This is the final response to your Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) request, originally received by the United States Secret Service (Secret Service) on October 16, 2017, for information pertaining to all records concerning use of U.S. Government funds to provide security and/or any other services to President Trump and any companions on their September 29-October 1 trip to Bedminster, New Jersey.

Enclosed are documents responsive to your request. In efforts to provide you with the greatest degree of access authorized by law, we have considered the reference material under the FOIA regulation, Title 5 U.S.C. § 552. Pursuant to this Act, exemptions have been applied where deemed appropriate. The exemptions cited are marked below.

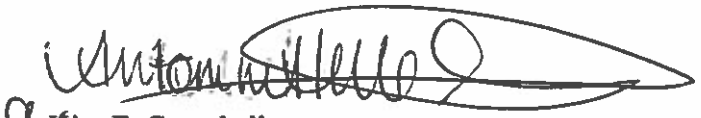

**FREEDOM OF INFORMATION ACT

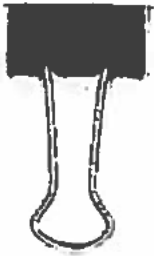
