UPON ARRIVAL I MADE ENTRY WITH OTHER OFFICERS INTO THE FIRST FLOOR OF BUILDING ONE. WE CONTINUED TO CLEAR THE FIRST AND SECOND FLOOR OF BUILDING ONE ENCOUNTERING NUMEROUS TEACHERS, ADMINISTRATORS, AND STUDENTS. WE THEN MOVED UPSTAIRS TO THE SECOND FLOOR OF BUILDING TWO. WE AGAIN ENCOUNTER MULTIPLE TEACHERS AND STUDENTS WHO WERE HIDING INSIDE ROOMS AND CLOSETS. IT SHOULD BE NOTED THAT I DID NOT COME ACROSS ANY PERSONS WHO WERE INJURED OR DECEASED DURING THIS PROCESS. I DID NOT CONDUCT ANY FURTHER INVESTIGATION INTO THIS INCIDENT.

ON 2/14/18 AT APPROXIMATELY 1515 HOURS, I RESPONDED TO MARJORY STONEMAN DOUGLAS HIGH SCHOOL IN REFERENCE TO AN ACTIVE SHOOTER CALL. WHILE EN ROUTE TO THE SCHOOL, DISPATCH COMMUNICATED THAT THE SUSPECT, LATER IDENTIFIED AS NIKOLAS CRUZ, WAS OBSERVED IN THE AREA OF WYNDHAM LAKES BLVD AND CORAL RIDGE DRIVE. I REDIRECTED TO THE AREA AS OFFICERS WERE TAKING CRUZ INTO CUSTODY. WHILE ON SCENE, I ASSISTED WITH TRAFFIC CONTROL, SCENE SECURITY AND MEDIA STAGING OUTSIDE OF THE GOLDEN BAY RESIDENTIAL COMMUNITY (11700 WYNDHAM LAKES BLVD SOUTH).

ON 2/14/18, AT APPROXIMATELY 1430 HRS I RESPONDED TO MARJORY STONEMAN DOUGLAS HIGH SCHOOL REFERENCE TO AN ACTIVE SHOOTER. UPON ARRIVAL, I PARKED AT THE SOUTH GATES OF THE SCHOOL AND DEPLOYED MY DEPARTMENTAL ISSUED AR-15 RIFLE. UNKNOWN AT THIS TIME WHERE THE ACTIVE SHOOTER WAS LOCATED, I STARTED CLEARING THE BUSES LOCATED IN THE SOUTH PARKING LOT. WHILE CLEARING THE BUSES, I CAME IN CONTACT WITH BUS DRIVERS AND DIRECTED THEM OFF THE BUS AND SENT THEM TOWARDS DET. HALLMAN, WHO ASSISTED THEM OFF SCHOOL GROUNDS. ONCE THE BUSES WERE CLEARED, I STARTED CHECKING THE PORTABLES WITH SGT. REID AND DET. DELUCA. ONCE THE PORTABLES WERE CLEARED, I ASSISTED THE OFFICERS AND DEPUTIES WITH SECURING THE SOUTH SIDE OF THE SCHOOL WHILE THE CLASSROOMS WERE BEING CHECKED BY SWAT PERSONNEL.

AFTER CLEARING THE SCENE, I RESPONDED TO THE HERON BAY MARRIOTT WITH DETECTIVES FROM CIU TO COORDINATE WITH FBI FOR INTERVIEWING THE STUDENTS WHO WERE INSIDE THE SCHOOL. ONCE THE INTERVIEWS WERE COMPLETED BY THE DETECTIVES, I CLEARED THE SCENE. I HAD NO FURTHER INVOLVEMENT IN THE CASE.

