ASK:

What is a single deputy response?

ADD:

If you are on scene or in the area and hear gunshots, You should immediately access what you have and prepare to respond.

Remember, every time you hear a gunshot in an active shooter incident; you have to believe that is another victim being killed.

ASK:

How many of you have shot a moving target? Was it easy or hard?

ADD:

Remember, speed and movement are your best friend when approaching by yourself. Be unpredictable in your movement.

SAY: Look for positions of cover.

ASK:

Is the gunfire getting louder? Do you see people fleeing from an area? Do you smell gunpowder? Do you see bodies?

ADD:

Use your senses to gain a better perspective of the event. Move with speed and be decisive.

ASK:

What is the third eye principle?

ADD: When searching, the gun stays up with your eyes and moves together.

SAY:

You should have a method of containing your own
