Hi Hillary, I just received some great news. [redacted]

Many thanks for your supportive CFR letter. Your endorsement meant a lot to me on both the personal and professional level

I remain very grateful and look forward to the opportunity to thank you in person.

Fyi, late last month, I visited India for 10 days and am working several issues related to the Mumbai terror attacks. I am in Manama, Bahrain next week chairing a panel on Border Security and Control issues and will be meeting with the former head of Indian intelligence (Kumar Davol) to further discuss the implications of the Mumbai attacks and the current Pakistan / India border security concerns.

I am presently in Vienna, Austria enroute DC having just completed an intensive eight day visit to Kurdistan, Iraq along with half a dozen other retired senior Officers and former US Government officials. Gen Jay Garner (US Army retired) and former Army Undersecretary Joe Reeder also participated.

The schedule included visits with senior Iraq and Kurdish leadership figures (Dinner with Mrs Talabani, Breakfast with Prime Minister Barzani, Meetings with the Governors of Erbil, Sulaimaniya and Dahuk etc).

Tours of the Koya University facilities, as well as various Regional Police and Military training schools were conducted

The discussions held with students, clergy, and an inspiring group of "women against violence" were informative and educational.

Our visit up to the Turkey-Kurdistan border area enabled us to observe first hand the growing oil export trade being conducted by Kurdistan via trucks. Seeing the various Turkish Army encampments actually inside Kurdistan was also revealing and reflective of the tensions caused by PKK attacks.

Of note, we shopped openly in the souks in Kurdistan and were received warmly. I felt very comfortable and secure out in the towns and villages of Kurdistan. Life is never risk free but the feel was very good.

My overall impression is that Kurdistan is prosperous with lots of development projects ongoing and the Kurdish people are tremendously pro US. They have newly formed democratic institutions and a true eagerness to support US policies for a unified Iraq. They know their future security depends on it.

That said, the Kurds also have a growing concern that without significantly increased US attention to the resolution of the City of Kirkuk and the other disputed areas, that their prosperity could unravel very quickly as a result of a civil war over these disputed areas - particularly Kirkuk.

Assignment of a special US envoy to help resolve the Kurdistan issues was encouraged by many Kurds as well as the idea of opening a US consulate office in the Kurdistan Regional Government (KRG) capital of Erbil to facilitate better communications.

Hillary, our outbrief regarding the Kurdistan trip would admittedly be very " pro Kurd " but that voice probably needs to be heard so it can be fully factored into our overall US foreign policy for Iraq and the region.

As you well know, a clear "US" policy regarding the Kurds has been sorely needed for quite some time. The Kurds have found themselves sandwiched between Syria, Turkey, Iran and Iraq - leading to horrific incidents of abuse.

On the US front, they have also been unfortunately caught between the segmented desks at DOD (Eucom vs Centcom) as well as various desks at the State Department which divide coverage in such a way that it has hindered efforts to formulate a more coherent Kurd policy.

If your schedule permits, I would like to suggest our group provide you a 30 minute update/pulse point regarding Iraq and the Kurdistan Regional Government (KRG) relationship. It may be useful for you to receive it, along with other key members of your team, as you deal with Kirkuk and article 140 of the Iraqi Constitution (dealing with the resolution of the remaining disputed territories).

Our brief may also allow for the opening of another channel of information for the State Department about the situation on the ground in Kurdistan - particularly as US forces prepare to leave Iraq. Jay Garner from our group is wired into the highest levels of the Kurdistan Government (KRG) and is treated as a local hero by all the Kurds that we visited with because of his role in saving Kurdish lives during Operation Provide Comfort in the early 90's.

On a personal level, I am happy to help you and your State Department team in any way I can. I know Jay Garner already has a personal relationship with Jim Jones based on their previous time together in this region and that Jay does not hesitate to give Jim a call in his new job at NSC.

