesman* reported that on February 1, 2017, the Travis County Sheriff's Office declined 196 detention requests from U.S. Immigration and Customs Enforcement. Therefore, pursuant to the provisions of the Texas Public Information Act, Judicial Watch, Inc. hereby requests that the Travis County Sheriff's Office produce:

1. The 196 detention requests from U.S. Immigration and Customs Enforcement. Such requests may include Department of Homeland Security Forms I-247N, I-247D, or I-247-X; and
2. Any records provided to U.S. Immigration and Customs Enforcement by the Travis County's Sheriff's office that declines the 196 detention requests.

Pursuant to the Texas Government Code §552.221, all records should be produced within ten (10) business days. Additionally, pursuant to §552.267, Judicial Watch, Inc. is entitled to a waiver of any charges related to this request due to the public interest in the subject and the fact that providing the requested copies of the materials described herein will primarily benefit the general public.