ON 2/14/18 AROUND 1500 HOURS, I RESPONDED TO AN ACTIVE SHOOTER AT STONEMAN DOUGLAS HIGH SCHOOL. I TOOK UP A PERIMETER POSITION IN THE SHOPPING CENTER IN THE 5600 BLOCK OF CORAL RIDGE DRIVE AS I WAS INFORMED THE SHOOTER WAS STILL AT LARGE. INFORMATION WAS THEN PROVIDED THAT THE SHOOTER WAS POSSIBLY IN THE MCDONALD'S LOCATED IN THE SHOPPING CENTER I WAS AT. OTHER UNITS IMMEDIATELY CONVERGED ON THE MCDONALD'S WHILE I MAINTAINED MY PERIMETER POSITION DUE TO THE POSSIBILITY THE SHOOTER WAS INSIDE ONE OF THE BUSINESSES I WAS IN FRONT OF OR WITHIN THE PARKING LOT. THE SUSPECT WAS NOT LOCATED AT MCDONALD'S. ONCE THE SUSPECT WAS DETAINED AT A NEARBY LOCATION, I RESPONDED TO THE HERON BAY MARRIOTT TO ASSIST BUSES THAT WERE GOING TO DROP PEOPLE OFF FROM THE SCHOOL. I POSITIONED MY VEHICLE WITH LIGHTS ACTIVATED IN THE CENTER MEDIAN OF THE PARKING LOT ENTRANCE TO ASSIST IN DIRECTING THE BUSES INTO PARKING LOT.

ONCE BUSES ARRIVED, I ASSISTED IN ESCORTING STUDENTS AND ADULTS TO THE SIGN IN TABLES.

AROUND 1800 HOURS, I RELIEVED BSO DEPUTY C. NEVES AT ONE OF THE SIGN IN TABLES AND SIGNED IN INDIVIDUALS WHILE CONDUCTING PRELIMINARY INTERVIEWS TO DISTINGUISH BETWEEN WITNESSES AND NON-WITNESSES THAT WERE BEING SEPARATED.

I WAS LATER RELIEVED OF SIGN IN DUTIES AND ASSISTED SORTING INDIVIDUALS ENTERING THE BUILDING AND TRAFFIC CONTROL IN THE PARKING LOT. THIS TASK WAS LATER TURNED OVER TO BSO.

On Wednesday, February 14, 2018, I responded to Marjory Stoneman Douglas High School located at 5901 N Pine Island Rd., Parkland, FL after a broadcast report over CSPD Dispatch's main channel of an active shooter on MSD campus.

Upon arrival, I parked my unmarked police vehicle on Pine Island Rd., directly East of the faculty and staff parking lot/bus drop-off. I retrieved my carbine from it's case in my trunk and proceed along the East side of the high school, past buildings 1 and 8. As I approached building 12, I observed CSPD officers enter the East door of building 12. I joined with Detective Winn and moved North and then West along the parking lot and positioned myself to cover the North and West side of building 12 in the event the suspect exited the building or in case shots were fired from a elevated position from the building.

After word was received that the suspect was observed on video exiting the building to the West and South approximately 20 minutes earlier, Detective Winn and I moved further West along building 13 and down to the SW corner of building 13.

I was directed by Captain McKeone to hold that position and cover building 6 while SWAT officers conducted building clearings. As buildings were cleared, I helped to direct students and staff as they egressed the campus to a safe staging area to the North.

Once the scene was secured, I was directed to respond to the Marriott Heron Bay Golf Resort. Upon arrival, contact was made with Sergeant Reid and I was instructed to assist the Victim Advocates from Coral Springs PD, Broward Sheriff's Office, and the Federal Bureau of Investigation. I was released from these duties at 9:30 pm.

I had no further involvement in this case.

On 02/14/18 at 1427 hours, I arrived at Marjory Stoneman Douglas HS (5901 Pine Island Rd.) in reference to an Active Shooter (AOJ).

I parked my marked unit in the south bus loop, took my rifle and began running northbound on the eastside of the school. I did not hear any gunfire and the hallways were completely clear. All of a sudden, a Douglas employee driving a golf cart came to my aid and stated "Jump in with me, I'll take you where you need to go." The employee provided me with suspect information that I immediately BOLO'd over the radio (white male, burgandy shirt (ROTC emblem), black pants, last seen around the 3 story building (1200 bldg.) or the northeast parking lot.) The employee advised he no longer wished to drive any further, due to approaching the unsecure parking lot. I exited the golf cart and ran westbound towards the 1200 bldg. while still trying to keep an eye on the northeast parking lot. I still did not hear any gunfire, and took cover behind a tree trunk and a black SUV directly in front of the 1200 building (east doors). About 40 yards to my left, I observed Dep. Peterson (Douglas SRO) seeking cover behind a concrete column. Dep. Peterson advised he hadn't heard any gunfire for a few minutes and didn't know the exact location of the shooter. Dep. Peterson advised that I needed to watch my back in case the shooter was behind me, hiding in the parking lot. Moments later, CSPD officers and BSO arrived on scene and started search teams entering the 1200 bldg. I held my position in case there was a possible ambush from the parking lot. Other CSPD officers joined me in securing the northeast lot. After a brief wait, we were advised via radio, that the shooter was seen on video exiting the 1200 building (westbound) prior to my arrival.