I just talked to Guo. She said it was a really good meeting, very substantive. HRC played so many different roles, host, commentator, and mediator during the discussion, which showed her keen interest in women's issues. It was open to the western press but no Chinese press was allowed, and the All-China Women's Federation official was announced "sick," so didn't participate. The 8 women had a great time. Guo and Gao sat next to her. She was impressed how HRC remembers everyone and knows very well about everyone's work. The press asked them questions too. The meeting went longer. It was supposed to end around 11:20 but it went close to noon. She said the Chinese press generally was very positive in reporting HRC's visit. In the past, they liked to describe HRC as a "tough" and "cold" woman but this time, the press changed their tone, saying she is very "kind" and "warm." This meeting means a lot to the women because HRC has a busy schedule and was willing to include this program.

Issue:

How can we define a relationship with China that establishes clear, verifiable markers for responsible behavior and that is reassuring to our Asian friends and allies? What requests should we make, and what is the quid pro quo that we can offer? How might the global economic downturn create unexpected opportunities for us in our relations with China?

Background:

The continuing domestic legitimacy concerns of the Chinese Communist Party (CCP), exacerbated by current economic conditions, raise questions about China's ability to act as a responsible stakeholder abroad. Past efforts to reach agreement with China on general political principles have not resolved outstanding problems. To achieve cooperative relations, therefore, we must be specific about what we would like China to do. Success in a high-visibility arena such as national security will make it much more likely that economic relations proceed cooperatively.

Our overall objective is to create conditions in Asia such that all countries, large and small, feel secure, so that economic growth can resume and peaceful relations can flourish. Over the longer term, this will require cooperative relations among the United States,

Japan, and India, as well as China. In the short term, we should seek a set of concrete actions by China.

For the United States, the most urgent issues on the agenda include the economic downturn, Pakistan, and Iran. For China's leaders, the most urgent is their domestic position, threatened by increasingly visible signs of a dramatic economic reversal. Therefore, we should propose actions that will appeal to the Party as bolstering its legitimacy. Actions along these lines could, however, be perceived as slighting our friends and allies, unless handled properly. Pending discussions with the Japanese and the Indians, the action items for China offered below are limited to information-sharing proposals that could, if successful, lead to multilateral discussions involving the United States, China, Japan, and India. The payoff for the CCP in terms of regime legitimacy would only be delivered later, when and if these initial steps led to a more visible role for China as a leader within the community of Asian powers and global stakeholders safeguarding the interests of peace and development in the 21st century.

Action items:

Economic Issues

The interests of the United States and China are aligned in seeking to prevent a protectionist turn that would impede economic recovery. China as an export-driven economy is particularly vulnerable. This is not just an economic or financial issue. It directly impinges on Chinese political stability. Therefore, it is important that China understand the rationale for expanding its security cooperation with the United States as a way of limiting the space for American political forces to target China's economic interests. The discussion of security-related subjects below includes recommendations for actions that China could take toward this end.

Pakistan

The goal is to create an international partnership to ensure the security of Pakistan's nuclear weapons and limit the further growth of Pakistan's arsenal – to prevent proliferation to terrorists in the event of state failure and to contain a potential nuclear arms race in the region. The partnership should involve the United States, India, and China, which has a particular responsibility as the source of Pakistan's original nuclear weapons design and as a continuing sponsor of nuclear reactors in Pakistan.

- We request that China participate in expert talks that address China's current activities in connection with the development of Pakistan's nuclear reactors; China's plans for the future in this area; and China's knowledge of Pakistan's nuclear technology infrastructure.
- We request that China participate in expert talks that address the state of Pakistan's nuclear warhead design.
- We request that China participate in expert talks about the adequacy of Pakistan's nuclear weapons custody arrangements under current and foreseeable conditions within Pakistan.
- The United States would undertake to provide experts to participate in these meetings and provide corresponding information.

Iran

The Chinese have few incentives to limit their economic interactions with and technology transfers to Iran because they give China influence in a key oil-exporting country. American efforts to limit Chinese trade with Iran, therefore, may need to be linked to broader efforts to protect oil-importing countries from threats to their energy security. If China is willing to work with the United States and other countries to prevent Iran from gaining nuclear weapons, the United States is willing to cooperate with China on measures to ensure the flow of oil from the Persian Gulf.

