Dear Mr. Fedeli:

I refer to your request letter dated January 14, 2016, under the Freedom of Information Act (the "FOIA"), 5 U.S.C. § 552.

The review of 48 documents responsive to your request has been completed. After reviewing these documents, we have determined that 28 documents may be released in full, 15 may be released with excisions, and 5 must be withheld in full. The Department withheld the 5 documents in their entirety under FOIA Exemption 5, 5 U.S.C. § 552(b)(5).

An enclosure explains the FOIA exemptions and other grounds for withholding material. Where we have made excisions, the applicable exemptions are marked on each document. All non-exempt material that is reasonably segregable from the exempt material has been released.

On January 7, 2016, as part of the ongoing release of former Secretary of State Clinton's emails, the Department of State released a partially redacted June 16-17, 2011, series of email exchanges between former Secretary Clinton and senior aide Jacob Sullivan. That email exchange included instructions from Mrs. Clinton to Mr. Sullivan to turn talking points into a "nonpaper w no identifying heading and send nonsecure" [sic].

According to recent television interviews, Mrs. Clinton has indicated that her instructions to Mr. Sullivan were never carried out, implying that the talking points were eventually sent by secure fax. Please provide us a copy of the associated transmission log and fax receipt, which as you know should include a description of the document transmitted, the sender and recipient of the fax, the number of pages transmitted, and the classification level of the transmitted document.

We appreciate your immediate attention to our request.

Associated Press: More detail, new questions about 2011 Clinton email

WASHINGTON (AP) — The State Department provided more detail Saturday about a 2011 document at the center of Hillary Clinton's latest email controversy, as an official said the former secretary of state never received the paper by nonsecure fax. But many other questions remained unanswered.

Clinton, whose presidential campaign has been challenged by her use of a private email account while secretary of state, is facing questions anew after Friday's revelation that she asked an adviser to go around a secure fax system to transmit a set of "talking points" on an unspecified subject.

Clinton told the adviser to turn it "into nonpaper w/no identifying heading and send nonsecure." Republicans immediately pounced on the exchange and suggested it proved impropriety.

The State Department said Friday that no such document was sent by email.

And on Saturday, a State Department official who wasn't authorized to speak publicly on the increasingly complicated review of Clinton's emails said the agency "checked its records and found no indication that the document in question was sent to Secretary Clinton using nonsecure fax or email."

The official, who demanded anonymity, said records instead turned up a secure fax transmission shortly after Clinton's email exchange with adviser Jake Sullivan on June 17, 2011. The implication was that this was the same document.

While the review appears to rule out the possibility of Clinton improperly receiving sensitive material, it leaves other questions unanswered.

Was the document classified or unclassified? The State Department won't say.

And was Clinton wrong to instruct a senior aide to send it through nonsecure means, even if that request wasn't fulfilled? The department says it isn't making a judgment.

Even the subject matter hasn't been revealed.

The only indication in the email exchange of what the document might have been about was redacted in Friday's release of some 3,000 pages from Clinton's tenure as America's top diplomat.

And it's unclear if any copy of the secure fax remains.

"Nonpaper" refers to an informal document, without official markings like letterhead or logos, not saved for records.

The Clinton campaign said that she had handled information appropriately.

"It is false that Hillary Clinton asked for classified material to be sent on a nonsecure system," campaign spokesman Brian Fallon said.

Since Clinton's use of a private email account and server became known last year, Republicans and others have questioned if the Democratic front-runner, either actively or passively, mishandled classified or otherwise sensitive material.

Republican Sen. Chuck Grassley of Iowa, the Judiciary Committee chairman, on Friday called the exchange with Sullivan a "disturbing email" that appears to show Clinton instructing an aide "to remove the headings from a classified document and send it to her in an unsecure manner."

Clinton, he said, "needs to finally come clean and be transparent about the email practices she used during her tenure at the department."

Clinton, whose presidential campaign has been challenged by her use of a private email account while secretary of state, is facing questions anew after Friday's revelation that she asked an adviser to go around a secure fax system to transmit a set of "talking points" on an unspecified subject.