I joined one of the search teams and assisted gunshot victims by placing them on a golf cart, driven by Ofc. Wilkins, who took them to the rescue staging area. I was approached by a female student who advised she couldn't walk anymore, due to a gunshot wound in her left hip. I carried her to Pine Island Rd. and handed her off to a Deputy. I ran back and observed Ofc. Maclean assisting a female with gunshot wounds to her knees. We lifted up the female and walked her to the CSPD "Bear Cat" vehicle, who took her to the rescue staging area.

I was asked by Sgt. Kozlowski to join another search team to clear the band/theater building of the school. We made contact with students in the band room who advised they were ok. The rest of the building was clear.

On 2/14/18 I responded to Marjory Stoneman Douglas H.S. (Parkland) in reference to an active shooter. Upon my arrival on the SE corner of the school property I coordinated the clearing of the school's SE parking lot along with Det. Bruna, Det. Kull, Officer Mulvey, Officer Coldoros and Officer Anderson. We cleared all cars (east to west) and moved up to several small portable units located on the south side of the property. All unsecured portables were cleared and no contact was made during our searches.

I then assisted in the clearing of the 100 building (Administration Building) 1st floor, with officers from multiple jurisdictions. Upon clearing the 1st floor it was learned that a classroom on the 2nd floor of this building still contained students. Officer Mulvey and I then joined Hallandale SWAT Operators and cleared the building's 2nd floor.

Upon leaving the school I responded to the Marriott Hotel which had been designated a staging area for families and children evacuated from the school and for those who were trying to locate missing family members. There I met with CSPD Victim Advocates (Linarte and Berrios) and coordinating members of the FBI and BSO who were actively trying to determine the names of those killed in the incident. Due to the number of impacted families, I requested detectives from Special Investigations respond in order to assist with coordinating death notifications (Detectives Crawford, Hallman, Kull, Bruna, Mitter, Randazzo, Payne and Koenig).

Later, members of BSO determined that they did not require additional outside support and released all non-BSO members from their assignments. I confirmed with members of the FBI that no further CSPD assistance was needed and all detectives were released from the scene.

Berrios and Linarte remained at the Marriott in order to assist with counseling and death notifications.

ON 2/14/18 I RESPONDED TO THE LISTED ADDRESS IN REFERENCE TO AN ACTIVE KILLER INCIDENT. UPON ARRIVAL I APPROACHED THE NORTH WEST STUDENT PARKING ENTRANCE. OFC. BURTON ADVISED THAT THE SHOOTING OCCURRED IN THE THREE STORY BUILDING ON THE NORTH SIDE OF THE CAMPUS. I WAS DIRECTLY NORTH OF THE WEST ENTRANCE INTO THAT THREE STORY BUILDING (1200 BUILDING). I OBSERVED TWO DEPUTY'S IN THE PARKING LOT, I ASKED THEM WHERE THE SHOOTER WAS BUT THEY ADVISED HIS LOCATION WAS UNKNOWN. I DIRECTED MY ATTENTION TO THE 1200 BUILDING WHERE I OBSERVED A ██████ LYING ON HIS BACK, LATER IDENTIFIED AS ██████. I OBSERVED THE THIRD FLOOR WEST WINDOW WAS STILL INTACT BUT HAD VISIBLE BULLET IMPACT MARKS.

