Dear Hillary,

Hope you are getting some rest and fun. I just got back from the meetings in DC and got your wonderful inscription on the photo of us... that means so much to me. Thank you. And remember if you need a tune up or help with anything, just let me know.

I was happy to hear that the President created a White House Council on Women and Girls. I remember last summer how you said women's issues and health care were what you now wanted to focus on. And I know you want to help with health care. I think you can. I hesitate to ask anything of you, but feel compelled because we are at a turning point for health care and our nation's future with possibility, but fraught with danger. There is now a small window of opportunity that may not be seen for another generation. That's why I am writing this letter (and I apologize in advance for its length). I live on the ground as a practicing doctor with real people suffering real problems that I know have real solutions that are being overlooked and hold the key to saving our health care system from self-destruction.

Last night I went to hear Howard Dean give a talk in the Berkshires on health care reform. The core tenets of the Obama plan are solid. But absent from the conversation was the need to face the reality that more access to acute care medicine for chronic disease will cost more and provide poorer outcomes. And prevention, as it is being discussed, mostly refers to application of "early detection" according to the Clinical Preventive Services Guidelines, and skips far short of what is needed. We do not need to simply give more access to the medicine we have, but to do something different. It is the pink elephant in the room.

A very different model based on systems/functional medicine has to be the "inlet inside" for our health care system and guide reform, from what is reimbursed, to how doctors are educated, to how medical care facilities are designed to create medicine for patients in their "health" care through education, classes in nutrition, stress management delivered by integrated health care teams, to how we design electronic records, to how conduct systems based research, and comparative effectiveness research to compare not drug to drug, but whole systems approaches to conventional approaches.

I believe that key avenues for sustainable change are being overlooked. I know you know these issues backwards and forwards, and care deeply about this. I know the exigencies and restrictions of your position, but I hope you can open a few doors so the right people in the administration get the right information and guidance as policies are crafted. There is a coalition of key leaders in medicine who can help create fundamental change, rather than simply re-arranging deck chairs on the Titanic. Their voices need to be front and center.

Is there a way you can help arrange a meeting with Secretary Designate Ms. Shobeilus, Nancy-Ann Min DeParle, key Senate and congressional leaders, Zuke, Peter Orszag, Zuke and perhaps you and the President with a few key thought leaders who can present a model for change that is out of the box, but at the center of what where medicine is heading including Wayne Jonas, Jeffrey Bland, Ralph Snyderman, John Podesta, myself and a few key others. John Podesta has been instrumental in developing a proposal called WIN (Wellness Initiative for the Nation) that provides a systems oriented model for developing policy, strategy and initiatives extend the potential for change beyond direct reform of health care delivery and financing.

We would like the opportunity to suggest a key wellness policy team within the White House that would work with the Office of Health Care Reform and draw on national experts (a SWAT team) to help interface with the rapidly evolving transformation of medicine to systems medicine and wellness rooted in the model of functional medicine.

I am facing that proposal so you have the detail behind it and sending it in a separate email in case those with attachments get blocked. I will also send you the executive one page summary of the proposal. It can be the vehicle for ongoing coordination and strategy.

I am also attaching (and will fax to your house because I don't know if attachments get through), an essay of mine to be published next month that details key reforms that can change the "inlet inside" for real health care reform. There won't be this chance for another generation. I hope you can help us. If not we will find another way. God willing.

I met yesterday with Palau's new President who HRC is to meet with tomorrow at 11. I'm writing to give HRC some perspective beyond what she may get from EAP and to suggest points for her to make. I'll start with the points. I'd like to discuss questions.

