Dear William F. Marshall:

This is a final response to your Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) requests dated September 21, 2018, in which you requested records from the Offices of the Attorney General (OAG) or Deputy Attorney General (ODAG) (1) reflecting surreptitious recordings or transcripts of meetings with the Executive Offices of the President or Vice President, or (2) records related to the 25th Amendment or the fitness of the President. You also requested ODAG records consisting of "memoranda, reports, and opinions written, signed or authorized by DAG Rosenstein in the month of May 2017, referencing the 25th Amendment to the US Constitution and/or the fitness of the President of the United States."

Please be advised that searches have been conducted on behalf of OAG and ODAG, as well as within the Departmental Executive Secretariat, and fourteen pages containing records responsive to your request were located. I have determined that these fourteen pages are appropriate for release with excisions made pursuant to Exemptions 5 and 6 of the FOIA, 5 U.S.C. § 552(b)(5) and (b)(6), and copies are enclosed. Exemption 5 pertains to certain inter- or intra-agency communications protected by the deliberative process privilege. Exemption 6 pertains to information the release of which would constitute a clearly unwarranted invasion of personal privacy.

For your information, Congress excluded three discrete categories of law enforcement and national security records from the requirements of the FOIA. See 5 U.S.C. § 552(c) (2018). This response is limited to those records that are subject to the requirements of the FOIA. This is a standard notification that is given to all our requesters and should not be taken as an indication that excluded records do, or do not, exist.