AS I BEGAN MY APPROACH INTO THE BUILDING, I WAS JOINED BY SGT. MAZZEI, SGT. MYERS AND OFC. WILKINS. WE APPROACHED THE WEST DOORS OF BUILDING 1200 AND CHECKED ON ██████ BUT ██████ WAS UNRESPONSIVE. IT SHOULD BE NOTED THAT AT THIS TIME WE WERE UNABLE TO DETERMINE THE SUSPECTS/GUNMAN (NIKOLAS CRUZ) LOCATION AND WERE ACTIVELY SEARCHING FOR HIM. WE ENTERED THE BUILDING AND IMMEDIATELY ENCOUNTERED A ██████ WHO HAD BEEN SHOT, STANDING AGAINST A WALL. THE ██████ LATER IDENTIFIED AS ██████ WAS CONSCIOUS AND BREATHING BUT FELL TO THE FLOOR AND WAS IN SHOCK. ██████ COULD NOT SPEAK OR GIVE ME ANY INFORMATION AS TO THE LOCATION OF THE GUNMAN. WE MOVED TOWARD ██████ AND I GRABBED ██████ BY HIS ARMS DRAGGING HIM OUT OF THE BUILDING, WITH THE ASSISTANCE OF OFC. WILKINS. I LEFT ██████ WITH OFC. WILKINS AND REENTERED THE BUILDING, TO CONTINUE THE SEARCH FOR THE GUNMAN. THE HALLWAY WAY QUIET AND FULL OF THICK SMOKE FROM GUNFIRE. AS WE MOVED EAST, I ENCOUNTERED A WHITE FEMALE TAKING SHELTER IN AN OFFICE, NEAR WHERE ██████ WAS AND REMOVED HER FROM THE BUILDING.

AT THIS POINT MORE CORAL SPRINGS OFFICERS MADE ENTRY INTO THE EAST DOORS OF BUILDING 1200. IN ORDER TO AVOID A CROSS FIRE, WE MADE THE DECISION TO CONTINUE THE SEARCH FOR THE GUNMAN ON THE SECOND FLOOR. ONCE ON THE SECOND FLOOR WE BEGAN LOCATING STUDENTS AND TEACHERS HIDING IN THE CLASSROOMS. WE STILL DID NOT KNOW THE GUNMAN'S LOCATION AND AS SUCH KEPT THE STUDENTS IN THE CLASSROOMS. ONCE THE SECOND FLOOR WAS SECURED, I MOVED TO ASSIST WITH CLEARING THE THIRD FLOOR. ON THE THIRD FLOOR I ENCOUNTERED SEVERAL DECEASED STUDENTS THROUGHOUT THE HALL WAY. I MADE MY WAY EAST, DOWN THE HALLWAY WHERE I WAS ASKED (BY BSO SWAT) TO STAND BY AND HOLD ON A DOOR. ONCE THE THIRD FLOOR WAS RENDERED SAFE AND CLEARED OF ANY THREATS, I RESPONDED TO BUILDING 13 AND ASSISTED CLEARING ROOMS THERE. BUILDING 13 WAS CLEARED OF ALL THREATS AND RENDERED SAFE.

On 02/14/2018 at approximately 1428 hours I was exiting briefing at the Coral Springs Police Department located at 2801 Coral Springs Drive in the City of Coral Springs, Florida when I did hear from an unknown Coral Springs Fire personnel that there was an active shooter at Marjory Stoneman Douglas High School located at 5901 Pine Island Road in the City of Parkland, Florida.

I immediately switched to information channel and requested confirmation from Coral Springs Dispatch if in fact there was an active shooter at Stoneman Douglas High School and I was advised there was. I immediately responded code three with my assigned police vehicle (9400) to Stoneman Douglas High School. I arrived within two minutes. As I made a left from Pine Island Road onto Holmberg Road, I saw approximately four Broward County Sheriff's Office vehicles parked in the west bound lane with their personnel taking up exterior positions behind their vehicles. I drove up just west of campus building 1200, exited my vehicle, grabbed my AR-15 rifle and donned on my tactical/medical vest. As I was advancing on foot through the chained link fence, I was advised by an unknown B.S.O. Deputy taking cover behind a tree, "he is on the third floor."

I immediately linked up with C.S.P.D. Detective Gil Monzon, along with an unknown B.S.O. Deputy, and we tactically advanced to the west side of building 1200. While advancing towards the building I saw numerous bullet holes to multiple windows and doors to building 1200. I observed [REDACTED] just to the south of the west exit doors of building 1200. Detective Monzon, the unknown Deputy and I advanced toward the exit doors. Detective Monzon covered the door while the Deputy and I checked for vital signs: [REDACTED] [REDACTED]. I looked at [REDACTED] and saw no breathing. I checked for a pulse and felt none. I saw a golf cart immediately to the north [REDACTED]. I advised the B.S.O. Deputy, "We need to move."