- We request a meeting to which China sends representatives prepared to address the question of what international arrangements would be sufficient to reassure China of the security of its supplies of energy from the Persian Gulf
- We request that Chinese representatives discuss with the United States China's activities and plans in the Persian Gulf and Indian Ocean littorals with regard to bilateral or multilateral agreements for port access, arms transfer relationships, and other measures to ensure China's energy supplies in the absence of such international arrangements.
- The United States would undertake to provide corresponding information.

Mr. RANGEL introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on Transportation and Infrastructure

A BILL

To designate the Federal building located at 799 United Nations Plaza in New York, New York, as the 'Ronald H. Brown United States Mission to the United Nations Building'.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the United States of America in Congress assembled.

SECTION 1. DESIGNATION.

Dear Madame Secretary and Cheryl -

We repeat our urging you to hire [redacted] or someone else senior for the personnel function, lodging it in White House Liaison for now. We believe that doing personnel correctly from the outset was important enough to have someone senior doing it. That's why we're doing it.

On the intake, it helps: senior people (Leo Hamilton, Strobe Talbot) whom we know meet with us at a moment's notice and give us their personal reactions openly; younger folks will meet with us because they think we are credible; we know things about who knows who/dislikes, was divorced from whom. We know who is related.

On the evaluation side, a senior person [redacted] can make decent judgments and save you and HRC lots of time by eliminating people you will not want to deal with. A person like [redacted] can deliver bad news to important people who are not selected in a way a junior person cannot -- and you should never be giving the bad news.

On the process side, an experienced person like [redacted] can make the [redacted] function for you by making things easy for [redacted] being knowledgeable and charming and generally getting you better treatment than those "represented" to the office by junior grade nice folks who are clueless. [redacted] will be able to write the forwarding letter in a way designed to please and encourage the [redacted] to expedite folks. [redacted] can set up a process in the office that will work into the future.

The whole personnel process, particularly at State where it is complicated by FSO considerations, is complex, time-consuming and filled with possible derailments and detours -- you need someone senior to ramrod it, certainly in the first six months.

If you don't get the people right in the Department -- and right away -- you are going to lose precious time and political capital you can't get back. We STRONGLY urge a senior person to get this started the right way right away.

[redacted] shouldn't do it forever -- [redacted] should do it for six months or so and then move on to one of the positions held by a career person or something else that suits [redacted]. But if you go with a junior person now, you will be paying for it for at least a year or more, and probably for all four years. The comparative advantage of someone knowledgeable for State versus what appears to be a [redacted] is huge -- you should not give that away!

