Dear Mr. Bekesha:

I refer you to our letter dated August 14, 2019, regarding the review of certain Department of State material under the Freedom of Information Act (the "FOIA"), 5 U.S.C. § 552. The review of potentially responsive records is ongoing, and has resulted in the retrieval of three additional documents responsive to your request. After reviewing these documents, we have determined that one may be released to you in full and two may be released in part. The released material is enclosed.

All non-exempt material that is reasonably segregable from the exempt material has been released. Where we have made excisions, the applicable exemptions are marked on the document. An enclosure provides information on FOIA exemptions and other grounds for withholding material.

The Freedom of Information Act (5 USC 552)

FOIA Exemptions