- I'm delighted to meet you, President Toribiong (Toh-ri-b-yong), my opposite number, Minister Pierantozzi (Peer-an-toe-zee), and the other members of the delegation. I tried hard to get a better job than Sandra was elected to as vice-president ... but we have pretty good jobs now, don't we, Sandra?
- I'm proud that the Compact was entered into in my husband's administration.
- It's disappointing the Bush Administration didn't do what it should have to complete the Compact Review process this year.
- But now we have new administrations. I understand you will re-evaluate your predecessor's proposal. I'll look at our position too.
- I hope, however, we can complete the process soon, although I understand it will take some time. I promise high-level, understanding, and sympathetic attention. I will designate a representative shortly.
- The U.S. and Palau have a special bond formed by decades of territorial administration and I know our responsibilities.
- And I understand that free association is not pure independence and you want to continue a very close relationship.
- The President's Budget is largely completed but I will look into your FY10 request and will work with OMB and Congress on it. I also understand the problem of the trust fund created by the market and earlier expectations.
- I've been to Guam. I understand that Palau has some of the most beautiful islands in the world, the 'rainbow's end.'
- Thanks for coming. We'll work with you on the Review and in the years ahead seriously, fairly, and responsibly.

Now, some background. We took Palau from Japan in bloody WWII battles and administered it for the UN. It became a 'freely associated state' in 1994. HRC and I have discussed this status as one of Puerto Rico's options. In free association, nations share governing responsibilities. We have full security rights in strategic Palau, provide Pell Grants, and Postal Service, etc. At the staff level, I guided congressional changes that Palauan reformers sought to the Compact of Free Association which the Reagan and Bush 1 Administrations tried to force on the territory. It was a tough battle that included the suicide of the corrupt first president allied with Reagan and Bush. Minister of State Pierantozzi was a leading reformer. President Toribiong was in the group.

A Review of the Compact is due this year with a focus on whether Palau's operational needs are being met. After years of US appropriations, a trust fund was supposed to fully meet the needs after year 15. But the trust, unrealistically expected by the US to grow 12% per year, will not be able to replace all appropriations according to the GAO. Early last year, Palau's last president made a Compact extension proposal but the Bush Administration failed to respond. Palau's lawyer, who I know from the Carter WH, quoted the head of the Australia, NZ, & Pacific Islands Office, Alcy Frelick (who he gives good marks to) saying she hadn't been able to get support within DoS.

Toribiong wants to revise his predecessor's proposal a bit and has three requests. 1) HRC ask OMB for current funding to continue through FY10 to provide time for talks since they didn't really begin as they should have last year, there are new administrations here and there, and it is unrealistic to get the talks done and legislation passed this fiscal year. This position is supported in the attached letter sent HRC Monday by the chairs of the Senate and House committees, Sen. Lugar, and others.

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2) The talks be serious and consider his administration's proposal (vs. his predecessor's) 3) The U.S. be represented by someone who can command the necessary attention. (I think EAP is planning to have Frelick. She is capable but maybe there should be someone higher or more special. There was a special Negotiator for the Reviews with the other two freely associated states.)

Toribiong says Palau needs \$20 m in Compact funding in FY10. \$15 m will come from the trust but he would like \$5 m through continued Compact appropriations. A fallback would be to take it from the trust but that would further deplete the trust.

Finally, the Bush Administration's inclination was to transform free association into pure independence. Palau wanted and wants a closer relationship with the US and this is important as a precedent for US territories for which statehood is not an option.

Hello Cheryl:

I've made some initial calls today and have gotten the preliminary sense that people are intrigued - some very excited - by [redacted]. She is seen as a strong advocate, particularly on prevention issues, and would go a long way to signaling a commitment to beefing up the prevention side of PEPFAR. The downside is that she is not a medical doctor, but I don't think that should be the one thing barring her from consideration. This criticism can be assuaged with four points:

1. When this position was created by Bush, the first appointee was also not a doctor, nor did he have an extensive clinical background aside from working at a pharma company.
2. The head of the Office of National AIDS Policy that was recently announced by President Obama is also not a medical doctor, but someone with extensive experience in health policy and health care financing.
3. The head of UNAIDS is not a medical doctor, but has extensive experience working on HIV/AIDS issues.
4. The current Assistant Coordinator is a nurse-midwife, and there are multiple medical experts working within the office to address the necessary treatment issues.

I should have more to share by Monday afternoon.