Clinton told the adviser to turn it "into nonpaper w/no identifying heading and send nonsecure." Republicans immediately pounced on the exchange and suggested it proved impropriety.

The State Department said Friday that no such document was sent by email.

And on Saturday, a State Department official who wasn't authorized to speak publicly on the increasingly complicated review of Clinton's emails said the agency "checked its records and found no indication that the document in question was sent to Secretary Clinton using nonsecure fax or email."

The official, who demanded anonymity, said records instead turned up a secure fax transmission shortly after Clinton's email exchange with adviser Jake Sullivan on June 17, 2011. The implication was that this was the same document.

While the review appears to rule out the possibility of Clinton improperly receiving sensitive material, it leaves other questions unanswered.

Was the document classified or unclassified? The State Department won't say.

And was Clinton wrong to instruct a senior aide to send it through nonsecure means, even if that request wasn't fulfilled? The department says it isn't making a judgment.

Even the subject matter hasn't been revealed.

The only indication in the email exchange of what the document might have been about was redacted in Friday's release of some 3,000 pages from Clinton's tenure as America's top diplomat.

And it's unclear if any copy of the secure fax remains.

"Nonpaper" refers to an informal document, without official markings like letterhead or logos, not saved for records.

The Clinton campaign said that she had handled information appropriately.

"It is false that Hillary Clinton asked for classified material to be sent on a nonsecure system," campaign spokesman Brian Fallon said.

Since Clinton's use of a private email account and server became known last year, Republicans and others have questioned if the Democratic front-runner, either actively or passively, mishandled classified or otherwise sensitive material.

Republican Sen. Chuck Grassley of Iowa, the Judiciary Committee chairman, on Friday called the exchange with Sullivan a "disturbing email" that appears to show Clinton instructing an aide "to remove the headings from a classified document and send it to her in an unsecure manner."

Clinton, he said, "needs to finally come clean and be transparent about the email practices she used during her tenure at the department."

WASHINGTON (AP) — The State Department provided more detail Saturday about a 2011 document at the center of Hillary Clinton's latest email controversy, as an official said the former secretary of state never received the paper by nonsecure fax. But many other questions remained unanswered.

Clinton, whose presidential campaign has been challenged by her use of a private email account while secretary of state, is facing questions anew after Friday's revelation that she asked an adviser to go around a secure fax system to transmit a set of "talking points" on an unspecified subject.

Clinton told the adviser to turn it "into nonpaper w/no identifying heading and send nonsecure." Republicans immediately pounced on the exchange and suggested it proved impropriety.

The State Department said Friday that no such document was sent by email.

And on Saturday, a State Department official who wasn't authorized to speak publicly on the increasingly complicated review of Clinton's emails said the agency "checked its records and found no indication that the document in question was sent to Secretary Clinton using nonsecure fax or email."

The official, who demanded anonymity, said records instead turned up a secure fax transmission shortly after Clinton's email exchange with adviser Jake Sullivan on June 17, 2011. The implication was that this was the same document.

While the review appears to rule out the possibility of Clinton improperly receiving sensitive material, it leaves other questions unanswered.

Was the document classified or unclassified? The State Department won't say.

And was Clinton wrong to instruct a senior aide to send it through nonsecure means, even if that request wasn't fulfilled? The department says it isn't making a judgment.

Even the subject matter hasn't been revealed.

The only indication in the email exchange of what the document might have been about was redacted in Friday's release of some 3,000 pages from Clinton's tenure as America's top diplomat.

And it's unclear if any copy of the secure fax remains.

"Nonpaper" refers to an informal document, without official markings like letterhead or logos, not saved for records.

The Clinton campaign said that she had handled information appropriately.

"It is false that Hillary Clinton asked for classified material to be sent on a nonsecure system," campaign spokesman Brian Fallon said."

Since Clinton's use of a private email account and server became known last year, Republicans and others have questioned if the Democratic front-runner, either actively or passively, mishandled classified or otherwise sensitive material.

Republican Sen. Chuck Grassley of Iowa, the Judiciary Committee chairman, on Friday called the exchange with Sullivan a "disturbing email" that appears to show Clinton instructing an aide "to remove the headings from a classified document and send it to her in an unsecure manner."