Entry was then made into building 1200 with Detective Monzon. I saw a white male directly to my left whom I now know as [REDACTED]. I continued to scan for threats. It was difficult to see through the billowing smoke. I smelled a strong odor of gun powder and saw more bodies of juveniles further east down the hall. I also saw numerous spent rifle cartridges. I made my way to [REDACTED] and saw [REDACTED] had shallow breathing while still clutching a school radio in [REDACTED] right hand. Unknown if the threat was still in the vicinity, I advised Detective Monzon that we needed to get [REDACTED] out. I went back to the west exit doors and saw the BSO Deputy and asked if [REDACTED] had the keys to the golf cart. The Deputy went into [REDACTED] pocket and retrieved a ring of keys and threw them to me. I placed a key into the golf cart and saw it was on.

I made my way to the west doors and Detective Monzon was already pulling [REDACTED] out. Detective Monzon and I picked [REDACTED] up placed him on the back of the golf cart. I told the B.S.O. Deputy to hold onto [REDACTED] and we extracted [REDACTED] from the campus to medical personnel who had staged at Holmberg Road and Pine Island Road. With the aid of medical personnel [REDACTED] was removed. I immediately turned the golf cart around and the Deputy and I returned to the

west doors of building 1200. As I pulled up another gunshot victim was being extracted. The victim was placed on the golf cart and again the B.S.O. Deputy and I drove the victim to the medical staging area. That victim was removed from the golf cart and the Deputy and I returned to the west side of building 1200. The Deputy and I aided in holding the ground floor when I heard victims were on the east side of building 1200. Both the Deputy and I drove the golf cart to the east side of building 1200. Minutes later another [REDACTED] victim with a gunshot wound to the leg was placed in the rear of the golf cart and the Deputy and I drove to the medical staging area. After the victim was removed from the golf cart the Deputy and I returned to the east side. Minutes later a [REDACTED] with a gunshot wound to her arm was placed on the golf cart and again the Deputy and I drove her to the medical staging area. After the victim was removed the Deputy and I again returned to the east side of building 1200 where B.S.O. S.W.A.T. extracted a victim. I aided them in placing the victim on the rear of the golf cart and the victim was driven by an unknown B.S.O. Deputy and S.W.A.T. Medic to the medical staging area.

I was then advised by Sgt. Kozlowski to marry up with his unit. Sgt. Kozlowski and C.S.P.D. Officers advanced to campus building 800 where I was advised to secure and hold the exterior auditorium doors where numerous students had sought safety. Sgt. Kozolowski and his team tactically cleared the auditorium. Sgt. Kozlowski then gave the order to have both the students and teachers evacuate out the interior doors through the breezeway and head north and eventually east into the parking lot. Sgt. Kozlowski then started clearing building 800 where numerous students had hunkered in place. Those students and teachers were then evacuated to safety through the breezeway and east into the parking lot. At about 1835 hours I was advised to return back to the Coral Springs Police Department Command Bus.

While downing my equipment back into my police vehicle, I observed my rifle had blood from sliding stock to rail light. Back at the E.O.C., I was advised by Lt. Allen to have C.S.I. Investigator Menke photograph and take DNA swabs of the rifle and check for any blood which may be on my vest or uniform. A visual examination of my vest and uniform showed no apparent signs of blood; Investigator Menke did process my rifle for DNA.

On 2/14/2018 at approximately 1423 hours I responded from CSPD to an in-progress shooting at Marjory Stoneman Douglas High School in Parkland, Florida. While responding to the school Officer Burton arrived on scene. He advised that the shooter was in the 1200 building which was the three story building on the North side of campus. I turned west on Holmberg Road and drove in the Eastbound traffic lanes in order to avoid the traffic in the westbound lanes (it was almost dismissal time). I observed Officer Whittington opening a gate which I used to gain access to the north parking lot.

I exited my vehicle and put on my marked tactical vest. I ran towards Detective Monzon and Sergeant Mazzei who were preparing to approach the 1200 building. As we ran towards the building I observed several bullet holes to a window on the third floor. I also saw [REDACTED] lying on the ground, just outside the west doors of the 1200 building. The [REDACTED] and lying on his back. I checked the [REDACTED] neck for a pulse and found none. We opened the west doors and entered the building. The corridor was smoky and smelled of gunpowder and blood. There were many [REDACTED] cartridges on the ground. I observed an [REDACTED] slumping to the ground just in front of us. [REDACTED] appeared to be putting pressure on several gunshot wounds [REDACTED] had received to [REDACTED] chest and abdomen. [REDACTED] was conscious and was looking at us. We asked [REDACTED] where the shooter was but [REDACTED] did not respond. We moved to [REDACTED] and I took a position of long cover as [REDACTED] was dragged outside of the building for medical attention.