I've also talked with the folks over at the GAC office today, and it sounds like they are interested in holding off on any specific position descriptions until the new GAC comes in, to wait to see how he or she might like to reorganize the office and do away with the currently existine Schedule C positions. I met yesterday with Palau's new President who HRC is to meet with tomorrow at 11. I'm writing to give HRC some perspective beyond what she may get from EAP and to suggest points for her to make. I'll start with the points. I'd like to discuss questions.

- I'm delighted to meet you, President Toribiong (Toh-rib-e-yong), my opposite number, Minister Pierantozzi (Peer-an-toe-zee), and the other members of the delegation. I tried hard to get a better job than Sandra was elected to as vice-president ... but we have pretty good jobs now, don't we, Sandra?
- I'm proud that the Compact was entered into in my husband's administration.
- It's disappointing the Bush Administration didn't do what it should have to complete the Compact Review process this year.
- But now we have new administrations. I understand you will re-evaluate your predecessor's proposal. I'll look at our position too.
- I hope, however, we can complete the process soon, although I understand it will take some time. I promise high-level, understanding, and sympathetic attention. I will designate a representative shortly.
- The U.S. and Palau have a special bond formed by decades of territorial administration and I know our responsibilities.
- And I understand that free association is not pure independence and you want to continue a very close relationship.
- The President's Budget is largely completed but I will look into your FY10 request and will work with OMB and Congress on it. I also understand the problem of the trust fund created by the market and earlier expectations.
- I've been to Guam. I understand that Palau has some of the most beautiful islands in the world, the 'rainbow's end.'
- Thanks for coming. We'll work with you on the Review and in the years ahead seriously, fairly, and responsibly.

Now, some background. We took Palau from Japan in bloody WWII battles and administered it for the UN. It became a 'freely associated state' in 1994. HRC and I have discussed this status as one of Puerto Rico's options. In free association, nations share governing responsibilities. We have full security rights in strategic Palau, provide Pell Grants, and Postal Service, etc. At the staff level, I guided congressional changes that Palauan reformers sought to the Compact of Free Association which the Reagan and Bush 1 Administrations tried to force on the territory. It was a tough battle that included the suicide of the corrupt first president allied with Reagan and Bush. Minister of State Pierantozzi was a leading reformer. President Toribiong was in the group.

A Review of the Compact is due this year with a focus on whether Palau's operational needs are being met. After years of US appropriations, a trust fund was supposed to fully meet the needs after year 15. But the trust, unrealistically expected by the US to grow 12% per year, will not be able to replace all appropriations according to the GAO. Early last year, Palau's last president made a Compact extension proposal but the Bush Administration failed to respond. Palau's lawyer, who I know from the Carter WH, quoted the head of the Australia, NZ, & Pacific Islands Office, Alcy Frelick (who he gives good marks to) saying she hadn't been able to get support within DoS.

Toribiong wants to revise his predecessor's proposal a bit and has three requests. 1) HRC ask OMB for current funding to

Hi! Hope you're doing well. Things look to be going very well at State.

I wanted to pass along another thought, this time about our message and approach to supporting democracy around the world. This is based on my work with NDI in the Middle East and North Africa.

As you may recall, I worked with the government of Lebanon, political parties and NGOs in a number of countries. We kept running into problems with the way democracy assistance was viewed in the U.S. and abroad.

Because of Bush's belligerence and the way the Republicans talk about advancing democracy as "promoting American values" and "winning the ideological war," the word "democracy" itself was tainted.

People who should support democracy and democratic governance were suspicious or hostile. Democratic reformers in many countries were put on the defensive, and even put in danger.

The Republican approach was more about selling democracy. Karen Hughes went around delivering lectures. They ran advertising campaigns, which were not well received overseas. (That's not surprising, since polls show commercial marketing and Hollywood exports contribute to negative perceptions of America.)

This is not to belittle good work done in public diplomacy, but the general orientation toward selling democracy as a concept (particularly in the context of invading Iraq) was ineffective at best and counter-productive at worst.