Clinton, he said, "needs to finally come clean and be transparent about the email practices she used during her tenure at the department."

Clinton told the adviser to turn it "into nonpaper w/no identifying heading and send nonsecure." Republicans immediately pounced on the exchange and suggested it proved impropriety.

The State Department said Friday that no such document was sent by email.

And on Saturday, a State Department official who wasn't authorized to speak publicly on the increasingly complicated review of Clinton's emails said the agency "checked its records and found no indication that the document in question was sent to Secretary Clinton using nonsecure fax or email."

The official, who demanded anonymity, said records instead turned up a secure fax transmission shortly after Clinton's email exchange with adviser Jake Sullivan on June 17, 2011. The implication was that this was the same document.

While the review appears to rule out the possibility of Clinton improperly receiving sensitive material, it leaves other questions unanswered.

Was the document classified or unclassified? The State Department won't say.

And was Clinton wrong to instruct a senior aide to send it through nonsecure means, even if that request wasn't fulfilled? The department says it isn't making a judgment.

Even the subject matter hasn't been revealed.

The only indication in the email exchange of what the document might have been about was redacted in Friday's release of some 3,000 pages from Clinton's tenure as America's top diplomat.

And it's unclear if any copy of the secure fax remains.

"Nonpaper" refers to an informal document, without official markings like letterhead or logos, not saved for records.

"It is false that Hillary Clinton asked for classified material to be sent on a nonsecure system," campaign spokesman Brian Fallon said.

Since Clinton's use of a private email account and server became known last year, Republicans and others have questioned if the Democratic front-runner, either actively or passively, mishandled classified or otherwise sensitive material.

Republican Sen. Chuck Grassley of Iowa, the Judiciary Committee chairman, on Friday called the exchange with Sullivan a "disturbing email" that appears to show Clinton instructing an aide "to remove the headings from a classified document and send it to her in an unsecure manner."

Clinton, he said, "needs to finally come clean and be transparent about the email practices she used during her tenure at the department."

Clinton, whose presidential campaign has been challenged by her use of a private email account while secretary of state, is facing questions anew after Friday's revelation that she asked an adviser to go around a secure fax system to transmit a set of "talking points" on an unspecified subject.

Clinton told the adviser to turn it "into nonpaper w/no identifying heading and send nonsecure." Republicans immediately pounced on the exchange and suggested it proved impropriety.

The State Department said Friday that no such document was sent by email.

And on Saturday, a State Department official who wasn't authorized to speak publicly on the increasingly complicated review of Clinton's emails said the agency "checked its records and found no indication that the document in question was sent to Secretary Clinton using nonsecure fax or email."

The official, who demanded anonymity, said records instead turned up a secure fax transmission shortly after Clinton's email exchange with adviser Jake Sullivan on June 17, 2011. The implication was that this was the same document.

While the review appears to rule out the possibility of Clinton improperly receiving sensitive material, it leaves other questions unanswered.

Was the document classified or unclassified? The State Department won't say.

And was Clinton wrong to instruct a senior aide to send it through nonsecure means, even if that request wasn't fulfilled? The department says it isn't making a judgment.

Even the subject matter hasn't been revealed.

The only indication in the email exchange of what the document might have been about was redacted in Friday's release of some 3,000 pages from Clinton's tenure as America's top diplomat.

And it's unclear if any copy of the secure fax remains.

"Nonpaper" refers to an informal document, without official markings like letterhead or logos, not saved for records.

"It is false that Hillary Clinton asked for classified material to be sent on a nonsecure system," campaign spokesman Brian Fallon said.

Since Clinton's use of a private email account and server became known last year, Republicans and others have questioned if the Democratic front-runner, either actively or passively, mishandled classified or otherwise sensitive material.

Republican Sen. Chuck Grassley of Iowa, the Judiciary Committee chairman, on Friday called the exchange with Sullivan a "disturbing email" that appears to show Clinton instructing an aide "to remove the headings from a classified document and send it to her in an unsecure manner."

Clinton, he said, "needs to finally come clean and be transparent about the email practices she used during her tenure at the department."

