Important to point out that I consulted with HQ, Pat Kelly and WFO counsel in March of 2015 when Jill was making her decision. Kelly advised me on the Hatch act and following his advice I decided that I would play no role in the campaign. Other than appearing unidentified in one family photo that was used in a maller, I played no role.

Late February to early March 2015: Jill was contacted by Lt Gov Ralph Northam and asked to consider running. She had two follow on conversations with other female, democratic state senators exploring the possibility.