In response, we developed a new way to talk about this work that would distinguish our (Democratic) approach from the Republicans.

We talked about it as "helping people build democratic institutions." This frames the U.S. as helping people on the ground, rather than lecturing them about abstract principles. "Democratic institutions" are fair elections, representative political parties, independent citizens' groups and government that is open and accountable.

We focused on the benefits to foreign publics: "Democratic institutions and processes can help people in any society resolve conflicts peacefully and improve their lives."

And to the American public: "Helping people build more democratic societies will contribute to greater peace and stability throughout the world."

This isn't to retreat from proactively advancing democracy, which Democrats have long embraced. It's framing the work in more concrete terms and focusing on the benefits to people's lives.

I hope that's useful food for thought. There's more to this, and I'm happy to chat about it if you're interested. We can also talk about the aspirational messaging, if you'd like to follow up on our previous exchange on that.

I met with Dr. Mugwege whom Eve Ensler brought to DC. They had hoped to meet with you and I promised to relay their message to you. Dr. M is as close as I'll ever come to meeting a live saint. Bob Herbert wrote about him a few days ago in a gripping column. Dr. M runs a small clinic in eastern Congo that serves hundreds of women every day whom he and his small team try to sew up after they are brutally raped and tortured in what has become nothing less than sexual terrorism. Fistula results from most cases and many are so bad they can't be repaired. As you know, this is rape as a tool of war but a purposeful war strategy to gain valuable minerals by destroying the life sustaining role that women play and thereby subduing entire communities.

Dr. M and Eve also met with Boxer, Feingold and Durbin (in separate meetings) today. Boxer is going to focus her first subcommittee hearing on violence against women in Darfur and the DRC. She would like to take a high-level Codel to Congo to meet with the women and hear about the consequences of the systematic rapes firsthand and focus greater attention on the violence. She is also going to push for a UN-trained women's strike force to protect women and for more federal assistance for protection and treatment.

Durbin and Feingold are interested in getting legislation passed that would require certification of minerals imported from DRC, like coltan which is important for cell phones and laptops. The civilians are terrorized by the rebel groups seeking to capitalize on the mining of these minerals. If there is a relationship, the import would be banned.

Dr. M believes that you — as perhaps the most powerful woman in the world — can really make a difference on the behalf of the brutally violated women in DRC.

*Need greater protection for civilians. There needs to be support for new Congolese armed forces and training of women policy officers and other steps to deal with the sexual violence.

Dr. M gave me a letter that Sen. Obama sent to Condi Rice in late 2007 with a series of questions about what the State Dept was doing to deal with the systematic violence in Congo. Last year Rice presided over a Security Council hearing to gain passage for US-led SC Res 1820 condemning rape as a tool of war. Little has happened in the six months since, but a report and plan of action is due in June.

There is great expectation that you, the President and Susan Rice will bring new, desperately needed leadership to this challenge. For her part, Eve has launched a worldwide grassroots campaign against the violence being perpetrated against women in Congo.