WASHINGTON (AP) — The State Department provided more detail Saturday about a 2011 document at the center of Hillary Clinton's latest email controversy, as an official said the former secretary of state never received the paper by nonsecure fax. But many other questions remained unanswered.

Clinton, whose presidential campaign has been challenged by her use of a private email account while secretary of state, is facing questions anew after Friday's revelation that she asked an adviser to go around a secure fax system to transmit a set of "talking points" on an unspecified subject.

Clinton told the adviser to turn it "into nonpaper w/no identifying heading and send nonsecure." Republicans immediately pounced on the exchange and suggested it proved impropriety.

The State Department said Friday that no such document was sent by email.

And on Saturday, a State Department official who wasn't authorized to speak publicly on the increasingly complicated review of Clinton's emails said the agency "checked its records and found no indication that the document in question was sent to Secretary Clinton using nonsecure fax or email."

The official, who demanded anonymity, said records instead turned up a secure fax transmission shortly after Clinton's email exchange with adviser Jake Sullivan on June 17, 2011. The implication was that this was the same document.

While the review appears to rule out the possibility of Clinton improperly receiving sensitive material, it leaves other questions unanswered.

Was the document classified or unclassified? The State Department won't say.

And was Clinton wrong to instruct a senior aide to send it through nonsecure means, even if that request wasn't fulfilled? The department says it isn't making a judgment.

Even the subject matter hasn't been revealed.

The only indication in the email exchange of what the document might have been about was redacted in Friday's release of some 3,000 pages from Clinton's tenure as America's top diplomat.

And it's unclear if any copy of the secure fax remains.

"Nonpaper" refers to an informal document, without official markings like letterhead or logos, not saved for records.







Thank you for your inquiries concerning a June 17, 2011, email exchange released as part of the Department of State's ongoing productions of former Secretary of State Hillary Clinton's emails pursuant to the Freedom of Information Act.

The email exchange discusses efforts to transmit a document from the State Department's Operations Center to Secretary Clinton using a secure fax machine. At 8:21 a.m., Secretary Clinton queried whether the document could instead be sent using unsecure methods given apparent problems with the secure fax machine.

We have been asked if we can confirm that the referenced document was transmitted using a secure fax machine. At this time, the Department has not been able to identify the document that was the subject of this exchange or to establish the content of the document transmitted in this time period. The Operations Center logs its interactions with Department officials and basic information on actions taken in response. The log does not record the subject or content of its fax transmissions. Accordingly, we are unable to provide you with a copy of the document. If the Department learns additional information about this document we will notify the Committee.

The Department confirms that the Operations Center sent a secure fax message to Secretary Clinton on June 17, 2011 at 9:00 a.m. The Operations Center has no record of sending a non-secure fax transmission to Secretary Clinton between the time of her 8:21 a.m. email and the secure transmission referred to above. In addition, the Department located two email chains that demonstrate the Department's efforts to transmit a document requested by the Secretary using a secure fax machine, including a final instruction to send the transmission at 9:00

a.m. A copy of the Operations Center log and these email chains are attached. We have also reviewed Secretary Clinton's emails from the relevant time period; it does not appear that she received the referenced document via email.

I hope this information addresses your questions. Please contact me if the Department can be of further assistance.







Thank you for your inquiries concerning a June 17, 2011, email exchange released as part of the Department of State's ongoing productions of former Secretary of State Hillary Clinton's emails pursuant to the Freedom of Information Act.

The email exchange discusses efforts to transmit a document from the State Department's Operations Center to Secretary Clinton using a secure fax machine. At 8:21 a.m., Secretary Clinton queried whether the document could instead be sent using unsecure methods given apparent problems with the secure fax machine.

We have been asked if we can confirm that the referenced document was transmitted using a secure fax machine. At this time, the Department has not been able to identify the document that was the subject of this exchange or to establish the content of the document transmitted in this time period. The Operations Center logs its interactions with Department officials and basic information on actions taken in response. The log does not record the subject or content of its fax transmissions. Accordingly, we are unable to provide you with a copy of the document. If the Department learns additional information about this document we will notify the Committee.