Additional officers entered the building and celled up with us. Sgt. Mazzei and I quickly cleared an office where an adult female was hiding. She, and a male student found hiding in a bathroom were evacuated out of the building. We continued pressing East when the East doors opened. Another emergency response team was entering the building opposite us. We yelled to them that we were police and quickly turned the first floor over to that team. We then moved back to the West stairwell and moved to the second floor. On the second floor landing dispatch advised that they were watching the shooter via cctv. We were advised over the radio that the shooter was preparing to exit the East stairwell on the second floor.

Our team pressed out of the West stairwell and began moving down the corridor towards the suspect. We were then advised the suspect was exiting the stairwell. We prepared to engage the shooter on the second floor. After several moments we were advised the cctv was not live and that an unknown delay existed. We were later informed that the suspect was seen exiting the building via cctv. Our team transitioned to a rescue team and we evacuated every classroom on the second floor.

I then responded to the third floor to assist with rescue and recovery operations. I entered the third floor from the East stairwell. I observed multiple shell casings, broken glass, blood, and bodies on this floor. I worked with a BSO swat member to clear an empty classroom. Captain Mock then requested all CSPD SWAT to assist with clearing the 1300 building as it was possible the shooter had relocated there. I raced to the 1300 building with other SWAT members.

On 02/14/18, at approximately 1426 hours, CSPD dispatch advised that there was an active shooter incident occurring at Marjory Stoneman Douglas High School in the city of Parkland. I immediately began to respond to that location from CSPD headquarters. While en-route, it was advised over the radio that the location of the shooter was in the three story building on the north side of the campus. As I turned westbound to Holmberg Rd from Coral Springs Dr., I passed several BSO deputies who were taking positions along Holmberg Rd. I proceeded into the north main gate near the student parking lot, exited my vehicle with my rifle and proceeded to run towards the three story building (1200) with several other CSPD officers. As I approached the west doors of the building, I observed a [REDACTED] lying on [REDACTED] back just outside the doors. [REDACTED] was unresponsive. I made an attempt to drag [REDACTED] to an area of safety but I determined that [REDACTED] was already deceased. There was also a [REDACTED] lying outside the doors who was deceased. At that point, there were several other officers with me and we made entry into the building through the west doors. This team consisted of Det. Monzon, Sgt. Wiesing, Ofc. Dintelman, Ofc. Wilkins, Ofc. P. Murray, Sgt. Myers, an unknown BSO uniformed deputy and myself.

Upon the doors opening I observed a [REDACTED] bleeding heavily from gunshot wounds. [REDACTED] was conscious but was unable to respond to any questions as to the location of the shooter. [REDACTED] was evacuated out of the building and turned over to other officers. The first floor hallway was full of smoke and multiple spent rifle rounds were observed on the ground. A female was located unharmed in the first office on the left as you enter the building. She was immediately evacuated. As we continued to clear the first floor we made contact with a male student hiding in the bathroom, he was immediately evacuated. Moving on, the east side doors of the 1200 building opened and there was another law enforcement team from CSPD preparing to make entry. Because of the potential cross fire, I communicated to the other team that my team would proceed to the second floor and they would finish the first floor.

At this point other CSPD officers joined my clearing element. When clearing the second floor we encountered multiple locked classrooms. We could see students; however they refused to open the doors. The windows on the doors were breached using the ASP baton so that we could gain entry. On the second floor, at least four of the rooms had a minimum of 25-30 students inside. Because we did not know the location of the shooter the decision was made to leave the students in their rooms with an officer posted as security. There was too high of a risk to have them exit with the location of the shooter unknown. Halfway through clearing the second floor, BSO SWAT arrived and assisted with the clearing. My element did not encounter any additional injured or deceased persons on the second floor.

Even though we did not hear gunfire, I made the decision to begin clearing the building because we still believed that the gunman was in the building, and we knew that there were multiple victims that needed rescuing.

Once the 1200 building was secured, I assisted with clearing the 1300, 500, 400, 900, and 600 buildings as I was given a master key at one point.