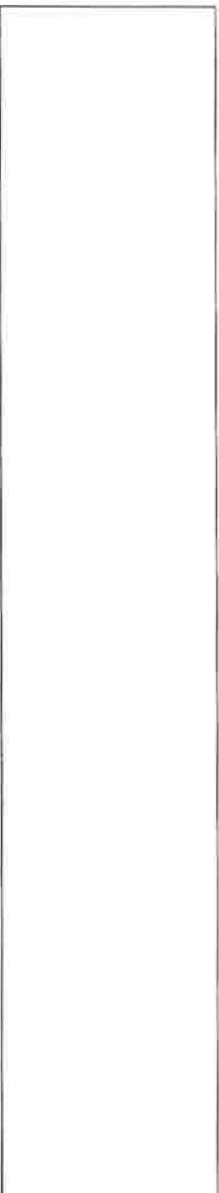

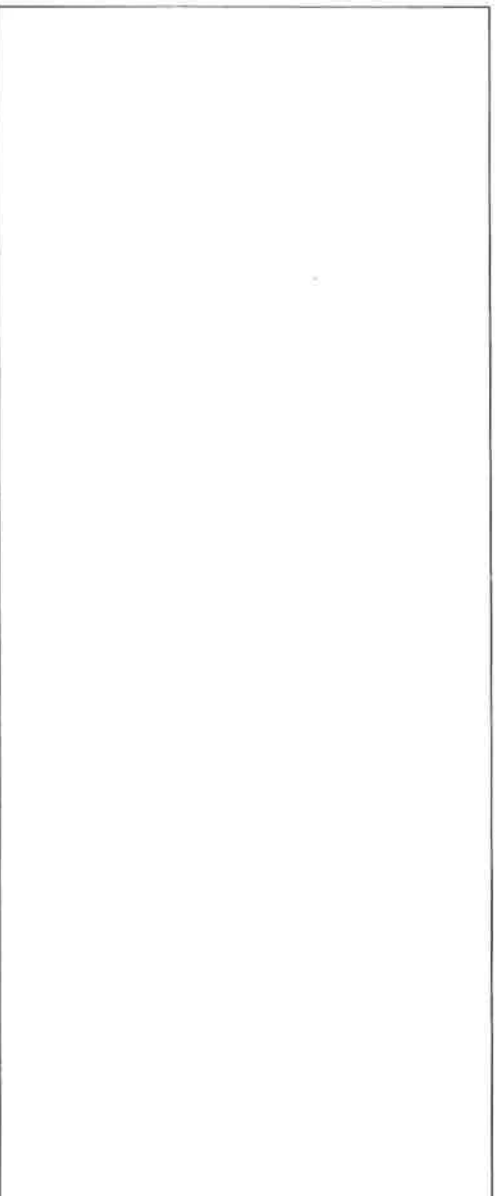

I feel like I'm in limbo but trying to do what's allowable on the women's front.

I wanted to raise a few issues regarding your upcoming trip.

China - the state of female migrant workers is booming as a big challenge and exacerbated by the economic downturn. About half of the 130 million migrant workers are women. The Chinese government just announced that 20 million migrant workers have lost jobs. Women's fate is compounded by the fact that 85 million are reported suffering from domestic violence and an unknown number are victims of trafficking. According to the All China Women's Federation, 1/3 of China's 267 million families have witnessed domestic violence and 94% are of the victims are women. A Chinese court in 2008 issued the first ever protective order to a domestic violence victim ... so far 6 have been issued in 3 localities. A central government document now mandates police to respond to DV complaints made through hotlines and mandate the All-China Women's Federation to establish DV hotlines throughout the country. The All-China Women's Federation is committed to getting a domestic violence law approved this year. Also China has finally issued the national action plan on combating trafficking in women and children to adopt a comprehensive approach to trafficking. They have a long way to go but this represents progress.

If there's anyway to mention pressing concerns affecting women, particularly protecting migrant workers, the urgency of protecting victims of domestic violence and trafficking, it could make a difference.

If you have time to meet with any women or to include them in an already planned for discussion, there are several women (some of whom you met during your 1998 trip to China and again at Vital Voices event, as well as the representative of All-China Women's Federation, Chen Zhili). I can provide contact information if there's interest, as can Susan O'Sullivan in DRL.

Finally on HIV/AIDS

ZENG JINYAN is the wife of the famous HIV/AIDS activist and detainee Hu Jia who was nominated for a Nobel Peace Prize. Sec. Rice raised his case in 2008 as he has been detained since 2007 for testifying on TV for the EU about China's human rights situation.

Zheng, his wife, was selected by TIME as one of the 100 most influential people in the world.

She is under house arrest with her 2 year-old daughter for speaking out on behalf of her husband.

Zheng and Hu were our messengers to Dr Gao when we were trying to get her to come to Washington in 2006. ZHENG TRANSLATED YOUR LETTER TO THE CHINESE PRESIDENT AND PREMIER, AS WELL AS THE VITAL VOICES INVITATION INTO CHINESE FOR DR. GAO. If there's anyway you could meet with Zheng it would send a strong and personal message for human rights.