The Department confirms that the Operations Center sent a secure fax message to Secretary Clinton on June 17, 2011 at 9:00 a.m. The Operations Center has no record of sending a non-secure fax transmission to Secretary Clinton between the time of her 8:21 a.m. email and the secure transmission referred to above. 





On January 8, 2015, the Department of State released, pursuant to the Freedom of Information Act (FOIA), a batch of Secretary Clinton's emails that included a disturbing June 2011 email exchange between Secretary Clinton and Jake Sullivan, her then-Deputy Chief of Staff. The exchange appears to show, in response to difficulties sending a secure fax, Secretary Clinton instructing a subordinate to remove the headings from what are presumably classified talking points and send them to her in an unsecure manner. Obviously, if the talking points were classified, they should have been sent via secure systems. I

On January 10, 2015, according to a Wall Street Journal article, the Department said it "has found no indication that the document in question was sent to Mrs. Clinton using nonsecure fax or email" but an unnamed Department official stated "there was a secure fax transmission to Secretary Clinton shortly after [the email exchange with Jake Sullivan]." Because the document's subject line was redacted, the subject matter of the talking points was unclear from the Department's FOIA release. The Associated Press, however, initially reported that the talking points related to a conversation Secretary Clinton had scheduled with a senator later that day and the subject included a Russian accountant, Sergei Magnitsky.

A few hours after Secretary Clinton's instructions to Mr. Sullivan, Ms. Huma Abedin sent an email containing classified information to Secretary Clinton. The subject line of that email was "D'Amato," but the body of the email is almost entirely redacted as classified. However, it appears that Secretary Clinton had "asked for background info[rmation]" on a call related to that subject. It is unclear whether this email was related to the earlier attempt to securely fax talking points to the Secretary.

On January 8, 2015, my staff contacted yours to request an unredacted copy of the talking points email exchange as well as the "talking points" referenced in it. On January 11, 2015, in light of the Department's statements in the Wall Street Journal article, my staff requested that the Department confirm whether the talking points referenced in the email were, in fact, sent securely. Rather than providing the information informally, the Department requested an official Committee letter.

Accordingly, please respond to the following:

- 1. The talking points email includes numerous FOIA redactions under the b(5) exemption. The Department of Justice has noted that the three primary privileges incorporated into Exemption 5 include the deliberative process privilege, the attorney work-product privilege, and the attorney-client privilege. Please indicate which privileges are at issue in the talking points email. 5
- 2. Please provide an unredacted version of the talking points email and the D'Amato email.⁶
- 3. Please provide an unredacted copy of the talking points referenced in the talking points email.
- 4. Did the Department keep records of all nonsecure faxes or emails sent to or received by Secretary Clinton? If so, please provide the records for June 17, 2011.
- 5. Did the Department keep records of all secure faxes or emails sent to or received by Secretary Clinton? If so, please provide the records for June 17, 2011.
- 6. Please provide a copy of the secure fax transmission sent to Secretary Clinton shortly after the email exchange with Jake Sullivan, as mentioned in the Wall Street Journal and attributed to an unnamed Department official.

On January 8, 2015, the Department of State released, pursuant to the Freedom of Information Act (FOIA), a batch of Secretary Clinton's emails that included a disturbing June 2011 email exchange between Secretary Clinton and Jake Sullivan, her then-Deputy Chief of Staff. The exchange appears to show, in response to difficulties sending a secure fax, Secretary Clinton instructing a subordinate to remove the headings from what are presumably classified talking points and send them to her in an unsecure manner. Obviously, if the talking points were classified, they should have been sent via secure systems. \(\frac{1}{2} \)

On January 10, 2015, according to a Wall Street Journal article, the Department said it "has found no indication that the document in question was sent to Mrs. Clinton using nonsecure fax or email" but an unnamed Department official stated "there was a secure fax transmission to Secretary Clinton shortly after [the email exchange with Jake Sullivan]." Because the document's subject line was redacted, the subject matter of the talking points was unclear from the Department's FOIA release. The Associated Press, however, initially reported that the talking points related to a conversation Secretary Clinton had scheduled with a senator later that day and the subject included a Russian accountant, Sergei Magnitsky.