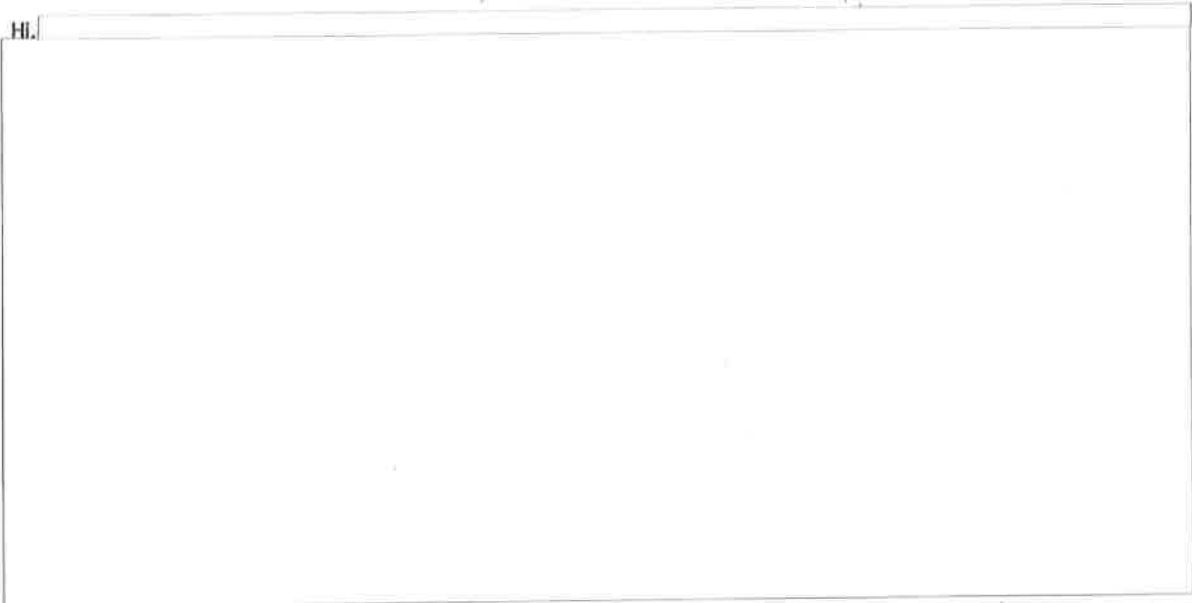

An Opportunity Missed, But Not Lost: What President Bush Should Have Written to Iranian President Mahmoud Ahmadinejad

This February marks the 30th anniversary of the Iranian revolution. In what may yet prove to be an historical milestone of another kind, on February 10, President Mahmoud Ahmadinejad of Iran appeared to reach out to the Obama administration, saying that Tehran was ready for "talks based on mutual respect and in a fair atmosphere." This possible overture in what has otherwise seemed to be an unbreachable divide between the United States and Iran during the administration of President George W. Bush reminded me that the possibility of rapproche ment between our two nations arose just a few years ago, but was ignored. I am referring to the fact that in May 2006, President Ahmadinejad wrote a far-ranging, 18-page letter to President George Bush discussing religious values, history and international relations. The letter went unanswered. During Ahmadinejad's visit to the UN later that year, he expressed his deep disappointment that President Bush had not responded to his missive.

As a student of the region and of United States-Iran relations, I believed then, and I believe now, that this was a missed opportunity—one of many. Ahmadinejad's letter provided President Bush with an opportunity to address the Iranian people directly to highlight America's longstanding relationship with Iran and clarify the Bush administration's views on the U.S.-Iran relationship.

At the time, thinking about these issues, I drafted a letter that might have served as a response by President Bush to the Iranian people. I offer it here.

I had a very long conversation w Sen Conrad. The outlook for passing any budget is, in his opinion, (as it perennially is) grim. The new CBO deficit number of 2.3T is 700B off OMB forecast. The projected deficits of 1T/yr amount to 5-6% of GDP. As he said, we wouldn't be able to join the EU.

Bottom line: he knows we've made a strong case and he'll do all he can, but we'll have to fight thru conference. He doesn't think he will get any R votes in committee or on the floor, and he already knows he won't get Den Nelson and Evan Dayh. So w neither Franken or Kennedy, he faces a big challenge. Jack will remember the cliffhanger we had in '93

Therefore, he said the following: he knows we did the right thing putting recurring programs into the budget, rather than using supps as in the past 8 years. But the reality still is that the big increase from 09 to 10 is a shocker for people even when they understand. (For many members the supplementals were funny money since they didn't go into the base so everyone could pretend the budgets were less than actual expenditures.)

He is moving lots of \$ out of the budget, including 250B for TARP II. The OMB increase for us is 28% not 40% since the IMF money is no longer attributed to the international affairs budget. But, the average non defense domestic increase is 10.6%. So we stick out at 2.5x as much. So he cut us by 4B but will fight to hold the line there. He thinks that is better than losing the overall vote on the floor or a vote to strip out more of our \$.

He has told the WH not to send the supp up in the midst of the budget fight or even this scennrio won't work. It will cause "sticker shock" and complicate everything. Members are overloaded by TARP-Stimulus-Omnibus-Budget so adding a Supp and Tarp II would cause an implosion.

I spoke also w Spratt who gave me same message about Obey as Jack rec'd. He said he would help and we need to get a better # out of the House so we have more leverage in conference.

Seey Gates also talked w Conrad on our behalf

I'll share more when I see you tomorrow.