I don't know where DRL and the China desk come down on all of this, but I thought you'd want to know. You have no shortage of experts in the building.

Japan - The DCM, James Zurwall, is the Charge. He is terrific. His wife, ANN KAMBARA, is also a Foreign Service officer. She took the lead when Baker was Ambassador (strongly supported by Nancy Kassebaum at the time), to get the Japanese to address the terrible trafficking problem, which had been largely ignored. (John Miller wanted to come down hard on the Japanese and Nancy knew that would be a counterproductive strategy with the Japanese.) Nancy brought in Vital Voices to engage others from around the world and demonstrate to the Japanese that this was a global problem that we all had to address. We worked really closely with Ann who did a terrific job of pulling a regional meeting together of top governments and NGOs - first time Japanese govt was in same room with the NGOs. It had a very positive impact and the work continues.

If you have a chance to thank Ann for her work on trafficking, it would be well deserved.

She is a huge fan of yours. She had me do a speaking tour in different parts of Japan for the embassy and I learned a great deal about the rather nascent state of civil society and the strictures on young women to leave the work force once they become mothers. This is creating a real problem as the birth rate there is dropping significantly.

Rep Kucinich would like to exit Gaza into Israel through Erez, but it's unclear when. Egyptian MFA has asked MOD to provide transport from Cairo to Rafah. MFA is also coordinating airport pick-up, transport within Cairo and hotel accommodations for the night of Feb 14.

POC at the Cleveland-based NGO said that the purpose of the trip to the region is to enter Gaza, and that Ohio constituents have asked Rep Kucinich to do this. Dates could get pushed back a few days because of the stimulus vote. Rep Kucinich's staffer Amy Vossbrink told me she thinks Kucinich may want to travel from Israel to Doha.

☐ I have been in touch with staff and case workers, but am told that I just have to wait and see. Am certain you had a productive trip. Your public comments were right on the mark!

I was initially disappointed you could not get to Iraq, Al/Frk, the M.E. on your first trip, given their priority and POTUS near term decisions on Iraq/Alq. But I do understand, the special envoys were in the region and I assume you did not want to undermine the significance of their visit by following in on their heels.

I respect your choice, the far east, our second most challenging neighborhood and avoiding, at least initially, the normal tendency to visit our friends in Europe. Am convinced in the 21st C. the center of gravity for international security and strife has moved east, out of Europe, where it was centered for most of the 20thC.

I visited Shouikh Muhammad(De' Min) for a few hours on last Saturday, in a private discussion, at his residence in Abu Dhabi. I found him to be quite impressive, a young, dynamic leader who is surprisingly modest, yet a visionary leader who is well grounded in reality. The most powerful influence in UAE, despite his older brother, the President, he is destined to succeed him. Believe when you and the POTUS are formulating plans for the region, you should rely on the wisdom of certain key regional leaders whose judgment you trust(know you are doing this but POTUS, has few, if any, relationships in the region). SM is one of the now forward looking leaders, in addition to the Emir and CP of Bahrain and the Sultan of Oman. I was struck by how similar SM is in temperament and personality to the POTUS. We discussed many of his concerns, and of course, he wanted advice on all of it(would prefer to discuss this on the phone).

One issue is that he desires an early and influential relationship with the Obama Team and is planning to officially seek a visit during last 2 weeks of March. Anything you can do to assist is appreciated. BTW, I have no financial relationship with SM, although he did host my stay at the Emirates Palace Hotel! He desires me to return to discuss the same issues with his brothers and some other UAE influential leaders in the next few months.

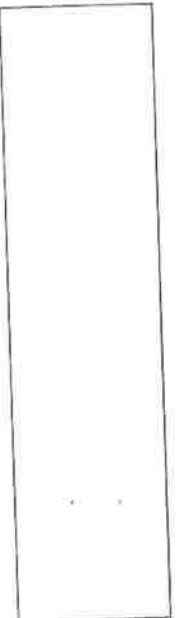