Failed to discuss a concern I have about Iraq. The security we established has enabled significant political progress, particularly the provincial elections in January, which fundamentally strengthens and changes how the Iraq people relate to their government and, in general, the maturation of the political process. Certainly watching the Council of Representatives check some of Malik's grab for increased power is a welcome development.

Yet, there are significant challenges ahead: the territorial dispute between the Sunni Arabs and Kurds, resolution of Kirkuk, oil revenue sharing, a final reconciliation with the Sunnis and Malik's strongman tendencies. This is work where USG can play a vital role in assisting the GOI and the key constituencies to work toward common goals for the betterment of Iraq. And they are achievable; how far the Iraqis have come since 2006 is nothing short of remarkable. It could not have been done without our help.

I am concerned that the GOI and other key Iraq influencers believe the USG is no longer committed to their long term development and stability (I also pick it up from Sunni Arab leaders in the region). Believe they draw this conclusion, primarily from POTUS remarks about Iraq which carry far more emphasis on ending the war than a long term strategic partnership with Iraq. Notwithstanding, how we entered the Iraq war and the three years of a failed strategy, which helped to divide our nation, there is a real strategic opportunity in front of us, that involves our support for a democratic, stable Iraq that is aligned with the US. The Strategic Framework Agreement (which both govts signed) pretty much lays this out and is a far more significant document than the Status of Forces, which, by necessity, is narrow in scope. The SFA is about a long term relationship which goes well beyond our current military one and appropriately involves a political, diplomatic, economic and cultural relationship. This agreement should be followed up with substantive implementation by both governments, but it won't happen unless we push it. It's a fact, the Iraqis want to be our partner but it is also true they have choices if that doesn't materialize. and it is this reality which concerns thoughtful leaders in and outside of Iraq. The Iranians understand this and are threatened by a US/Iraq partnership which helps to realize the democratic and human rights aspirations of the Iraq people.

One of the failings of incoming administrations is their inability to accept, at times, the success of their predecessors as they are so preoccupied with the failures. The Bush team failed to accept Bosnia and Kosovo for what they were: foreign policy successes, by the Clinton team, that stabilized southern Europe after 4 debilitating wars in the region. Preoccupied with "nation building" as a failed Clinton strategy and their desire to do the minimum to avoid dependency of the host nation on USG, it led the Bush team to a grossly under resourced Afghanistan that we are just beginning to address after 8 years and a similar mismatch in Iraq which came dangerously close to strategic failure.

Am afraid the Obama team is doing the same in Iraq as it fails to come to grips with the success of Iraq, due largely to Bush's "surge" decision, and is somewhat paralyzed by the previous investment in an opposing strategy. As such, we are failing to forge a strong relationship with our Iraqis partners, to help them to move through their challenges and to continue to stand with them as a strategic partner. They are the only Arab Muslim state which genuinely elects its leaders. This is a dagger to the heart of the extremists in the region and it offers so much hope and potential for so many in the autocratic and, in some cases, repressed regimes.

Also, I spoke with folks at the Clinton Foundation this am. There is a great need to get relief workers and AID down there. Through [redacted] we have the airlift to get it down there. Again- all that's needed is an order...

I think this humanitarian disaster could provide a unique opportunity to pair State with a non-profit with the Marines. We just need to get the ball rolling.

I honestly cannot tell you how many times I yelled at the TV over the holidays as expert pundit after expert pundit commenting on the latest unsuccessful terror plot never seemed to hone in on the lack of opportunity that exists in so many parts of the world and thus, these young people are coerced into joining a destructive 'movement'. I don't see much difference with disaffected youth in this country although those who seek to do us harm in that manner have of course taken it to an entirely different level.....

Nevertheless, I feel that what we could potentially offer would help address this systemic problem, further your goals, and truly inject into the dialogue some positive stories about the United States' influence/role in the world and in particular, in areas where we may be viewed as 'occupiers' or worse. Heck, maybe as a bonus we'll even get a positive story or two about the American labor movement and/or America's Building Trades Unions but I won't hold my breath in that regard :-)
